NCAA Tournament Notables

- Tonight's attendance for the national championship was 19,810, bringing the total for the Final Four to 39,540.
- UConn won a NCAA record 10th National Title on Tuesday.
- Coach Geno Auriemma joins UCLA men's basketball coach John Wooden as the only two college coaches to win 10 national championship titles.
- Connecticut junior Breanna Stewart was named the Most Outstanding Player for the third consecutive tournament, becoming the first player to ever achieve that mark. Other multi-year MOPs include: Cheryl Miller (USC, 83-84), Chamique Holdsclaw (Tennessee, 97-98), Diana Taurasi (UConn, 03-04), Candace Parker (Tennessee, 07-08).
- Stewart joins UCLA men's basketball player Kareem Abdul-Jabbar as the only two players to have won Most Outstanding Player honors three times in a career.
- NCAA officials for Tuesday were Dee Kantner, Denise Brooks and Mark Zentz.
- Kantner called her seventh title game in the last eight years and her 12th overall.
- Denise Brooks officiated her third straight championship game.
- Mark Zentz officiated his first championship game and his second Final Four in three years.
