POSTSEASON HONORS

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

McKenzie Milton • Jr. • QB • UCF • Kapolei, Hawaii

Milton becomes the first player to repeat as The American's Offensive Player of the Year as he served as the catalyst behind an offense that leads the conference and ranks fifth nationally at 531.5 yards per game and averaged 43.1 points per game, which ranks eighth. Milton, who suffered a serious injury in UCF's win against USF, threw for 2,663 yards and 25 touchdowns with six interceptions and rushed for 307 yards and a team-high nine TDs in 2018. He ranks 10th nationally in pass efficiency (161.0), third in yards per completion (15.57) and sixth in points responsible for per game (20.4).

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Nate Harvey • Sr. • DE • ECU • Knightdale, N.C.

Harvey enjoyed a breakout season as a senior in 2018. After spending last season primarily on special teams, Harvey emerged as a starting defensive end and finished the year as the national leader in tackles for loss (2.12 per game). Harvey, who had 25.5 tackles for loss, broke The American's single-season record of 23.0 TFL, set by Houston's Ed Oliver in 2017, and tied the conference's single-season sacks record. Harvey had 14.5 sacks, joining Louisville's Marcus Smith, who set the mark in 2013. In addition, Harvey had 63 tackles, two forced fumbles and a fumble recovery. He is the first ECU player to be chosen as The American's Defensive Player of the Year.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Isaiah Wright • Jr. • WR/KR • Temple • West Hartford, Conn.

Wright becomes the first Temple player to earn Special Teams Player of the Year honors from The American. Wright scored a nation-leading three special teams touchdowns in 2018 and finished the season as the conference leader in punt return average (13.1 yards per return). Wright is third in the conference in kickoff return average (26.5 ypr) and fourth in all-purpose yards (121.1 yards per game).

ROOKIE OF THE YEAR

Desmond Ridder • Fr. • QB • Cincinnati • Louisville, Ky.

Ridder is the first Cincinnati player to be named as The American's Rookie of the Year. Ridder took over as the Bearcats' quarterback in the second quarter of the season-opening win at UCLA and led Cincinnati to an 11-2 record. Ridder passed for 2,468 yards and 20 touchdowns with five interceptions and rushed for 572 yards and five TDs as a redshirt freshman. He ranks fourth in The American in pass efficiency (147.0) and sixth in total offense (233.8 yards per game).

COACH OF THE YEAR

Luke Fickell • Cincinnati

Fickell was chosen by his peers as The American's Coach of the Year after he orchestrated a seven-win improvement in his second year on the Cincinnati sideline. After going 4-8 in his first year, Fickell led the Bearcats to an 11-2 overall record, a 5-0 in mark in nonconference games and a 6-2 conference mark in 2018. The Bearcats returned to the national polls for the first time since 2013, ranking as high as No. 19 in the Nov. 11 Associated Press poll and finishing the season ranked No. 23 in the coaches' poll.

AMERICAN NOTEBOOK

Rank And File

The American Athletic Conference placed two teams in the final national polls for the second consecutive season and the fourth time in the league's six-year history. UCF was ranked No. 11 in the final AP poll and No. 12 in the coaches' poll, while Cincinnati was No. 24 in the AP ranking and No. 23 in the coaches' poll.

Powerful Stuff

The American has 34 nonconference victories against other Power 6 opponents (including Notre Dame) since the start of the 2015 season, the first year of The American's current membership. American teams had eight Power 6 wins in the 2018 season.

The American placed seven teams in bowl games in the 2018 season (UCF, Cincinnati, Houston, Memphis, USF, Temple, Tulane). The American has had at least seven teams in bowl games in each of the last four seasons.

This Is Our House

Home teams were a combined 30-18 in American Athletic Conference games in 2018. UCF, Temple and Cincinnati all went 4-0 in conference home games.

