WEEKLY HONORS

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

D.J. Crowther • R-Sr. • RB • South Florida

Crowther had a career-night for the Bulls rushing for three touchdowns on only eight carries. He totaled 141 all-purpose yards (101 rushing, 40 receiving), while averaging 12.6 yards per carry. He became the first Bull to run for three touchdowns in a game since 2021.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Ayden Ducanson • 4th Year. • S • East Carolina

Ducanson intercepted his first career pass in the 20-17 come-from-behind win over Old Dominion, returning the interception 67 yards for a touchdown to tie the game at 17.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Trequan Jones • Sr. • RB • Tulsa

Jones returned the opening kickoff of the second half 98 yards for a touchdown to extend the Tulsa lead to three touchdowns. It marked the first Golden Hurricane return touchdown since 2024 as Tulsa defeated East Texas A&M 42-0.

HONORABLE MENTION

Collin Gill • Sr. • DB • Charlotte

Totaled seven tackles, two pass breakups and returned an interception 36 yards for a touchdown in a 26-21 loss to App State.

Chris Tooley III • Sr. • DB • Florida Atlantic

Totaled five tackles (one TFL), one forced fumble and one interception in a 16-10 win over FIU.

Marcus Stokes • R-Jr. • QB • Memphis

Threw for 258 yards and four touchdowns on 26-of-32 throwing in a 45-21 win over UT Martin.

Ajani Sheppard • Sr. • QB • Temple

Scored four touchdowns (three passing, one rushing), threw for 164 yards and rushed for 66 yards in a 49-48 overtime loss to Toledo.

Seth Davis • R-Jr. • RB • Tulsa

Rushed for 90 yards and a touchdown on nine carries in a 42-0 win over East Texas A&M.

AMERICAN NOTEBOOK

Polling Place

Sitting at 3-0, Tulsa is receiving votes in both the AP Poll and Coaches Poll. The Golden Hurricane are looking to be ranked in the Top 25 for the first time since 2020.

Putting Up Points

Memphis has scored at least 15 points in 87-consecutive home games. It is the second-longest active streak in the FBS and the fourth-longest streak overall since 1978.

Mean Green Rebuild

After reaching the 2025 American Championship game, UNT returns zero starters from its runner-up squad. The Mean Green added key offensive transfers in RB Jaheim White (West Virginia) and QB Tayven Jackson (UCF).

UNT is one of two FBS teams in the country to return zero starters from 2025 – the other is Iowa State.

Protecting the Ball

The Tigers have extended their active streak of games with two or fewer turnovers to 33 games, the second-longest streak by an American Conference team, the longest active streak in the conference and 6th longest active streak in the FBS.

Running of the Bulls

South Florida had a historic night against Delaware State, scoring seven rushing touchdowns in the win. The seven ground scores are the second most in program history, trailing only the eight scored against Kentucky Wesleyan in the opening game in program history.

Three is a Magic Number

A pair of American teams have started the season 3-0 – South Florida and Tulsa. It marks the first time since 2018 that the Bulls have started 3-0 and the first time since 2008 that the Golden Hurricane have hit the mark.

Shula Bowl

Florida Atlantic regained the Don Shula Award, defeating FIU 16-10 in the 24th edition of the Shula Bowl. The Owls lead the series 18-6 and have won eight of the past nine games in the rivalry.

Friday Night Lights

A double-header is on deck for the American on Friday night with a pair of games on ESPN. Army will travel to Philadelphia to take on Temple at 4 p.m. ET, followed by UAB hosting Navy at 7 p.m. ET.

American Tailgate Tour

The American Tailgate Tour is a new game day activation from the American Conference that will bring a conference-branded tailgate destination to selected football matchups beginning in 2026. The Tour gives the conference a traveling platform to reach fans directly, create original social content, and support sponsors inside the college football game day environment. 61 Initiative Partnership

The American Conference has partnered with the Shawn Clark Legacy Foundation and its 61 Initiative to prioritize coach physical and mental health.

Foundation representative Jonelle Clark addressed American head coaches at the 2026 American Kickoff in St. Petersburg, Florida, encouraging coaches to dedicate one extra minute daily to personal well-being. The conference has formally adopted the initiative across all football programs.

The American will issue player availability reports in advance of all conference games in the 2026 season. Reports will be published to the American website and on social media no later than two hours prior to kickoff for conference games.

Long Distance

Florida Atlantic's kicker Collin Rogers connected on a 60-yard field goal just before halftime in the 38-30 win over Navy. It set a new program record, while tying the second longest made field goal in American Conference history.

In week 3, Tulane's Cooper Helmke connected on a 58-yard field goal to set a Green Wave record, while tying the fourth longest in American history.

Streak Extender

Tulsa defeated Oklahoma State 24-10 in Week 1, marking the first times since 1952 that the Golden Hurricane have defeated the Cowboys in consecutive games.

Top 25

American Conference teams will play a combined eight non-conference games against teams ranked in the preseason top 25 polls in the 2026 season. That ledger includes games against three of the top six teams and four of the top 10 teams.

Ground Attack

Army and Navy both eclipsed 500 rushing yards in the same day for the first time since 2017. In Week 1, Army ran for 569 yards, while Navy totaled 506 rushing yards.

