UW HOSTS PURDUE ON FRIDAY

- The Badgers return home on Friday when they host Purdue at the Kohl Center. Wisconsin has won 3 of the last 4 at home against the Boilermakers, including last season's 57-53 upset of No. 6 Purdue.
- Up next, UW travels to College Park, Md. to take on Maryland on Monday, Jan. 14. The Badgers have won 3 of the last 4 against the Terrapins.

KEY NOTES TO CONSIDER

- Wisconsin checked in at No. 17 in the Jan. 7 NET rankings and at the time was 1 of just 4 teams with 4 Quadrant 1 wins this season (*more on Page 3*).
- The Badgers are ranked 14th in defensive efficiency according to KenPom.com. UW is allowing 61.6 ppg and ranks 2nd in the NCAA with just 9.1 turnovers per game.
- Wisconsin has amassed 5 wins away from home this season, surpassing its total from last season (4). UW is 1 of just 5 major conference teams with 3 true road wins.
- UW is off to a 3-1 start to conference play for the 5th time in the last 7 seasons. The Badgers also opened Big Ten play 3-1 or better in 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2017.
- In his fourth season as head coach, Greg Gard has led the Badgers to a mark of 68-40 (.630), the 3rd-highest win percentage in program history (min. 60 games).
- Preseason AP All-American **Ethan Happ** is playing like a *postseason* All-American. Ranking 3rd in the nation in double-doubles (10), Happ ranks among the Big Ten's top 4 in scoring (19.3 ppg), rebounds (10.3 rpg) and assists (4.7 apg). (*Page 4*)
- **Happ** recently became just the 7th player in Big Ten history, and first since Indiana's Alan Henderson in 1995, to accumulate 1,800 career points and 1,000 rebounds. (*Page 10*)
- Since 2001-02 when Bo Ryan and Greg Gard got to Madison, Wisconsin owns the best conference win pct and most wins among Big Ten teams, posting a mark of 206-92 (.691). The Badgers also have the best home record over that span: 125-24 (.839).
- Sophomore **D'Mitrik Trice** ranks 3rd in the Big Ten and ranks 10th in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage, shooting 46.5% (40-for-86) from long range. The guard entered the season with a career high of 16 points, but has already topped that 5 times this season.
- Wisconsin ranks 2nd in the Big Ten shooting 38.5% from 3-point range. That figure is up from 33.5% a year ago. Defensively, UW is allowing opponents to shoot just 30.6% from long range and hit a mere 6.2 3FGs per game.
- Sophomores **Brad Davison** and **Nate Reuvers** are emerging lately. Davison ranks 3rd on the team averaging 10.3 ppg and Reuvers has scored in double figures in 5 of the last 7 games.



All-American Ethan Happ has earned 4 Big Ten Player of the Week honors this season and is the nation's only player averaging at least 17.0 ppg, 10.0 rpg and 4.0 apg.

- The Badgers snapped a 2-game skid with a convincing 71-52 win at Penn State on Sunday.
- Wisconsin tallied its 11th straight win over Penn State, including its 7th in a row at the Bryce Jordan Center.
- UW took control with a 22-6 run over 8:53 of the first half and scored the first 10 points of the second half to put the game out of reach.
- Wisconsin posted 17 assists with 7 turnovers, while forcing 16 turnovers.
- The Badgers shot 49.2% overall and 50.0% (8-16) from 3-point range, while holding PSU to just 37.7% from the floor and 20.0% from deep.
- Senior **Ethan Happ** finished with 22 points, 8 rebounds and 4 assists. He has scored at least 20 points 6 times this season.
- Sophomore **Brad Davison** posted 14 points, 7 rebounds and 3 assists. Sophomore **Nate Reuvers** scored in double figures for the 5th time in the last 7 games, while adding 5 blocks.

BIG TEN BEASTS

- Since 2001-02 when Bo Ryan and Greg Gard got to Madison, no team has been better than Wisconsin when it comes to Big Ten play. The Badgers have won 69.1% of their conference games over that 18-year span.

- The Badgers have also been the Big Ten's most dominant team at home during conference play, going 125-24 (.839) since 2001-02.
- Since 2002, UW has won 7 Big Ten championships (4 regular season and 3 tournament). Only OSU (10; 5 regular season, 5 tourn.) has won more titles during that era. MSU has 6 and ILL has 5.

SECOND-HALF SURGE

- Wisconsin is averaging 39.9 points in the second half of games this season, compared to 34.0 ppg in the first half.
- The Badgers are out-scoring opponents 599-489 in the second half, for an average margin of 7.3 points per game.
- UW is shooting 50.7% from the field after intermission and averaging a mere 4.1 turnovers in the second half.
- **Ethan Happ** has been a strong 2nd-half player:

TRIPLE-DOUBLE HAPP-ENING

■ **Ethan Happ** authored the 2nd triple-double in UW history with 10p, 11r, 12a vs. Coppin State. Josh Gasser is the only other Badger to record a triple-double (at Northwestern, 2011).

■ Happ's career-high 12 assists equaled the 3rd-highest total in school history and the most since 2000.

■ The NCAA's last player 6-10 or taller to record a triple-double with points, rebounds and assists was NU's Evan Eshmeyer (27p, 14r, 10a vs. IND in 1999).

■ Happ is the NCAA's first player to post at least 10p, 11r, 11a and 4b since Dwyane Wade in the 2003 Elite Eight vs. Kentucky (20p, 11r, 11a, 4b).

HAPP'S CAREER IN RARE AIR

Ethan Happ is putting together one of the greatest careers in Big Ten annals (more on page 10).

