GOLDEN LIONS TO FACE TIGERS SEEKING WINNING SEASON The University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff football team will end the 2019 season in the home finale against Texas Southern.

SEEKING WINNING SEASON UAPB football is seeking just its sixth winning season just returning to the SWAC in 1998 and the first since 2012. (1998: 8-3; 2000: 6-5; 2004: 6-3; 2006: 8-4 (lost SWAC Championship game); 2012: 10-2 (SWAC Champions).

BEST SINCE '12 UAPB's 5-5 mark is the best since the 10-2 season of 2012. The Golden Lions have surpassed the win totals from each of the previous six seasons (4 wins in 2014; 2 wins in 2013, 2015, 2017, 2018; 1 win in 2016).

SENIOR SENDOFF A total of nine players will suit up for UAPB for the final time: RB Taeyler Porter, WR Kolby McNeal, DB Blake Conner, LB A.C. Gilliam, OL Raynald St. Jour, Jayden Glover, and Bradley Burrell, DE Jalen Steward, and K Austin Krzeminski.

PORTER RUNS INTO RECORD BOOKS RB Taeyler Porter's 98-yard touchdown run in the Oct. 3 45-38 homecoming win over Lane is the longest run in school history and the third-longest play in the history of the Arkansas At Pine Bluff football program.

Porter's fourth-quarter touchdown run surpassed the record of Henry Wright, who had an 89-yard run against Wiley College in 1965. Porter's touchdown run is the second longest in the history of the Southwestern Athletic Conference, as Mississippi Valley's Hubert Owens had a 99-yard touchdown run against UAPB in 1980.

Only two plays are longer than Porter's 98-yard run in Golden Lion history. In 1998, Chris Akins' 100-yard interception return for touchdown at Alcorn State ranks as the longest play in school history. In 2006, Derrick Poole caught a screen pass from Christopher Wallace and took it 99 yards against Grambling in the Arkansas Literacy Classic in Little Rock for the longest passing touchdown in school history.

Porter (5-10, 202; Sr., Immokalee, Fla.) finished the contest with a season-high 182 rushing yards and two TDs and earned STATS FCS National Player of the Week Honorable Mention honors. He currently ranks third in the SWAC with 830 rushing yards and is fourth in the league with 10 touchdowns.

BALLARD III RANKS IN SWAC TOP 5 IN REC, YARDS, TDS WR Harry Ballard III (6-3, 205; Jr., St. Louis, Mo.) is a two-time SWAC Newcomer of the Week who is fourth in the league in receptions (49) and receiving yards (842), and tied for fourth in receiving touchdowns (nine). He posted his fifth 100-yard receiving game of the season at Prairie View A&M with 108 yards on three receptions, including a 77-yard TD reception in the fourth quarter. Ballard had a season-high nine receptions for 144 yards and two touchdowns against Grambling, with TD receptions of five yards in the third quarter and 24 yards in the fourth quarter. Ballard, who also has a rushing touchdown this season, hauled in his sixth scoring pass of the season in the win over Lane in which he caught six passes for 50 yards. Ballard earned SWAC Newcomer of the Week honors following the Alabama A&M game, catching five passes for 140 yards and three touchdowns in the 52-34 win. Ballard had TD receptions of 59 yards in the first quarter, 49 yards in the second quarter, and 24 yards in the third quarter. His second Newcomer honor came in the win at Tennessee State as he caught a season-high seven passes for 112 yards and scored on a three-yard touchdown run. Ballard scored his rushing touchdown with just under four minutes remaining to extend the UAPB lead to 31-24. After the Tigers' tied the score at 31-31 with 50 seconds remaining, Ballard caught three passes for 58 yards on the final drive, setting up Jeremy Brown's 17-yard touchdown reception on the final play. Ballard also caught five passes for a season-high 147 yards and two touchdowns against Langston, and had five receptions for 58 yards against Miss. Valley St.

NOTABLES vs. PRAIRIE VIEW:

- RB Taeyler Porter went over the 2,000-yard rushing mark for his career and now has 2,040 in 19 career games.
- WR Harry Ballard III posted his fifth 100-yard receiving game with three receptions for 108 yards and a touchdown. He is fourth in the SWAC in both receptions (49) and receiving yards (842) and tied for fourth in touchdowns (nine).
- WR DeJuan Miller caught a touchdown pass for the fourth straight game and had seven receptions for 91 yards. He ranks sixth in the SWAC in both receptions (40) and receiving yards (673) and is tied for seventh in touchdowns.
- DB Blake Conner and LB Kolby Watts each recorded their third 10+ tackle games of the season with 10 stops apiece.
- LB A.C. Gilliam recorded a season-high nine tackles.
- DE Jalen Steward made eight tackles and a career-high tying 3.5 tackles for loss.
- P Myles Pini had two punts downed inside the 20 and is second in the SWAC with 20 this season.

