**CREDENTIALS**

The South Alabama Athletics Strategic Communications Office will issue credentials to WORKING press only. Passes for spouses, children or friends will not be issued. These credentials are non-transferable and any unauthorized use of a credential will result in the pass being immediately revoked.

**WEEKLY LUNCHEON**

USA will hold a media luncheon with head coach Steve Campbell, coordinators Kenny Edenfield and Greg Stewart, and select student-athletes beginning at 12:30 pm every Monday prior to a Saturday game throughout the season (the week two luncheon will be Tuesday at 12:30 pm due to Labor Day). The luncheon and interviews that follow will take place at the football field house on the west side of campus.

**SUN BELT CONFERENCE TELECONFERENCE**

The Sun Belt Conference conducts a weekly teleconference with each of the 10 head coaches in the league. Coach Campbell will be available at 10:44 a.m. CT each week.

**PRACTICES**

On Tuesdays and Wednesdays the last 30 minutes of practice is open to the media; interviews with coaches and student-athletes will be conducted following the workout. Please contact Fremund in advance if you are interested in conducting interviews and/or attending a practice session, so an escort can be made available.

**INTERVIEWS**

In-person interviews with members of the coaching staff and student-athletes can be arranged by calling or e-mailing Fremund. Interviews with student-athletes MUST be arranged in advance through the Strategic Communications Office. Players are generally available after practice on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Phone interviews are also available, but will be arranged around the student-athletes' class and practice schedules. Student-athletes' phone numbers are not available under any circumstance. All phone interview requests must be made 24 hours prior.

**POSTGAME INTERVIEWS**

After a 10-minute cooling off period, requested players and coaches will be made available to members of the media. The Jaguar locker room is CLOSED both at home and on the road. Requested players and coaches will be escorted by a South Alabama Strategic Communications staff member to the designated interview area in the lobby of the main offices on the west side of Ladd-Pebbles Stadium.

For road games, USA will adhere to the home team's postgame policies and procedures.

**OPENING KICK**

- ▶ The Jaguars will open the season on the road against an opponent from a Power Five conference for the third time in the last four years.
- ▶ This is just the fourth time since the program's inception in 2009 that South will take on a nationally-ranked opponent.
- ▶ USA is 1-2 all-time against top-25 foes, with the results including:
  - ▷ L, 10-30 at #23 Mississippi State, 9/22/12
  - ▷ W, 42-24 vs. #19 San Diego State, 10/1/16
  - ▷ L, 7-44 vs. #10 Oklahoma State, 9/8/17
- ▶ The Cornhuskers are the only team the Jags have faced from the Big Ten Conference, with the two schools previously meeting in Lincoln during the 2015 season.
- ▶ It marks the first time South will kick off prior to noon since visiting Mississippi State at 11 a.m. (CDT) on Sept. 3, 2016.
- ▶ Jaguar redshirt freshman cornerback **Tyrone Legette's** father, also named Tyrone, was a three-year letterwinner at Nebraska as a cornerback from 1989-91.

**NOTES FROM THE LAST NEBRASKA MEETING**

- ▶ Only two current members of the Jaguar program — **Jalen Thompson** and **Tyree Turner** — played in the previous match-up with the Cornhuskers.
- ▶ Thompson was credited with five stops and a pass defended in his first-ever start on the road at the collegiate level.
- ▶ South managed just 19 yards on the ground, the third-lowest total in program history.
- ▶ The 313 yards passing for the Jags that day is the most ever recorded against a Power Five conference opponent.
- ▶ Nebraska's 561 yards of total offense set an opponent game record at the time and remain the sixth-highest total surrendered by the Jaguars in the team's 10 years of competition.

**NOTES ON CAMPBELL'S COACHING/PLAYING CAREER**

- ▶ Campbell's 162-62 mark as a head coach includes going 33-15 over four years at Central Arkansas from 204-17, where he guided the Bears to back-to-back NCAA Football Championship Subdivision playoff appearances before taking over at South Alabama.
- ▶ He has led two programs to national championships — Delta (Miss.) State in 2000 at the NCAA Division II level and Mississippi Gulf Coast C.C. to the 2007 National Junior College Athletic Association crown.
- ▶ In 20 seasons no team coached by Campbell finished below .500 prior to the 2018 campaign.
- ▶ Campbell has coached on the staffs of **Pat Dye** (Auburn graduate assistant, 1988-89) and **Jackie Sherrill** (Mississippi State assistant, 2003).
- ▶ Campbell and Jaguar coordinators **Kenny Edenfield** and **Greg Stewart** were teammates on Troy's 1987 NCAA Division II national championship squad.

**NOTES TO "OPEN" WITH**

- ▶ The Jaguars are 6-4 in season openers overall, which includes a 2-1 mark when starting the year on the road.
- ▶ South has a 4-5 record in their first road game of the season (the Jags played all seven contests at home their inaugural year).
- ▶ USA has split its two previous season openers at Power Five members, defeating Mississippi State, 21-20, to begin the 2016 campaign while dropping a 47-27 decision at Ole Miss the following fall.
- ▶ The win in Starkville marked the last time the Jaguars have begun the season with a victory.
- ▶ This marks only the second time in program history the Jags will open the year in August, as South fell 22-21 to Southern Utah at home on Aug. 29, 2013.

