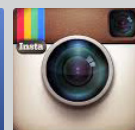

SEASON PREVIEW



The Texas Lutheran Bulldogs, under new Head Coach Jimmy Smith, were picked fifth in the Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference Preseason Men's Basketball Poll.

TLU received 23 voting points in the pre-season poll. The Bulldogs finished eighth in the SCAC standings last season and lost in the first round of the SCAC Championship Tournament.

In 2013-14, the Bulldogs posted an overall record of 9-17 with a conference mark of 3-11.

The Bulldogs open the year this Saturday with a road contest at Top 25 opponent University of Texas at Dallas.

TLU's first home game of the season comes Nov. 18 with a 7:30 p.m. matchup in Memorial Gymnasium with former conference rival Concordia Texas. The Bulldogs and Tornados each played in the American Southwest Conference before TLU joined the SCAC for 2013-14.

The 2014-15 season will be TLU's second year in the SCAC.

Smith comes to Seguin after spending the last two years at the helm of the Schreiner University men's basketball program, where he led a quick turnaround for the Mountaineers, amassing a 36-37 record in those two years.

Before Smith came to Schreiner, the Mountaineers' record in their Division III era was 92-253 (.270 win pct.). In just his second season, Smith guided Schreiner to its first winning season since joining the NCAA Division III, finishing 15-12 overall and 10-4

in the SCAC. Smith's squad finished second in the SCAC standings and reached the semi-finals of the SCAC Championship.

Last season, Smith's Mountaineers set school records (NCAA-era) for wins (15), winning percentage (.556), conference winning percentage (.714) and points per game allowed (68.9). He also coached the 2013-14 SCAC Co-Player of the Year and SCAC Defensive Player of the Year AJ Myres.

The Bulldogs have not had a winning season in men's basketball since the 2004-05 season, when the Bulldogs went 13-12 overall and 12-10 in the American Southwest Conference. The Bulldogs' best conference finish of the NCAA DIII-era came in 2003-04, when the Bulldogs were third in the ASC West Division with an overall record of 17-8 and a conference mark of 9-5.

The Bulldogs return their top two scorers from 2013-14, in the form of guards Garrett Wilkins (6-1, 170) and Jordan Kouremetis (6-0, 180). Wilkins is a senior guard, and Kouremetis is a sophomore guard.

Wilkins (Austin/Connally/Colorado Northwestern CC) has played in all 51 games since transferring to TLU for the start of the 2012-13 season. He has made 46 starts.

Wilkins averaged 14 points per game last season and led the team in that category. He was a SCAC Third Team All-Conference selection and finished eighth in the conference in scoring.

Kouremetis (San Antonio/O'Connor) earned SCAC Honorable Mention honors in 2013-14

and was the Bulldogs' leading scorer in conference play, averaging 16.2 points per game. He scored at least 20 points in five games, and all five of those games came in the final 10 games he played.

Kouremetis had a late-season injury that forced him to miss the final two weeks of the regular season. He was second on team in overall season scoring, at 13.4 points per game and shot 39.6 percent from the floor and 37.3 percent from the three-point line. He made team-best 47 three-pointers, taking 126 three-point shots, and he shot 84.7 percent from the free throw line.

The Bulldogs' projected starting lineup includes Kouremetis and Wilkins along with sophomore transfer Sterling Holmes (San Antonio/Antonian/Richland College) at point guard, senior Donte McGee (Victoria/Memorial/Texas A&M-Kingsville) at forward, and senior Thomas Verm (Sealy/Sealy) at center.

The 6-5 and 218-pound McGee averaged 6.2 points and 3.9 rebounds per game. He led the team in blocks, with 24. Verm, at 6-8 and 230 pounds, averaged 7.7 points and 4.3 rebounds in his junior year.

Two other players that appeared in every game last season – point guard Joseph Richardson (San Antonio/East Central) and guard Joshua Alderman (Needville/Needville) – also return for the Bulldogs.