2018-19 Golden Lions Year In Review

The 2018-19 University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff athletics season can be defined by one word: **transition**. New leadership, new coaching hires, strong academic performance and outstanding individual accolades marked the past season. Here's a snapshot:

- **New Coaches Hired:** UAPB hired new head coaches in volleyball, soccer, and women's basketball. Chelsea Lucas was named head volleyball coach in February, Jeremy Winzer was hired as head soccer coach in early May, and Dawn Brown was named head women's basketball coach later in May.
- **Men's Cross Country Wins SWAC Championship; Lion Men Post Best Ever Finish In SWAC Commissioner's Cup Standings:** The UAPB men's cross country program won its first SWAC Championship since re-entering the conference in 1997 and its first conference crown since 1993. The men's indoor track and field team finished third, and the men's outdoor track and field team finished fourth. The Golden Lions combined to finish third in the standings for the C.D. Henry Award for best all-around men's program in the SWAC. The men's golf team made a nearly 100-shot improvement over last year's performance in the SWAC Championship in posting a fourth-place finish. Cross Country head coach Chris McCoy was named SWAC Coach of the Year, and men's golf coach Roger Totten was named SWAC Co-Coach Of The Year.
- **Student-Athletes Have Strong Year Academically:** UAPB student-athletes combined to post a 2.928 GPA for the 2018-19 year. A total of nine of the 14 teams had GPAs for 3.0 or better. 120 student-athletes earned a 3.0 or better in Spring 2019, including 31 with a perfect 4.0 grade point average. A total of 50 student-athletes graduated in Spring 2019.
- **Lion Teams Continue To Flourish In APR:** The women's cross country team, women's track team, men's tennis, and men's cross country team each earned a perfect Academic Progress Rate (APR) score of 1000 for the 2017-18 year. A total of 13 of the 14 UAPB teams achieved above the NCAA mandate of 930 over the four-year period from 2013-14 through 2017-18.
- **Athletic Academic Center Opens:** In December 2018, UAPB opened a new Student Athlete Academic Center in the J. Thomas May Field House. The center provides student-athletes with a lab with assistance from athletic academic advisors, computers, and programs to assist with their matriculation at UAPB.
- **Videoboard, New Turf Installed At Simmons Bank Field:** Renovations to the home of Golden Lions football were completed prior to the 2018 season. Simmons Bank Field was renovated with a new video board, field turf, scoreboards, and audio system to provide an enhanced fan experience.
- **New Floor, Seating Installed At H.O Clemmons Arena:** In January 2019, the renovated home for UAPB volleyball and basketball was unveiled. A new, brighter playing surface was installed with an updated UAPB logo emblazoned at center court as well as new basketball goals featuring the UAPB logo on each basketball support. The renovation also included newly installed bleachers in the UAPB Black and Gold colors with the Golden Lion logo.
- **Baseball Facility Upgrades:** The Torii Hunter Baseball Complex received facility upgrades this season. In February, new padding was installed around all fencing inside the newly named Bill Jones Field. In April, the Simmons Bank Pavilion opened behind home plate, featuring a team locker room, coach's offices, officials' locker room, press box, and concession stand.
- **McKnight, Harris Earn HBCU Basketball All-America Honors:** Martaveous McKnight and Shawntayla Harris earned BOXTOROW All-America honors. McKnight earned first-team honors after he led the SWAC in scoring at 20.3 points per game including a pair of 40-point games and ranked 33rd nationally in scoring. McKnight was also selected to represent the conference in the 3x3 National Championship Tournament during the Final Four. Harris earned second-team honors after lead the SWAC in blocked shots (2.5 per game) and was fifth in rebounds (6.7 per game).
- **John, Bibbs Set Track and Field Records:** Safiya John and Travis Bibbs had record-setting performances in the SWAC Track and Field Championships. John earned outstanding field performer honors in both the SWAC Indoor Track and Field Championships and the SWAC Outdoor Track and Field Championship. John set SWAC records in the heptathlon in both the indoor meet with 3,449 points and the outdoor meet with 5,257 points. Bibbs set school records in both the indoor triple jump (15.48m) and outdoor triple jump (15.54m) at SWAC Championships this season.
- **Bibbs Among Five Men's Track Athletes To Compete In NCAA West Outdoor Regionals:** Bibbs' mark earned in the SWAC Outdoor Championship helped him to qualify for the NCAA Outdoor Regionals in Sacramento, Ca. Rasheed McAlpin competed in the 400 meter hurdles, while teammates Wade Garner and Laurel Heath competed in the 800 meter dash. The trio along with teammate Malique Smith comprised the UAPB 4x400 relay team that qualified and competed in the NCAA West Regional.
- **Armstead Named To First Pro Bowl:** Golden Lion alum ('13) and New Orleans Saints left tackle Terron Armstead was named a Pro Bowl starter. Armstead, who is entering his seventh NFL season in New Orleans, started 10 games for the NFC South Champion Saints in 2018, protecting the league's all-time leading passer in QB Drew Brees.
- **Gillan, Sanchez Sign Professional Contracts:** A pair of Spring 2019 graduates signed professional sport contracts. Former UAPB punter and kicker Jamie Gillan signed a free agent contract with the Cleveland Browns of the National Football League in April. Baseball standout Ricardo Sanchez signed a free agent contract with the Kansas City Royals of Major League Baseball.

