- (1) Most amount of points = Kruse Award Winner
- (2) Points are determined by the number of teams participating in that particular sport. First place points will be given equivalent to the number of teams competing in that particular sport. Second place, third place, etc. in descending order.

EXAMPLE

If there are 8 teams competing = 1st place gets 8 points, 2nd place gets 7 points, 3rd place gets 6 points, etc. If there are 5 teams competing = 1st place gets 5 points, 2nd place gets 4 points, 3rd place gets 4 points, etc.

- (3) Provisionary schools and associate members are not eligible for Kruse Award and are not considered in awarding points for regular season finishes
- (4) If two or more teams tie for the same regular season finish spot, the point value for their corresponding finishes are added together and divided by the number of teams tied, which is then awarded to all of the tied teams.

 Example If there is a two-way tie for first place, you would add 8+7 and then divide by 2 so that each team receives 7.5 points