It's East vs. West

The American's East Division finished the 2018 season with a 10-8 head-to-head record against the league's West Division, marking the first time in the four-year history of the conference's two-division format that the East had the better head-to-head record.

Prognostication

The 2018 season was the first in which both preseason favorites in The American's East (UCF) and West (Memphis) divisions went on to win division titles.

Pac Mentality

American Athletic Conference teams are a combined 4-0 against the Pac-12 since the start of the 2017 season.

This Too Shall Pass

UCF saw a 25-game winning streak come to an end when the Knights fell to LSU in the PlayStation Fiesta Bowl.

One And Only

UCF is the only team in FBS football that has only one loss in the last two seasons. The Knights are 25-1 since the start of the 2017 season.

Conference Call

UCF has won 18 consecutive games against American Athletic Conference opponents since the start of the 2017 season. That is the longest active winning streak nationally for any team in its conference. Clemson ranks second with 13 straight wins against ACC teams, while Alabama has defeated 10 straight SEC opponents.

Home Is Where The Wins Are

UCF has won 15 straight home games, tying Clemson for the nation's second-longest active streak. Alabama has won its last 26 home games.

This Goes To 11

Cincinnati registered its third 11-win season in school history in 2018. The Bearcats had previously won 11 games in 2008 and scored 12 wins in 2009.

New Wave

Tulane won five of its last six games of the 2018 season as the Green Wave played in a bowl game for the first time since 2013.

The Best Offense ...

Temple led the nation with eight defensive touchdowns in 2018. Houston was sixth nationally with four defensive TDs.

Offensive Outbursts

The American Athletic Conference had three of the top seven teams nationally in total offense. Memphis was fourth at 523.1 yards per game. UCF was fifth at 522.7 ypg, while Houston was seventh at 512.5 ypg.

Running Free

Memphis RB Darrell Henderson broke The American's single-season rushing record in the Tigers' win against Houston to close the regular season. Henderson finished the 2018 season with 1,909 yards, surpassing Tulsa's James Flanders, who had 1,629 yards in the 2016 season.

Ground And Pound

Memphis ranked fourth nationally in rushing offense (279.9 yards per game) and was first among teams that do not run the option as their primary system. Navy was fifth nationally at 276.1 ypg.

Best Behavior

Navy finished the 2018 season ranked second nationally in fewest penalties (3.69) and penalty yards per game (30.0).

Great Responsibility

Houston QB D'Eriq King finished the 2018 season as the national leader in points responsible for per game. King had a hand in 50 touchdowns (14 rushing, 36 passing) and one two-point conversion, good for 302 points in 11 games (27.5 ppg average). Heisman Trophy finalist Dwayne Haskins of Ohio State was second at 23.1 ppg, while Heisman winner Kyler Murray of Oklahoma was third at 23.1 ppg. UCF QB McKenzie Milton was fifth at 22.0 ppg.

Election Totals

UCF QB McKenzie Milton finished sixth in the 2018 Heisman Trophy voting, making him one of two players to finish in the top 10 of the voting in each of the last two seasons (along with Wisconsin RB Jonathan Taylor). Memphis RB Darrell Henderson was 10th in the 2018 voting, giving The American two top-10 finishers in the same season for the first time.

Everybody's All-America

Memphis RB Darrell Henderson and Houston DT Ed Oliver were chosen as NCAA Consensus All-America selections in 2018. Oliver becomes The American's first two-time consensus All-America pick, while the two selections this season mark the second straight year in which The American had multiple players selected.

Freshman Phenom

Tulsa LB Zaven Collins was chosen as a Freshman All-America selection by the Football Writers Association of America. Collins registered 85 tackles with 9.5 tackles for loss in his rookie season.

At A Loss

ECU DE Nate Harvey set the American Athletic Conference's single-season record with 25.5 tackles for loss in 2018. Harvey, who led the nation with 2.1 tackles for loss per game, also tied the conference record with 14.5 sacks.