Head Coach Cedric Thomas

UAPB alum Cedric Thomas is in his second season as head coach of the Golden Lions.

In his first season, UAPB produced six players who earned All-Southwestern Athletic Conference honors, including four first-team selections. RB Tayerl Porter led the conference with 1,220 yards. SWAC Freshman of the Year in WR DeJuan Miller tied for the conference lead in receptions (56), was third in receiving yards (801), and was tied for second in receiving touchdowns (six).

K/P Jamie Gillan earned first team honors at both positions, was second in the conference in punting average (42.5), and led the SWAC with 20 field goals made. DL Jalen Steward was second on the team in tackles and first in sacks with seven.

UAPB went 2-9 in Thomas' first season at the helm, with the Lions losing four games by a touchdown or less, including a pair of overtime defeats.



Thomas returned home after spending six seasons at Alcorn State, initially coaching defensive backs (2012-15), before spending the last two seasons as defensive coordinator (2016-17). The Braves won four straight SWAC Eastern Division titles, including back-to-back SWAC titles in 2014 and 2015 and played in the inaugural Celebration Bowl.

The former Golden Lion cornerback began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Alcorn (2001) before becoming running backs coach at Tennessee-Martin for one season (2002).

Thomas had two stints at Mississippi Delta Community College as defensive coordinator (2003-04; 2007-11), sandwiched around coaching defensive backs at Itawamba Community College (2005-06).

After beginning his collegiate playing career at Mississippi Delta Community College, Thomas was a two-year letterman and started his senior for the Golden Lions. He graduated from UAPB in 2001 with a bachelor's degree in recreation and earned his Master's degree in administration from Alcorn in 2015.

The Cleveland, Miss. native is married to Kelunda, and the couple has one daughter, Loegan. Thomas also as a son, Cedric Jr.

2019 UAPB OFFENSIVE NOTES UAPB ranks third in the SWAC in total offense, averaging 438.8 yards per game. The Golden Lions rank eighth in rushing offense, averaging 156.0 ypg. UAPB ranks second in passing offense, averaging 282.2 ypg. The Golden Lions rank fifth in scoring, averaging 30.4 ppg.

