THE AMERICAN TODAY

USF EXTENDS AMERICAN LEAD TO 5-0

No. 18/19 USF extended its solo lead at the top of The American standings following a 66-48 home victory over Wichita State on Jan. 6. The Bulls have won a league-best seven straight games overall entering play this weekend.

UCF, TEMPLE ALSO REMAIN UNBEATEN

Joining USF among the remaining undefeated teams in American play entering the weekend are No. RV UCF and Temple. UCF won its third game in a row overall with a gritty 55-46 win over previously unbeaten Houston on Jan. 3. Temple won its third straight conference contest to join UCF at 3-0 following a 66-57 win at East Carolina on Jan. 6.

A MONSTER GAME FOR MUNUNGA

USF's Bethy Mununga earned American Co-Player of the Week on Jan. 4 following a phenomenal game against East Carolina for the first place Bulls last week. Mununga connected on 7-of-11 shots from the field and 9-of-12 attempts from the line to score 23 points, pulling down a career-high 21 rebounds in the win. Mununga is believed to be the third player in conference history to score at least 20 points and log 21 rebounds in a single game, joining USF's Alisia Jenkins (23/21 against Penn State on Dec. 21, 2014) and SMU's Alicia Froling (33/22 against Cincinnati on Jan. 27, 2016).

UCF DEFENSE HOLDING THE LINE

UCF remains the leading scoring defense in The American as of Jan. 8, pacing the conference with 50.3 point per game allowed in six games. The Knights ranked sixth in the nation in scoring defense in the most recent release of the NCAA statistical standings.

THOMAS STILL ENJOYING ALL-AMERICA START

The leading scorer in The American, preseason co-American Player of the Year Iimar'I Thomas of Cincinnati remains on a historic scoring pace thus far in the 2020-21 campaign. Thomas has averaged 27.1 points per game while shooting .594 from the field over her first seven starts, which have featured 30-point outings against Northern Kentucky (34), Marquette (32) and USF (32), and a 24-point, 17-rebound game against Wichita State. Her points per game average remains just under five full points ahead of Courtney Williams' top conference mark of 22.4 points per contest for USF in 2015-16. Thomas ranked fourth in the country in points per game as of Jan. 7.

WEEKLY HONORS

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Bethy Mununga • Sr. • F • USF

Mununga shined in a pair of wins for first place USF last week, averaging 17.0 points and 14.0 rebounds per game while shooting .667 (12-of-18) from the field. After scoring 11 points and pulling down seven rebounds at Tulsa on Dec. 30, She erupted for 23 points, 21 boards (six offensive) and three steals in a win over East Carolina on Jan. 2. Mununga became just the third player in American history to score 20 or more points and pull down 21 or more rebounds in the game.

Iimar'I Thomas • Sr. • F • Cincinnati

Thomas continued her dazzling senior season with an All-America effort at Wichita State on Jan. 2, tallying 24 points, 17 rebounds (eight offensive), five assists and three blocks in a Cincinnati road victory. Thomas, the leading scorer in The American with 27.6 points per game and a .613 field goal percentage, ranks second in Division I in scoring as of Jan. 4.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Jerkaila Jordan • Fr. • G • Tulane

Jordan earned top conference weekly honors for the fourth time (third freshman of the week citation) in her rookie season after scoring 15 points on 7-of-10 (.700) shooting with three rebounds and three steals in a Tulane win over Memphis on Jan. 2. Through eight career games, Jordan ranks third in The American with 15.6 points per game, shooting at a .447 (46-of-103) clip.
