Tulane Postgame Notes

In its first year in the American Athletic Conference, Tulane became the only first-round participant to reach the semifinals by eliminating third-seeded Tulsa. Tulane finished 2-1 against the Golden Hurricane this year.

The Green Wave had 17 steals against Tulsa, and has 27 steals through two games of the tournament. Tulane had 16 steals in the previous meeting with Tulsa, a 55-52 loss on February 28th. It began the tournament averaging 9.8 steals per game, which ranked fourth in The American.

Sophomore guard Leslie Vorpahl tied a career-high with four made 3-pointers, and recorded her ninth double-figure scoring game of the season with 17 points.

Senior guard Jamie Kaplan had a season-high three treys, finishing with 13 points.

Tulane made a season-high 10 3-pointers.

Freshman guard Kolby Morgan had her 19th double-figure scoring game, finishing with 15 points.

Sophomore guard Courtnie Latham had her fifth double-figure scoring game of the season with 11 points.

Tulsa Postgame Notes

Tulsa junior guard Ashley Clark had her 25th double-figure scoring game of the season, finishing with 23 points on 11-of-17 shooting. She fell two rebounds short of what would have been her seventh double-double of the year.

Tulsa sophomore guard Teanna Reid tied a career-high with seven rebounds.

Tulsa senior forward Mariah Turner tied a career-high with four assists. She had 10 points, her 21st double-figure scoring game of the season and the 45th of her career.

Tulsa was forced into a season-high 27 turnovers. The previous season-high was 23 (twice) against Tulane.