- **Protecting The Pocket:** UAPB is second in the SWAC in fewest sacks allowed with 17.
- **Roaring Lions:** In games against Alabama A&M, Langston, and Tennessee St., UAPB gained 1,598 yards and scored 142 points. The Golden Lions gained 645 yards at Alabama A&M and had back-to-back 50-point games vs. AAMU and Langston for the first time since returning to the SWAC in 1997.
- **2 Is Better Than 1:** Both quarterbacks Shannon Patrick (142-226, 2207 yards, 18 TD, 13 INT) and Skyler Perry (50-90, 621 yards, 6 TDs, 4 INT) have both anchored the position. Patrick, who threw three TD passes at Alabama A&M, led three second half touchdown drives in the win at Tennessee State, including two in the final four minutes of the game. Patrick completed a then career-high 21 passes in 28 attempts for a season-best 334 yards and three touchdowns in the win vs. Miss. Valley St. Against Grambling, Patrick set career highs in completions (22), touchdown passes (four), and rushing yards (31). Patrick ranks 2nd in the SWAC in passing yards, is third in passing TDs and also has a rushing touchdown. Perry threw three TD passes in back-to-back games at Alabama A&M and vs. Langston and has a rushing touchdown as well.
- **Face Of The Program:** Senior RB Taeyler Porter (162-830-10; 5.1 avg.) ranks third in the SWAC in rushing yards and is fourth in touchdowns. Porter, who won the SWAC rushing title last season with 1,220 yards on nine touchdowns, has 10 career 100-yard rushing games (three this season), including tallying a season-high 182 yards and two touchdowns vs. Lane in the homecoming that included a school record 98-yard TD run. Porter carried the rock 18 times for 130 yards and one touchdown in the win at Alabama A&M, and then had his second 100-yard rushing game of the season against Tennessee St. with 18 carries for 107 yards and two touchdowns while also catching two passes for 33 yards and a touchdown.
- **Quiet Assassin:** TE Jeremy Brown caught TD passes in games against Alabama A&M, Langston, and Tennessee State, including the game winner on the final play at TSU. He has 14 receptions for 228 yards and three TDs this season.
- **Genuine Moments:** WR DeJuan Miller caught a touchdown pass for the fourth straight game as he had a season-high seven receptions for 91 yards and a touchdown at Prairie View A&M. Miller caught three receptions for 38 yards and a TD at Jackson St, made a then season-high six receptions for 88 yards and a career-high tying two touchdowns against Grambling, and hauled in five passes for 90 yards and a TD against Miss. Valley St. In the last six games, Miller has caught 30 passes for 490 yards and five touchdowns (16.3 ypc). He had his first 100-yard receiving game of the season and fifth of his career with 101 yards on three receptions against Lane. Miller caught a season-high tying six passes for 72 yards against Southern. At Alabama A&M, he caught five passes for 98 yards and a touchdown, his first receptions of the season. On the season, Miller is sixth in the SWAC in receptions (40) and receiving yards (673), and tied for seventh in TDs (six).
- **Wilkes Unleashed:** WR Josh Wilkes has been a big-play presence throughout the season. After making his season debut at Tennessee State, his production has continued to increase. Wilkes made five receptions for 29 yards against Southern, before his second-straight five-reception game for 73 yards and one touchdown against Lane. Against Valley, Wilkes tied a career high with seven receptions for 138 yards and one touchdown, and caught three passes for 34 yards against Grambling. He posted his second 100-yard game of the season Saturday against Jackson St., catching four passes for 117 yards. He has 28 receptions for 430 yards and two touchdowns this season.

2019 UAPB DEFENSIVE NOTES UAPB ranks fourth in the SWAC in total defense, yielding 381.9 yards per game. The Golden Lions rank third in rushing defense, allowing 151.5 ypg. UAPB ranks sixth in passing defense, allowing 230.2 ypg. The Golden Lions rank seventh in scoring defense, allowing 29.1 ppg.

- **Getting Home:** The Golden Lions have made at least one sack in 15 of the last straight games dating to last season and 36 overall during that time. UAPB is seventh in the SWAC with 21 sacks. Xavier Mitchell leads the team with 4.5 sacks (t-9th/SWAC) and is one of 11 players with at least 1/2 sack.
- **Tied For Fifth In SWAC In INTs:** After making only five interceptions last season, the defense made at least one interception in eight straight games from Alabama A&M to Jackson St.. Freshman Jordan Brown's fourth-quarter pick against Grambling gave UAPB a chance to win late in the game. Against Miss. Valley St., Martevious Washington, Shawn Steele, and Jalen Steward each had a pick against the Delta Devils. Jalon Thigpen's fourth-quarter pick sealed the win at Alabama A&M. Paul Reeves' third-quarter pick vs. Langston led to a touchdown drive. Henri Murphy's second-quarter interception stopped a Tennessee St. drive. Both Blake Conner and Shawn Steele had INTs against Southern, and Steele's INT on the final drive against Lane sealed the win. Blake Conner recorded a first-quarter interception at Jackson St.
- **Man Of Steele:** DB Shawn Steele made interceptions in three straight games earlier this season (vs. Southern, vs. Lane, vs. Miss. Valley St.), and is tied for third in the SWAC in interceptions (three), and is tied for the conference lead in pass breakups (13) and passes defended (16), including back-to-back career-high three PBUs vs. Langston and at Tennessee St. Steele picked off a second-quarter pass against Miss. Valley St. that ended a potential scoring drive. Steele's fourth-quarter pick against Lane was the second of two takeaways (fumble recovery) on consecutive possessions late in the game. He also nabbed a second-quarter pick against Southern. He has 42 tackles and two fumble recoveries this season.
- **Turnover Turnaround:** After making only two takeaways in the first five games of 2018, the defense has forced at least one turnover in 14 of the last 16 contests. The Golden Lions have forced 13 takeaways in the past six games (2 vs. Southern, 4 vs. Lane, 4 vs. Miss. Valley St., 2 vs. Grambling, 2 at Jackson St.). UAPB's takeaway total against Lane (three fumble recoveries, one interception) is the most in a game since 2015. The defense has forced 28 turnovers in the last 15 games (15 INTs / 13 FR), including 18 this season (10 INTs / 8 FR).