Richardson made 24 starts and averaged 4.8 points and 2.6 rebounds per game. He notched 25 steals and 94 assists. Alderman averaged 3.5 points and 0.8 rebounds. He made two starts.

On April 7, 2014, Texas Lutheran University announced that Jimmy Smith, previously the head coach at Schreiner University, had been named the ninth head coach of the TLU men's basketball program.



"Jimmy Smith is one of the best young basketball coaches in Texas, and we are delighted he will lead the TLU men's basketball program," Texas Lutheran President Dr. Stuart Dorsey said at the time of Smith's hiring. "He had great success at Schreiner, and I know he

will be a winner here as well. TLU's athletics programs are on the rise, and Coach Smith will play an important role in the program's future success."

Smith comes to Seguin after spending the last two years at the helm of the Schreiner program, where he helped lead a quick turnaround for the Mountaineers, amassing a 36-37 record in those two years.

Before Smith came to Schreiner, the Mountaineers' record in their Division III era was 92-253 (.270 win pct.). In just his second season, Smith guided Schreiner to its first winning season since joining the NCAA Division III, finishing 15-12 overall and 10-4 in the SCAC. Smith's squad finished second in the SCAC standings and reached the semifinals of the SCAC Championship.

"I'm excited," Smith said. "I've known about TLU for a long time – both as a player playing against them and then coaching against them in the league. I've always had a lot of respect for the university. I think there's a lot of untapped potential, so I'm just trying to get in here, figure out exactly how things work and get things going in the direction I have in my mind, as soon as possible.

"I think everyone's goal is to try and win the conference. I have a lot of familiarity with these guys from coaching against them, so I think that's the goal next year. Let's figure out what we've got, figure out who we can add to the group to help us improve and start working towards winning the SCAC Championship next year."

Last season, Smith's Mountaineers set school



records (NCAA-era) for wins (15), winning percentage (.556), conference winning percentage (.714) and points per game allowed (68.9). He also coached the 2013-14 SCAC Co-Player of the Year and SCAC Defensive Player of the Year AJ Myres.

"We're really excited to have Jimmy Smith as the next head coach of the TLU's men's basketball program," Texas Lutheran Athletic Director Bill Miller said. "We believe he is the right man at the right time to elevate the program. He is an outstanding fit for both this campus and the community."

Before coming to Schreiner, Smith spent three years as an assistant coach at his alma mater University of Mary Hardin-Baylor. As both a player and coach at UMHB, Smith was part of a winning culture. During his three years as

an assistant coach, the Cru racked up a 70-18 record and qualified for three NCAA Tournaments.

Smith also enjoyed an outstanding playing career for UMHB, earning the school's Male Athlete of the Year award and All-ASC West Division recognition. He was also the first Cru basketball player to receive Academic All-District VI First Team honors.

Smith began his coaching career at Sam Houston State University. He joined the Bearkats as an assistant coach in 2004 and spent two years with the basketball program, helping the Bearkats to a 40-21 record during that span.

Smith is a husband and a father. Smith and his wife, Lori, are the parents of two young children.

Austin Falke was hired as an assistant men's basketball coach at Texas Lutheran in April 2014 after spending the last two seasons with current Bulldog head coach Jimmy Smith at Schreiner.



Falke was an assistant under Smith while also working as the head coach of the Mountaineers' junior varsity squad. During his time at Schreiner, Falke and Smith teamed together to lead the Mountaineers to a record-breaking 2013-14 season, setting

program-best marks in winning percentage and wins. Schreiner went to just its second and third conference tournaments in school history during Falke's tenure.

Falke came to Schreiner after graduating from Stephen F. Austin, where he enjoyed a three-year playing career. The Lumberjacks won back-to-back Southland Conference titles during his playing career and played in both the NCAA Tournament and the NIT.



