THE AMERICAN TODAY

WINNING STREAKS CONTINUE

The top four teams in The American standings each have sustained winning streaks of four or more games as of Feb. 16. No. 14/15 USF has officially won 10 straight games overall dating back to the nonconference schedule, one of the most impressive active winning streaks in the nation. Second place UCF has won five in a row in American play to rise to 10-2 overall and 8-1 in conference. Tulane has earned six straight wins to pull back into solo third place in the league at 10-4 (14-5 overall). Houston capped last weekend with its fourth straight win and sits 9-4 in conference games and 12-5 in total this season.

HOW THE AMERICAN STANDS IN THE NET

As of the Feb. 15 calculation of the NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) rankings, a number of American teams remained in strong position for potential at-large NCAA Tournament berths. Conference leader USF set the pace at 15th in the NET. UCF was 45th, Houston was 54th and Tulane was 61st. Tulsa's fifth ranked nonconference NET strength of schedule led the conference, followed by Temple (11th) and Houston (26th).

LONG LAYOFFS LEAVE NO ILL EFFECTS ON USF, UCF

In spite of long layoffs away from game action during the stretch run of conference play, the top two teams in The American standings showed few ill effects in returning to the floor on Feb. 13. USF, which had not played since Jan. 13, took to its home court with a vengeance in a 67-46 win against Tulsa. UCF, over two weeks past its most recent game on Jan. 27, was equally impressive in a 70-51 road triumph at Cincinnati.

SIX STEALS A FAMILIAR MARK ALL SEASON

As of games completed on Feb. 13, a total of seven different American players have combined to notch six steals in a game at various points this season. USF's Elisa Pinzan has met the mark twice (at Tulane on Jan. 13, versus Tulsa on Feb. 13), along with East Carolina's Lashonda Monk, Tulane's Arsula Clark, Tulsa's Wyvette Mayberry, Temple's Jasha Clinton, Tulane's Jerkaila Jordan and Houston's Laila Blair.

UCF/USF DEFENSES AMONG THE BEST IN THE NCAA

UCF and USF remained the leading scoring defense in The American as of Feb. 16, with the Knights pacing the conference with 49.2 points per game and the Bulls checking in second at 52.4. UCF led the nation in scoring defense in the most recent release of the NCAA statistical standings, with USF in eighth.

Smith enjoyed her best game of the season as UCF roared back from an extended layoff with a 70-51 win over Cincinnati on Feb. 13. The junior forward tallied 25 points and 12 rebounds to go along with a block and two steals in 33 minutes on the road. Smith shot a remarkable 76.9 percent (10-of-13) from the floor and connected on 5-of-6 tries from the free-throw line.