2019 UAPB SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES UAPB ranks fifth in both gross punting average at 37.4 yards per punt, and net punting average at 34.6 yards per punt. The Golden Lions are fourth in kickoff returns, averaging 21.2 yards per return. UAPB is third in punt returns, averaging 10.9 yards per return.

- **Runnin' Ralph:** Tyrin Ralph leads the SWAC in punt returns, averaging 12.0 yards on 13 returns. He averaged 18.5 yards on a pair of returns against Grambling, including a season-long 35 yards return in a series of great returns this season, including a 25-yard punt return at Tennessee State to set up the first touchdown for UAPB. Ralph made his second-touchdown catch of the season against Valley, a diving 17-yard reception late in the second quarter. On the season, he has 25 receptions for 266 yards and two touchdowns, has rushed three times for 17 yards, and is averaging 29.4 yards on eight kickoff returns.
- **G'Day, Myles:** Punter Myles Pini (pronounced PY-nee) is second in punts downed inside the 20 with 20. The freshman from Queensland, Australia is tied for second in the SWAC with seven 50+ yards and has the longest punt of the season in the conference at 72 yards at TCU. He averaged a season-high 46.3 yards on four punts against Lane, including three 50+ yard punts (53, 52, 52), and had a season-high three punts downed inside the 20 against MVSU. Pini is tied for seventh in the SWAC in punting, averaging 37.4 yards per punt.
- **Clutch In A Pinch:** UAPB baseball catcher Austin Krzeminski (pronounced krez-MEN-skee) has worked on his 'swing' during the fall for Golden Lion football. Due to an injury to K Zack Piwniczka (pronounced piv-NIS-ka), Krzeminski, who last kicked as a junior in high school, converted five of six extra points in the win over Langston, and converted one PAT at Tennessee St. He also handled all kickoff and has one touchback and one tackle on special teams in the last seven games.

GOLDEN LIONS IN YEAR TWO OF THOMAS ERA UAPB alum Cedric Thomas is in his second season as head coach. The Golden Lions went 2-9 in his first season with wins over Cumberland in September and ending the year with a Southwestern Athletic Conference road victory at Texas Southern. The Golden Lions were more competitive than the record indicates, losing four games by a touchdown or less, including a pair of overtime defeats.

YOUNG, ROARING LIONS Second-year head coach Cedric Thomas is remaking the Golden Lions the old fashioned way, building the foundation with young players. UAPB has 60 underclassmen on the roster, 44 of them freshmen. There are only 26 upperclassmen on the roster with only 10 seniors.

NEW FACES ON COACHING STAFF Thomas added several new faces to his coaching staff. Jonathan Bradley was named defensive coordinator and defensive line coach after spending the previous five seasons as assistant defensive line coach at North Carolina Central. Bradley spent four seasons in the NFL as a defensive lineman with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers and Detroit Lions. A four-year player at Arkansas State, Bradley began his coaching career at his alma mater before his tenure at NCCU.

Jason Onyebuaga (An-Yay-BOO-wah-ga) was hired as run game coordinator and offensive line coach after spending the previous five years at NCCU as offensive line coach and later as co-offensive coordinator. He also coached at Syracuse and North Carolina, and as a player was an all-conference performer at Northern Illinois.

Another key addition to the athletic department was the hiring of Director of Sports Performance Rashad Harris, a former linebacker at Louisville. Harris has spent more than 15 years in coaching, teaching, and strength and conditioning. Collegiately, he has coached at Florida, Alabama A&M, and Colorado State.

- The UAPB Sports Network launched August 31 from Ft. Worth, Tex. as UAPB Football will air in Central Arkansas in Pine Bluff (KPBA FM 99.3) in Little Rock (KARN 920 AM).
- A new coaches show, Lions Roar All Access, debuted on Monday, Sept. 9, on location from the 410 Lounge in Pine Bluff. The show airs locally on KPBA 99.3 FM.
- In August, UAPB Athletics and Cox Sports Television announced a partnership to air the television version of Lions Roar All Access across 18 states which began Sept. 11.
- Also this fall, UAPB Athletics announced a partnership with Keemotion that will allow their technology will allow the volleyball, women's basketball, and men's basketball teams to video record their practice sessions at the touch of a button using artificial intelligence and have instant film study with their respective teams. Additionally, the Keemotion system will also allow the ability to video stream volleyball, women's basketball, and men's basketball contests online through uapblionsroar.com.

