CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

In the 2022-23 academic year, the MIAA had three National Championship Teams: Central Oklahoma Wrestling and Pittsburg State Men's Indoor and Outdoor Track and Field.



The MIAA has captured nine NCAA Division II titles since 2021.

Nine teams have appeared in postseason games the last four seasons. (UCM, UCO, ESU, FHSU, MWSU, UNK, NW, PSU,WU).



The last time the MIAA didn't have multiple teams in the playoffs was 2009.

The MIAA has gone 12-1 in postseason bowl games since 2017.

Six MIAA football student-athletes were named to the 2022 CoSIDA Academic All-America Team.



Two MIAA instituitions will have new head coaches competing in their first full season: Missouri Western's Tyler Fenwick and Nebraska Kearney's Ryan Held.

MIAA Eight MIAA head coaches either played or were an assistant coach at an institution currently in the Association.



Three MIAA head coaches are leading the programs that they played for: Higgins (ESU), Eckert (NSU) and Bradley (MSSU).

Five MIAA teams ranked in the Division II's top-25 in total attendance: PSU, NW, WU, UCM, ESU.

HOW THEY STARTED-

MIAA

The MIAA was founded in 1912. Founding members include Central Missouri and Northwest Missouri.



Washburn's first college football game occurred in 1891. The first year of the "Turnpike Tussle" with Emporia State in football occurred in 1899, many years before the creation of the country's first Turnpike.



Emporia State's first college football game occurred in 1893. In 1926, the Hornets went undefeated, outscoring its opponents 144-3.



Central Missouri's first college football game occurred in 1894. Legendary Kansas basketball coach Phog Allen coached the UCM football team from 1912-1917, going 29-17-2.



Central Oklahoma's first college football game occurred in 1902. They have over 600 wins, two national championships, and 26 conference championships.



Fort Hays State also competed in its first college football game in 1902. Two seasons later in 1904, the Tigers scored a 17-0 victory over Kansas State.



Nebraska Kearney's first college football game occurred in 1905. Over the past 115 years, UNK has won nearly 600 football games and 32 conference championships.



Northwest Missouri started its college football program in 1908. Since then, they have played in nine NCAA Division II national title games while competing in Bearcat Stadium, the oldest stadium in use in Division II (1917).



Pittsburg State also started its college football program in 1908. The Gorillas, whose 729 all-time victories lead NCAA Division II football, have played in five NCAA Division II national title games.



Northeastern State played in its first college football game in 1909 and has claimed two national football championships during its 113 year history.



Missouri Southern played in its first college football game in 1968, winning a national championship just four years later in 1972.



Missouri Western began its college football program in 1970, playing its games at Spratt Stadium—one of the nicest facilities in Division II football and home to the Kansas City Chiefs Training Camp since 2010.



Combined, the MIAA has collected eight football national championships since its first in 1991 won by Pittsburg State. Northwest Missouri has won the Association's last seven football titles – most recently in 2016.