After his playing career with SFASU was over, he spent the 2011-12 season as a graduate assistant coach for the 'Jacks. Falke graduated with a bachelor of science degree in kinesiology from Stephen F. Austin in August 2010. He earned a master's degree in kinesiology from SFASU in May 2012.

He played high school basketball for Thorndale, where he was named the 2007 Texas Association of Basketball Coaches Class A Player of the Year.

He is married to Rebekah Falke.

Thomas Orr joined the Texas Lutheran staff in the summer of 2014.

He comes to the Bulldogs after three years spent at the University of Mary-Hardin Baylor, first as a student-athlete, then as a coach. He enjoyed a stellar two-year playing career (2011-13) for the Crusaders, serving as the leading scorer for a team that advanced all the way to the NCAA Division III National Championship game during his senior season. He garnered



ASC All-West Division First Team honors that senior season, averaging 15.1 points and 5.2 rebounds per game.

He stayed on with the Cru for the 2013-14 season as an assistant coach as he finished up his degree. He graduated from UMHB with a



degree in sports management and a minor in business management in May 2014.

Orr is a native of Hutto, Texas and played high

school basketball for Hutto High School, earning both All-State and All-South Region honors and was named his district's MVP.

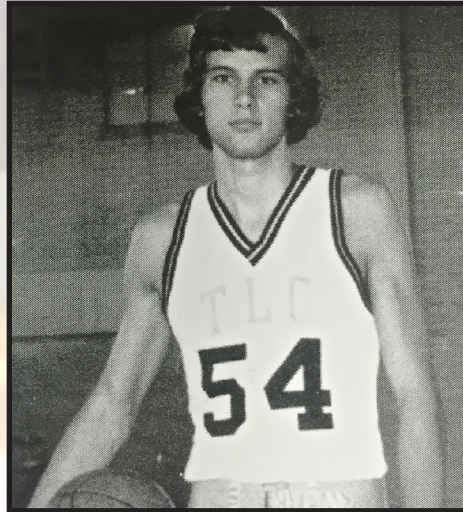

Jerald Reiner #12

Jersey No. 12, worn for four seasons by Jerald Reiner, was retired by Texas Lutheran University on April 25, 1997. Reiner was a two-time First Team NAIA All-American that established 16 TLU men's basketball records and led his team to three Heart of Texas Conference tournament appearances. Reiner was an Honorable Mention All-American his sophomore season, and he was the Heart of Texas Conference Freshman of the Year after scoring 594 points in his first year as a Bulldog. For his junior and senior seasons, Reiner was named the HOTC Player of the Year. His career records include: most points, scoring average, free throws made, free throws attempted, free throw percentage, three-pointers made, three-pointers attempted, three-point shooting percentage, and assists. His single-season records include: three-pointers made, free throw percentage, and assists. Single-game records include: points, free throws made, free throws attempted, three-pointers made. Reiner was inducted into the TLU Athletics Hall of Fame in 2007.



Steve Porter #54

During a campus visit his senior year in high school, Steve Porter caught the eye of Head Coach Jim Shuler in a pick-up basketball game. Shuler offered Porter a scholarship on the spot, and the rest became Texas Lutheran basketball history. Porter, a native of Sioux Falls, S.D., made an immediate impact on the Bulldog basketball program. In his four years as a starter, Porter and the Bulldogs produced an overall record of 73-36. Porter still holds school records for rebounds in a season, rebounds in a four-year career, fields goals made in a career, and rebound average in a career. Porter's career points record (of 2,039 - established prior to the three-point line) stood for 20 years before Jerald Reiner (2,523) broke it. Porter was a First Team All-Big State Conference selection three times, named to the All-NAIA District IV team twice, and named to the NAIA All-America Honorable Mention Team twice. Porter was on the Dean's List each semester, and his jersey number 54 was retired on May 2, 1977. Porter's was the first basketball jersey to be retired. He was inducted into the TLU Athletics Hall of Fame in 1989.