HUNTSVILLE, Ala. – The University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff football team opened conference play with a 52-34 win at Alabama A&M in the Southwestern Athletic Conference opener for both teams.

Keshawn Williams rushed for 206 yards on 21 carries, and Taeyler Porter rushed 18 times for 117 yards and one touchdown. Harry Ballard caught four passes for 132 yards and three touchdowns as quarterbacks Skyler Perry (11-15, 109 yards, 3 TDs) and Shannon Patrick (9-14, 196 yards, 3 TDs) combined to throw for six touchdown passes.

UAPB (1-1 overall, 1-0 SWAC) scored on the first drive, taking just three plays to move 58 yards. Perry and Ballard connected on a 59-yard scoring pass to take a 7-0 lead. Following a tying AAMU touchdown, the Golden Lions scored on their third possession, as Zack Piwniczka connected on a 30-yard field goal to give UAPB a 10-7 lead with 7:17 to play in the first quarter.

After Alabama A&M (1-0, 0-1) took the lead at 14-10 with just over five minutes to play in the opening period, the remainder of the first half was dominated by UAPB.

Tyrin Ralph caught a 28-yard scoring pass from Shannon Patrick with just over two minutes to play in the first quarter to give the lead for good, 17-14.

In the second quarter, Perry drove the Golden Lions 80 yards in 10 plays, as Jeremy Brown's eight-yard TD reception extended the lead to 24-14.

Following a short punt, it took Arkansas At Pine Bluff just one play to score, as Patrick and Ballard connected on a 49-yard scoring pass to give the Golden Lions a 31-14 lead they would take to the halftime locker room.

UAPB stayed aggressive in the third quarter, as Monroe Beard III recovered a surprise onside kick to begin the half. From there, Patrick threw a 27-yard touchdown pass to Dejuan Miller three plays later to extend the lead to 38-14.

Following an Alabama A&M punt, the Golden Lions scored two plays later, as Porter scampered 53 yards for a touchdown to extend to a 45-14 lead with 12:18 to play in the third quarter.

After a Bulldog touchdown, UAPB scored for the final time as Perry threw a 24-yard touchdown pass to Ballard to take a 52-21 lead at the mid-way point of the third quarter.

PINE BLUFF, Ark. – The University of Arkansas At Pine Bluff football team rolled to a 53-15 win over Langston in the home opener at Simmons Bank Field.

The Golden Lions (2-1 overall, 1-0 SWAC) matched their win total for all of 2018 in winning back-to-back games for the first time since 2014.

Skyler Perry completed seven of nine passes for 189 yards and three touchdowns, and Shannon Patrick completed nine of 12 passes for 135 yards and a touchdown.

Harry Ballard recorded his second straight 100-yard receiving game with 147 yards on five receptions and two touchdowns. Jeremy Brown caught a touchdown pass for the second straight game, and Kolby McNeal added a touchdown reception.

Taelyer Porter rushed 11 times for 51 yards and two touchdowns, and Keshawn Williams and Omar Allen added touchdowns runs as the Golden Lions improved to 2-1 for the first time since 2012.

The Golden Lions scored on their second possession of the game. Perry completed a 60-yard pass to Ballard on the first play of the drive, leading to Williams' two-yard run to give UAPB a 6-0 lead with just over 11 minutes to play in the opening quarter.

UAPB broke the game open by scoring on four straight possessions in the second quarter. Porter scored on a one-yard run to complete a nine-play, 59-yard drive to extend to a 13-0 lead. Following a Langston punt, it took the Golden Lions only two plays to score. Following a Williams' run for 12 yards, Perry connected with Brown on a 35-yard scoring pass for a 20-0 lead.

On the next UAPB possession, it was the Porter show as he carried the ball on four straight plays for 39 yards with a five-yard scoring run to extend to a 27-0 lead.

Following a Langston touchdown, the Golden Lions answered with a six-play, 78-yard drive, ending with a five-yard scoring pass from Patrick to McNeal as UAPB took a 34-6 halftime lead.

After halftime, the offense continued to roll as the Golden Lions scored on its first three possessions of the third quarter. A Henri Murphy interception set up a Perry-to-Ballard 10-yard scoring pass and a 40-6 lead.

