The MIAA "Holiday" Men's Basketball Tournament

Prior to the start of the MIAA Postseason Tournament in 1980-81, the conference conducted a men's "holiday" tourney on an annual basis for 14 years. The event first took place from 1959-60 through 1964-65 with one tournament being hosted by each of the six schools in the league at the time and including two guest teams.

Guest schools during this period included Eastern Illinois and St. Ambrose (Iowa) in 1959, Central Arkansas and future MIAA member Northeastern State (Okla.) in 1960, Arkansas Tech and Southern Illinois (Carbondale) in 1961 and 1963, Tarkio (Mo.) and William Jewell (Mo.) in 1962, and future MIAA members Lincoln and Pittsburg State in 1964.

After a seven-season absence, the tournament was revived in time for the 1972-73 campaign and hosted for eight years by former member Southwest Missouri State (now Missouri State) in Springfield until it was discontinued following the 1979-80 event. The tourney included the seven conference members at the time and one guest team.

Guest schools during this period included future MIAA members Southwest Baptist in 1973, Missouri Southern in 1974 and 1980, Pittsburg State in 1975 and the Missouri-St. Louis in 1977, as well as Southern Illinois-Edwardsville in 1976, Drury (Mo.) in 1978 and Evangel (Mo.) in 1979.