**START ME UP**

South returns just 10 starters from last year's squad, the fewest since only seven came back from the program's first-ever bowl team in 2015; that fall, the Jaguars actually began the campaign with wins in three of their first five contests before falling one victory shy of returning to postseason action. Entering Campbell's first season in charge of the program only one Jag offensive lineman had ever started a contest at the collegiate level, but this year USA is bringing back four-fifths of the group that opened the final six outings of 2018 including three individuals — **Brian Ankerson**, **Hadon Merchant** and **Troy Thingstad** — who started all 12 contests last year.

**MIGHTY MINTER**

With over 1,000 yards rushing the last two years rising senior **Tra Minter** enters the fall expected to carry the workload in the Jaguars' offensive backfield, but it's his versatility that has earned him more recognition — making three preseason watch lists and a trio of magazine's preseason all-Sun Belt Conference teams — than any other member of the program this summer. In addition to closing in on 1,000 yards in kickoff returns in his career, Minter is the only USA running back to catch more than 20 passes since the program's inception, a feat he has accomplished each of the last two seasons after posting 23 for 201 yards last fall.

**TURNER'S TIME**

Perhaps no Jag is more respected in the Sun Belt this fall than Turner, who is coming off a year that saw him set career highs for tackles (51), stops for loss (10) and sacks (four) as he was a second-team all-league selection. The rising senior was the top-rated individual from the program on SouthernPigskin.com's list of the top 100 players in the conference, coming in at No. 18 overall, as he enters his final season at the collegiate level needing just an assist behind the line of scrimmage and one sack to move into the top five in both categories in USA's career record book.

**DOUBLE THE FUN**

**Kawaan Baker** has reached the end zone on 14 occasions over the last two seasons, which is not only most on the team during that span but the sixth-highest total on South's all-time list in the category. Baker, however, holds the distinction of being the only individual in program history to rank among the top 10 on the career record list in both rushing touchdowns (sixth with nine) and touchdown receptions (tied for eighth with five).

**TESTED THOMPSON**

Arguably the most decorated high school recruit in the first 10-plus years of the program's existence, Thompson has lived up to those expectations in some regard as he begins his senior campaign already tied for the school's career record with eight interceptions and the lone individual to ever return multiple picks for scores. After sitting out 2017, he came back last fall to set career highs with 34 total tackles and eight passes defended.

**SOUTH BY THE NUMBERS**

Games played in 2018, combined, by LBs **Riley Cole** and **Chris Henderson** due to injury, which allowed **Taji Stewart** to record a career-high 28 stops after making a total of 17 tackles his first two seasons on the team.

Combined reception total, for 69 yards, for the duo of **Davyn Flenord** and **Jalen Tolbert** — South's projected starters at the wideout slots — as redshirt freshmen a year ago. Second-team all-conference selection **Jamarius Way** led the Jags with a school-record 61 catches for 855 yards and eight scores on his own last season.

Yards rushing recorded by Minter in the Jaguars' most recent outing — a 31-28 victory over Coastal Carolina on Nov. 23 last fall — setting a new school standard. Not only was it the first 200-yard performance in program history, it was the only one in the Sun Belt during the 2018 campaign.

**“GET ON CAMPUS”**

The University of South Alabama Board of Trustees voted on Nov. 10 to authorize the construction of an on-campus football stadium, paving the way for the USA Jaguars first game in the new stadium to be scheduled for September 12, 2020.

“This is a great day for the University of South Alabama and Jaguar athletics,” said USA President Dr. Tony G. Waldrop. “The outpouring of support from our students, alumni and fans for the stadium project, along with the contributions of our generous sponsors and donors, has created the momentum and foundation to move forward with an expected stadium opening in 2020.”

Phase II of construction includes:

- The shell of the press tower
- The shell of the athletics administration building
- Lower-bowl cast-in-place concrete for seating
- Installation of the primary underground utilities to the stadium

The new 25,000-seat football stadium will be located on the west side of campus, adjacent to the Jaguar Training Center, Football Fieldhouse and football practice fields and is set to include:

- Abraham A. Mitchell Field, named in recognition of a \$5 million commitment from Mitchell structured as a challenge gift — any donation to the stadium project from a minimum of \$500 to a maximum of \$250,000 per donor will be matched on a one-to-one basis — that will facilitate additional donations to Hancock Whitney Stadium
- A state-of-the-art video board — measuring 37 feet high by 100 feet wide with nearly 3,500 square feet of viewing space — and sound system
- The Michelob Ultra Terrace, named in recognition of a \$1 million gift from Budweiser-Busch Distributing Co., Inc.
- 16-seat suites, a club level with 800 seats, and premier chair-back and bench-back seating options

USA and Hancock Whitney announced Jan. 15 that the stadium will be named Hancock Whitney Stadium in recognition of a new, comprehensive financial partnership between the two organizations. Under the terms of the 10-year agreement, Hancock Whitney will provide the University of South Alabama with an array of financial and investment services.

The stadium’s estimated cost is \$74 million. Funding and debt service on bonded indebtedness incurred to construct the stadium will come from a combination of the athletic department, auxiliary enterprises and public/private funding. USA has already announced a \$2.5 million sponsorship from the Mobile County Commission, which will create the Mobile County Center for Academic Success, located within the stadium’s administration building. Discussions are ongoing with additional sponsors and donors.

Ticket sales for Hancock Whitney Stadium began on Monday, July 8, and in just over 24 hours all suites and loges were sold out.