Langston added a field goal before the Golden Lions drove 78 yards in four plays. Perry hit Ballard on back-to-back passes of 18 and 49 yards, the last for a touchdown to extend to a 46-9 lead.

After a three-and-out and a short punt, it took just three plays to score as Omar Allen scored on a five-yard run for a 53-9 lead.

NASHVILLE, Tenn. – Shannon Patrick's 17-yard touchdown pass to Jeremy Brown on the final play of the game gave the University of Arkansas At Pine Bluff football team a dramatic 37-31 win over Tennessee State at Hale Stadium.

UAPB improves to 3-1 overall for the first time since 2012 and have won three in a row also for the first time in seven years in defeating Tennessee State (1-3) for the first time in five series meetings.

After Tennessee State tied the game at 31-all with 50 seconds remaining, Patrick drove the Golden Lions 75 yards in seven plays. Patrick completed passes of 16, seven, and 35 yards to Harry Ballard III to move the football to the TSU 17. After a pair of incompletions and a final timeout by UAPB with four seconds remaining, Patrick connected with Brown on the scoring pass down the seam on the left hash mark on the final play for the walkoff win.

In a game that saw three touchdowns scored in the final 3:51, the Golden Lions extended to a 31-24 lead with a 10-play, 85-yard drive. Patrick's 40-yard completion to Brown on third and seven moved UAPB into Tiger territory, with the drive ending with a Ballard three-scoring run to extend the lead to 31-24 prior to TSU's game-tying drive before the exciting finish.

Patrick completed 14 of 21 passes for 253 yards with two touchdowns and one interception. Ballard posted his third straight 100-yard receiving game with seven catches for 112 yards. Porter rushed 18 times for 107 yards and two touchdowns, and caught two passes for 33 yards and a touchdown. Keshawn Williams rushed 13 times for 84 yards and one touchdown, caught two passes for 22 yards, and had 76 yards on three kickoff returns.

UAPB scored first on a 74-yard, eight play drive ending with Porter's three-yard scoring run and a 7-0 lead with 9:23 to play in the first quarter.

After TSU tied the game late in the first quarter, UAPB scored a pair of touchdowns in the second quarter. Porter's 20-yard scoring pass from Patrick, followed by Porter's 12-yard scoring run prior late in the first half extended the lead to 19-7.

With UAPB leading 19-10 entering the third quarter, Tennessee State scored back-to-back touchdowns to take its first lead at 24-19 with just under four minutes to play in the period.

Williams 35-yard kickoff return sparked the Golden Lions to regain the lead on the ensuing possession. The six-play, 60-yard drive led to Williams' 22-yard scoring run and a 25-24 lead UAPB would take into the fourth quarter, setting up the exciting finish.

RB Taeyler Porter's 98-yard touchdown run with just over four minutes remaining lifted the Arkansas At Pine Bluff football team to a 45-38 homecoming game win over Lane at Simmons Bank Field.

Porter's career-long run on one of the longest plays in school history broke a 38-38 tie as UAPB improved to 4-2 for the first time since 2012 and won its homecoming game for the first time in seven years as well.

DB Shawn Steele made two takeaways in the final 3:28. His forced fumble and fumble recovery on the ensuing possession following the Porter touchdown run set the stage for the conclusion following a Golden Lion punt.

Steele's interception with just over one second remaining at the UAPB 15 sealed the win.

Porter rushed 21 times for 182 yards and two touchdowns. QB Shannon Patrick completed 17 of 25 passes for 268 yards and two touchdowns with two interceptions. WR DeJuan Miller caught three passes for 101 yards, and Josh Wilkes (5-73-1) and Harry Ballard III (6-50-1) each had touchdown receptions.

After trailing 3-0, UAPB scored 24 of the game's next 27 points. Patrick's eight-yard scoring run late in the first quarter gave the Golden Lions a 7-3 lead with just over a minute to play in the first quarter.

Following a forced fumble by Solomon Brooks that was recovered by Isaac Peppers at the Lane 19, UAPB scored four plays later. Porter's two-yard run on 4th and 1 extended the lead to 14-3 with just over 11 minutes to play until halftime.

Later in the quarter, Porter and Wilkes connected on a 49-yard touchdown pass to extend to a 21-3 lead with just over six minutes to play. After the teams traded field goals, UAPB led 24-6 at halftime.

Lane (2-3) rallied in the second half, outscoring UAPB 25-7 in the third quarter to tie the score at 31-all after three quarters.

