THE AMERICAN TODAY

USF REMAINS UNBEATEN IN CONFERENCE PLAY

No. 14 USF remains the only unbeaten team in The American in conference play at 7-0 (10-1 overall). The Bulls current nine-game winning streak ranks 11th among all active teams in NCAA Division I women's basketball.

HOW THE AMERICAN STANDS IN THE NET

As of the Jan. 21 calculation of the NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) rankings, a number of American teams are in strong position for potential at-large NCAA Tournament berths. Conference leader USF set the pace at 14th in the NET. Tulane was 51st, UCF was 58th and Houston was 67th. Houston's 15th ranked nonconference NET strength of schedule leads the conference.

HOUSTON CLICKING ON ALL CYLINDERS

Houston kept its momentum rolling with a third straight victory, improving its conference record to 5-3 with an 80-46 win against Temple on Jan. 20. The 80 points scored by the Cougars matched a season-high during conference play for any team in The American, with the 34-point margin of victory ranking second.

STEALS APLENTY

Temple's Jasha Clinton was the fifth player in The American to log six steals in a single game this season, hitting the mark against Houston on Jan. 20. Other players with six steals this year are East Carolina's Lashonda Monk (Dec. 16 at SMU), Tulane's Arsula Clark (at ECU on Dec. 22), Tulsa's Wyvette Mayberry (vs. Memphis on Jan. 9) and USF's Elisa Pinzan (at Tulane on Jan. 13).

30-POINT GAMES GALORE

USF's Elena Tsineke became the fourth different American player to surpass the 30-point plateau in a game this season against Wichita State on Jan. 6, tallying 31 in a Bulls victory. It was the sixth 30-point game overall in the conference in 2020-21, with Cincinnati's Iimar'I Thomas pacing the league with three (34 against Northern Kentucky, 32 against both Marquette and USF). Temple's Mia Davis (34 against FGCU) and East Carolina's Lashonda Monk (32 against Cincinnati) have also hit the mark this season.

UCF DEFENSE AMONG THE BEST IN THE COUNTRY

UCF remains the leading scoring defense in The American as of Jan. 21, pacing the conference with 50.6 points per game allowed in nine games. The Knights ranked fifth in the nation in scoring defense in the most recent release of the NCAA statistical standings.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Elisa Pinzan • Jr. • PG • USF

Pinzan shined in a nonconference road tilt at Tulane on Jan. 13, scoring a game-high 22 points while adding in seven assists, six steals and three rebounds in a 19-point win. Pinzan's steals total tied a conference high for the season against a Tulane offense that ranks third in The American in total turnovers per game. Pinzan leads all American players with 79 assists and 7.2 assists per game (ranked third nationally) and is also first in the conference in assist/turnover ratio (4.6, third in the NCAA).

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Jerkaila Jordan • Fr. • G • Tulane

Jordan secured freshman of the week honors for the fourth time this season after a pair of solid performances in a 1-1 Tulane week. She averaged 16.5 points on 61.9 percent shooting and 4.5 rebounds per game against No. 16/17 USF on Jan. 13 and on the road at Tulsa on Jan. 16. Jordan tallied 11 points, four boards, three assists, a block and a steal against first-place USF before going off for 22 points on 8-of-9 shooting (4-for-4 from 3-point range) with five rebounds and two steals in a victory over Tulsa.

Scored a team-high 23 points to lead the way for Temple in a competitive showdown with Cincinnati; hit 4-of-9 shots from 3-point range and added four rebounds, five assists and four steals

Logged 16.0 points per game for Tulsa in two starts during the week; tallied 11 points at Houston and contributed a team-high 21 points against Tulane

- UCF won for the fourth time in five games with a victory on national TV against Cincinnati, downing the Bearcats 57-41 Jan. 17 on ESPN.
- The Knights held onto their claim as the top scoring defense in The American in the win over Cincinnati, limiting the Bearcats to just 28.6 percent conversion from the floor while forcing 18 turnovers.
- Diamond Battles filled the stat sheet with 14 points, four rebounds, five assists and three steals. Brittney Smith added 12 points and five boards.

- Five different Houston players scored in double figures in the win against Temple, led by the 19 points of Laila Blair. Tatyana Hill added 16 points and 11 rebounds, and Miya Crump finished with 15 points.