UCF quarterback McKenzie Milton, who led the No. 7-ranked Knights to a second consecutive perfect regular season, has been chosen as the American Athletic Conference Offensive Player of the Year for the second straight year, while ECU defensive end Nate Harvey, the national leader in tackles for loss, was named as The American's Defensive Player of the Year by the league's 12 head coaches.

Temple wide receiver Isaiah Wright was named as The American's Special Teams Player of the Year. Cincinnati quarterback Desmond Ridder was chosen as Rookie of the Year, while Bearcat head coach Luke Fickell was named as Coach of the Year.

Milton becomes the first player to repeat as The American's Offensive Player of the Year as he served as the catalyst behind an offense that leads the conference and ranks fifth nationally at 531.5 yards per game and averaged 43.1 points per game, which ranks eighth. Milton, who suffered a serious injury in UCF's win against USF last Friday, threw for 2,663 yards and 25 touchdowns with six interceptions and rushed for 307 yards and a team-high nine TDs in 2018.

Harvey enjoyed a breakout season as a senior at ECU in 2018. After spending last season primarily on special teams, Harvey emerged as a starting defensive end and enters Saturday's regular-season finale at North Carolina State as the national leader in tackles for loss (24.0). Harvey broke The American's single-season record of 23.0 tackles for loss, set by Houston's Ed Oliver last year, and enters Saturday's game with 13.5 sacks, one shy of the conference's single-season record (14.5 by Louisville's Marcus Smith in 2013). He is the first ECU player to be chosen as The American's Defensive Player of the Year.

Wright becomes the first Temple player to earn Special Teams Player of the Year honors from The American. Wright scored a nation-leading three special teams touchdowns in 2018 and enters the postseason as the conference leader in punt return average (13.9 yards per return). Wright is third in the conference in kickoff return average (25.9 ypr) and fifth in all-purpose yards (119.0 yards per game).

Ridder is the first Cincinnati player to be named as The American's Rookie of the Year. Ridder took over as the Bearcats' quarterback during the season-opening win at UCLA and has led Cincinnati to a 10-2 record. Ridder has thrown for 2,382 yards and 19 touchdowns with five interceptions and has rushed for 563 yards and five TDs. He ranks fourth in The American in pass efficiency (145.7) and fifth in total offense (245.4 ypg).

Fickell was chosen by his peers as The American's Coach of the Year after he orchestrated a six-win improvement in his second year on the Cincinnati sideline. After going 4-8 in his first year, Fickell has led the Bearcats to a 10-2 overall record, a 4-0 in mark in nonconference games and a 6-2 conference mark in 2018. The Bearcats returned to the national polls for the first time since 2013, ranking as high as No. 19 in the Nov. 11 Associated Press poll.

COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

The College Football Playoff (CFP) is a big success. Fans, including many who are new to the sport, enjoy it. The first College Football Playoff semifinals and national championship were the three most-viewed programs in cable television history.

Every Game Counts

The playoff preserves the excitement and significance of college football's unique regular season where every game counts.

Four Teams

The selection committee ranks the teams based on the members' evaluation of the teams' performance on the field, using conference championships won, strength of schedule, head-to-head results, and comparison of results against common opponents to decide among teams that are comparable.

Two Games, One Goal

The kickoff of the new year belongs to college football, with two semifinal games rotating annually among the Cotton Bowl, Fiesta Bowl, Orange Bowl, Peach Bowl, Rose Bowl and Sugar Bowl. The two teams winning the playoff semifinals compete for the College Football Playoff National Championship. That game is in a different city each year, always on a Monday night.

Universal Access

Every FBS team has equal access to the College Football Playoff based on its performance. No team automatically qualifies.

Governance

University presidents and chancellors from all 10 FBS conferences and Notre Dame serve on the CFP Board of Managers and govern the administrative operations, with commissioners (the Management Committee) managing the event. A small staff in the playoff office in Irving, Texas, carries out the detailed responsibilities.