Home Cooking

Navy has won 79-consecutive games at home when leading after three quarters, the nation's longest streak

Coach of the Week

Memphis head coach Charles Huff was named the Bear Bryant National Coach of the Week after leading the Tigers to a 27-21 comeback win over UNLV in Week 0.

Bowling Partner

American squads played in a conference-record nine postseason games last season, including Army, East Carolina, Memphis, Navy, UNT, Rice, South Florida, UTSA and Tulane.

The American won five of those games, trialing only the Big Ten and ACC among all conferences for postseason wins.

Now and Then

Tulane had won 19 American Conference games in its first eight years in the conference and has 28 wins in the American in the last four seasons, including two championships.

Us Vs. Them

The American was the only conference in the nation to earn non-conference wins over teams from the Big 12, Big 10, SEC and ACC during 2025.

Select Company

The American produced three teams with 11 or more wins in 2025 (Navy, UNT, Tulane). The only other leagues with at least three 11-win teams were the Big Ten, Big 12, and SEC.

A handful of quarterbacks will return as starters this season for American teams.

Speaking of Quarterbacks

Florida Atlantic's Caden Veltkamp and UTSA's Owen McCown lead the group of returning signal callers in the American.

Veltkamp ranked among the nation's top passers in 2025, finishing 1st in completions per game, 3rd in pass completions (345), 3rd in pass attempts (515), and 5th in passing yards (3,641).

McCown returns for his third season as UTSA's starter after finishing second in the American with 30 passing touchdowns against just seven interceptions in 2025.

Hayes Eyes More Records

Tulsa sophomore QB Baylor Hayes set freshman program records last season in 200-yard passing games (6), total offense (2,346 yards), and touchdown passes (12). Hayes enters his second season aiming for additional school marks.

Rolling in December

Tulane has reached the American Conference Championship Game in four consecutive seasons, hosting three times and winning two titles.

Going Bowling

The Rice Owls have appeared in three bowl games since 2022 after playing in just six bowl contests combined from 1961-2014. Rice competed most recently in the 2025 Armed Forces Bowl.

Commander in Chief's Trophy

Navy will look to claim the Commander in Chief's Trophy for the 19th time and the third consecutive season in 2026. No team has won the trophy more than two years in a row since the Midshipmen earned that distinction from 2003-09.

Army will look to reclaim the Commander in Chief's Trophy for the 11th time and the first season since 2023.

Battle of the Bones Continues

The rivalry between Memphis and UAB will continue on October 10 when the two clash for the Battle of the Bones. UAB leads the all-time series 11-7, including taking last years game 31-24.

New Playoff Format

The 12-team College Football Playoff field features automatic bids for champions of the ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, and SEC, alongside the highest-ranked champion from the American, CUSA, MAC, Mountain West, Pac-12, or Sun Belt. The remaining seven spots go to the highest-ranked at-large teams. Notre Dame secures an automatic berth if ranked inside the Top 12.

COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

The Bracket

The format of the College Football Playoff is built on a 12-team bracket. Four automatic bids will be given to the champions of the ACC, Big Ten, Big 12 and SEC, with one automatic bid coming from the highest ranked team from the remaining conferences. The remaining seven at-large bids will be given to the best remaining teams from any conference.

- Notre Dame receives an automatic bid if it is ranked in the CFP Top 12 on Selection Day. If so, six (6) at-large bids would be awarded.
- Seeds 1-4 receive first-round byes
- Seeds 5-12 play first-round games at the higher seed's home stadium
- Any automatic qualifiers ranked outside the top 12 will be placed in order at the bottom of the seeding.
- The No. 1 seed will select its quarterfinal bowl site and the semifinal site into which it will advance should it win its quarterfinal game.
- The No. 2 seed, followed by the No. 3 seed, will then select from the remaining quarterfinal bowl sites. Those two teams will be assigned to the remaining semifinal.
- The No. 4 seed will be assigned to the remaining quarterfinal bowl site.
- With the four highest-ranked schools' bowls selected, their four CFP Quarterfinal opponents will be dictated by the bracket (i.e., No. 1 vs. No. 8/9 winner, No. 4 vs. No. 5/12 winner, No. 2 vs. 7/10 winner; No. 3 vs. 6/11 winner.)
- The CFP bracket will follow the selection committee's rankings, with no modifications made to avoid rematches between teams that may have played during the regular season or are from the same conference.
- The bracket will remain in effect throughout the CFP (i.e., no re-seeding).
- All 11 games will be under the CFP umbrella with the administrative policies determined by the CFP.

Selection Committee

A dedicated group of high-integrity football experts, with experience as coaches, student-athletes, college administrators and journalists, along with sitting athletics directors, comprise the CFP Selection Committee. Each fall, the committee meets in person to rank the top 25 teams, assign the schools to the 12-team playoff bracket and assign the CFP Quarterfinal and CFP Semifinal bowl sites. Members of the committee are Troy Dannen, Mark Dantonio, Doug Gillin, Mark Harlan, Ivan Maisel, Gus Malzahn, Chris Massaro, Randall McDaniel, Mike Riley, Jeff Tedford, Wesley Walls, Carla Williams, and Hunter Yurachek.

We have officially transitioned from 'American Athletic Conference' (and the acronym 'AAC') to 'American Conference' on first reference and 'American' in subsequent references.