In the fourth quarter, Skyler Perry's nine-yard scoring run with just under 13 minutes remaining gave UAPB a 38-31 lead. Lane tied the score on the ensuing possession, leading to the late-game finish.

The University of Arkansas At Pine Bluff football team used a steady, methodical approach in defeating Mississippi Valley State 38-6 at Simmons Bank Field.

UAPB (5-2 overall, 2-1 SWAC) matched its best start in seven years headed into the bye week by scoring in every quarter and using a great balance of rushing, passing, and defense in compiling a nearly 200 yards difference in total yards (489 – 299).

RB Taeyler Porter set the tone, rushing 20 times for 95 yards, 56 of them in the first quarter, and two touchdowns.

His early rushing opened the way for the passing game, as Shannon Patrick had season highs in completions (20), attempts (27), and passing yards (334) while tying a season high with three touchdown passes and no interceptions.

Josh Wilkes caught a season-high seven passes for 138 yards and one touchdown. DeJuan Miller (5-90-1) and Tyrin Ralph (2-31-1) also caught scoring passes from Patrick. The defense made three interceptions, recorded three sacks, and allowed no points and only 139 yards total offense over the final three quarters. Martevio Washington, Shawn Steele, and Jalen Steward each had an interception.

Trailing 6-0 late in the first quarter, the Golden Lions drove 75 yards in eight plays, as Porter's four-yard scoring run put UAPB ahead 7-6 with just over three minutes to play in the first quarter.

Early in the second quarter, UAPB drove 62 yards in seven plays, capped by Miller's 32-yard TD reception from Patrick to extend the lead to 14-6 with 10:38 to play until halftime.

UAPB scored again just before halftime, driving 66 yards in five plays in only 51 seconds. Ralph's diving 17-yard touchdown catch in the near corner of the end zone gave the Golden Lions a 21-6 lead at halftime.

Late in the third quarter, UAPB drove 61 yards in seven plays, as Porter's one-yard run made the score 28-6 with just under a minute to play in the period.

Following Steward's interception, it only took two plays for the Golden Lions to cash it in. On the first play of the fourth quarter, Wilkes caught a screen pass, ran through a tackle and found the opening through the defense on a 56-yard touchdown play and a 35-6 lead.

The University of Arkansas At Pine Bluff football team nearly erased a 13-point fourth-quarter deficit but fell to Grambling 39-33 at Simmons Bank Field.

The contest featured a safety, an interception return for touchdown, three missed/botched extra points, four lead changes, 10 touchdowns and 72 points.

Trailing 39-23 with just under eight minutes remaining, the Golden Lions rallied. Driving 65 yards in 10 plays, Harry Ballard III's 24-yard touchdown catch from Shannon Patrick brought UAPB within six with just over four minutes remaining.

On Grambling's ensuing possession, Jordan Brown's first-career interception and 19-yard return gave the Golden Lions possession at the GSU 11-yard line with just over three minutes remaining.

After moving the football to the Tigers' three-yard line with just over a minute to play, UAPB lost yards on third down and two. On fourth down, Grambling intercepted a pass its' 12-yard line with 57 seconds to play.

Patrick completed 22 of 35 passes for 291 yards and a career-high tying four touchdowns, two of them to Ballard who caught a career-best nine passes for 144 yards. DeJuan Miller caught six passes for 84 yards and two touchdowns.

Trailing 7-0, UAPB responded with a seven-play, 75-yard drive, ending with Patrick's 17-yard scoring pass to Miller to bring the Golden Lions to within 7-6 with 4:26 to play in the opening quarter.

Following a Grambling score on a safety, UAPB took the football back two plays later as Xavier Mitchell forced and recovered a fumble at the UAPB 43.

On the next play, a 46-yard Patrick-to-Ballard connection led to a score three plays later, as Taeyler Porter scored from a yard out as the Golden Lions took the lead for the first time, 12-9, with less than two minutes to play in the first quarter.

After Grambling (3-4, 1-2) scored touchdowns on consecutive possessions to take a 22-12 lead, the Golden Lions responded prior to halftime. A six-play, 57-yard drive ended with Miller's leaping 24-yard touchdown reception to cut the UAPB deficit to 22-19 at halftime.

The Golden Lions opened the third quarter with a 15 play, 69-yard drive, converting two third downs and one fourth down. Patrick's five-yard scoring pass to Ballard put UAPB back in front, 26-22.

Grambling answered with a touchdown drive of its own on the ensuing possession to regain the lead for good, then added 10 fourth-quarter points prior to the UAPB late-game rally.