Selection Committee

A talented group of high-integrity individuals with experience as coaches, student-athletes, college administrators and journalists, along with sitting athletics directors, comprise the selection committee. Members of the committee are: Rob Mullens (chair), Frank Beamer, Paola Boivin, Jeff Bower, Joe Castiglione, Herb Deromedi, Ken Hatfield, Chris Howard, Bobby Johnson, Ronnie Lott, Gene Smith, Todd Stansbury, and Scott Stricklin.

Selection Committee Responsibilities

- Rank the top 25 teams and assign the top four to semifinal sites.
- Assign teams to New Year's bowls
- Create competitive matchups
- Attempt to avoid rematches of regular-season games and repeat appearances
- Consider geography

Participants In New Year's Bowls

Both participants in the Orange, Rose and Sugar Bowls are contracted outside the playoff arrangement (Big Ten and Pac-12 to Rose Bowl; SEC and Big 12 to Sugar Bowl; ACC to Orange Bowl against the highest ranked available team from the SEC, Big Ten and Notre Dame). If a conference champion qualifies for the playoff, then the bowl will choose a replacement from that conference. When those bowls host the semifinals and their contracted conference champions do not qualify, then the displaced champion(s) will play in one of the other New Year's bowls.

When not hosting semifinals, the Cotton, Fiesta and Peach Bowls will welcome displaced conference champions and the top-ranked champion from a non-contract conference. The highest-ranked available teams will fill any other berths. The selection committee will make the pairings.

BOWL PARTNERSHIPS

The American Bowl Lineup

In addition to the College Football Playoff and New Year's Bowls, The American has either a primary or secondary affiliation with 12 bowl games during its current six-year bowl cycle, which ends following the 2019 season. The American works annually with its member schools and bowl partners to create the most sensible and attractive postseason matchups.

The **Military Bowl presented by Northrop Grumman** takes place at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium in Annapolis, Maryland, while the events and activities surrounding the game are based in Washington, D.C. The American Athletic Conference will face an opponent from the Atlantic Coast Conference each year in the current cycle.

The **Jared Birmingham Bowl** takes place at Legion Field in Birmingham, Alabama. The American/Big East has partnered with the bowl since its inception in the 2006 season. The American Athletic Conference will annually face an opponent from the Southeastern Conference.

The **Bad Boy Mowers Gasparilla Bowl** is played at Raymond James Stadium in Tampa, Florida. The American Athletic Conference will supply a team to the bowl during each year of the six-year cycle. Conference USA will play in the game in 2015, 2017 and 2019, while the Atlantic Coast Conference provides the opposing team in 2014, 2016 and 2018.

The **Cheribundi Tart Cherry Boca Raton Bowl** began in 2014 and will feature an American Athletic Conference team three times during the six-year cycle at FAU Stadium in Boca Raton, Florida. The American representative will play a team from Conference USA in 2018.

The **Frisco Bowl** will be played for the second time in 2018 as the former Miami Beach Bowl was relocated to Toyota Stadium in Frisco, Texas. An American Athletic Conference plays in the bowl each year.

The **AutoNation Cure Bowl** made its debut in 2015 at the newly renovated Camping World Stadium in Orlando, Florida. An American Athletic Conference team will be paired against an opponent from the Sun Belt Conference. Net proceeds from the game will benefit the Breast Cancer Research Foundation.

The **Lockheed Martin Armed Forces Bowl** is played at Amon G. Carter Stadium on the campus of Texas Christian University. The American Athletic Conference sends a team to the bowl in 2014, 2016 and 2018. The opponent will be a Big 12 team in 2016 and 2018, with Conference USA as a secondary affiliation.

In addition to the conference's primary bowl affiliations, The American holds secondary partnerships with the **AutoZone Liberty Bowl** in Memphis, Tennessee, and the **Walk-On's Independence Bowl** in Shreveport, Louisiana, as well as with other ESPN-owned bowls.