- With 1,030 career rebounds, Happ ranks 13th in Big Ten history (list on page 10).
- Over the last 20 years, only 2 Big Ten players have totaled 1,500p, 900r and 250a:

- Happ is 170 points from becoming the 4th player in Big Ten history with 2,000 points, 1,000 rebounds -- joining Greg Kelsner (MSU), Joe Barry Carroll (PUR) and Herb Williams (OSU).

HAPP OFF TO ALL-AMERICAN START

Senior **Ethan Happ** opened the season as just the 4th pre-season AP All-American in UW history. However, early in the season, he's playing like a *postseason* All-American.

- Averaging 19.3 points, 10.3 rebounds and 4.7 assists per game, Happ is the nation's only player averaging at least 17.0 ppg, 10.0 rpg and 4.0 apg.

In fact, over the last 20 years, LSU's First-Team All-American Ben Simmons (19.2 ppg, 11.8 rpg, 4.8 apg in 2015-16) is the NCAA's only player to reach those marks for an entire season.

- Historically speaking, Happ's numbers would put him in the company of some of college basketball's best players over the last decade.

Since 2007, a total of 10 major conference players have averaged at least 19.0 ppg and 10.0 rpg... 9 of the 10 have earned AP All-American, including 7 first-teamers.

- Happ ranks 3rd in the Big Ten in scoring, 2nd in rebounding, 4th in assists, 11th in blocks, 9th in FG Pct and 9th with a 1.8 assist-to-turnover ratio.

- Happ ranks 3rd in the NCAA with 10 double-doubles this season and has tallied at least 10+ points, 10+ rebounds and 5+ assists in 6 of 15 games. No other player in the country has more than 4 such games.

Happ ranks 2nd in UW history with 41 double-doubles, trailing only Joe Franklin (47 from 1966-68).

- In addition to his triple-double in the season-opener vs. Coppin State, Happ has topped 30 points twice this season: 30 points at Xavier and 34 points at Marquette.

- Happ's career-high 34 points at MU came on 16-of-21 shooting, posting the nation's highest FG% for players attempting at least 20 FGAs this season.

- A four-time Big Ten Player of the Week winner this season, Happ was also named to the Battle 4 Atlantis All-Tournament team, averaging 17.3 ppg, 13.0 rpg, 3.7 apg and 2.0 bpg over the 3-game series.

- Happ is the 3rd Badger with multiple games of 30+ points since 1995, joining Devin Harris (3) and Nigel Hayes (3).

D'MITRIK THRICE

Sophomore **D'Mitrik Trice** missed the final 23 games of the 2017-18 season with a foot injury, but he's making up for lost time this season.

- Trice ranks 20th in the Big Ten averaging 14.3 ppg, an increase of 4.9 ppg from last year's injury-shortened average of 9.4 ppg.

- Trice ranks 3rd in the Big Ten and 17th in the nation, shooting 46.5% from 3-point range, hitting 40-of-86. He is also 3rd in the conference averaging 2.7 triples per game.

Trice has had already some memorable performances from 3-point range this season. Trice went 5-5 from deep at Xavier, 7-8 vs. Oklahoma, 4-5 vs. NC State, 4-8 at Iowa and 4-7 vs. SSU.



TR-ICE IN HIS VEINS

D'Mitrik Trice ranks third in the Big Ten shooting 46.5% (40-86) from 3-point range.

The UW single-season 3FG Pct. record is 49.0% (75-153) by Tracy Webster in 1991-92.

- For his career, Trice is shooting 41.5% from 3-point range, hitting 90-of-217. That mark would rank 8th on UW's all-time 3-point shooting ledger (list on page 10).

- Trice entered the season with a career high of 16 points against Oklahoma as a freshman in 2016-17. Through 15 games this season, he has already topped that figure 5 times.

Trice opened the season with 21 points against Coppin State and 22 points at Xavier. He then poured in 25 points against Oklahoma, scored 18 vs. NC State and tallied 20 at Iowa.

- Trice has also authored 42 assists with just 21 turnovers on the year, good for a 2.0 assist-to-TO ratio. That figure would rank 9th in the Big Ten, but he falls 3 assists shy of qualifying.

ADDITIONAL INDIVIDUAL NOTABLES

- Sophomore **Nate Reuvers** has scored in double figures in 5 of the last 7 games, averaging 9.3 ppg over that stretch.

Reuvers ranks 4th in the Big Ten averaging 1.8 blocks per game. Reuvers tied the UW single-game record with 9 blocked shots against Stanford on Nov. 21.

Reuvers is shooting 35.3% from 3-point range, hitting 12-of-34 from beyond the arc. He is 1 of just 7 players 6-11 or taller to hit at least 12 3-pointers this season.

- **Ethan Happ** has started all 120 games of his collegiate career. He now trails only Josh Gasser (144), Alando Tucker (126) on UW's all-time starts list.

He is 12th in school annals with 3,501 career minutes played.

- Sophomore **Brad Davison** ranks 9th in the Big Ten averaging 1.3 steals per game.

- A total of 10 Badgers have scored in double figures in a game this season, including 5 off the bench.

DANGEROUS DAVISON

On the heels of one of the best freshman seasons in Wisconsin history, sophomore **Brad Davison** is starting to heat up in year number two.

- Over the last 5 games, Davison is averaging 15.0 ppg, scoring 24 against Savannah State and 26 at Western Kentucky.

- On the season, Davison is averaging 10.3 ppg. He averaged 12.1 ppg last season.

- Davison is 2nd on the Badgers and 11th in the conference, shooting 41.8% (23-55) from 3-point range. That's an improvement from his 35.5% (60-169) mark last season.

- Shooting 80.6% at the FT line (29-36), Davison would rank 10th in the Big Ten, but falls a couple FTAs short of qualifying. He is also 9th in the conference with 1.3 steals per game.

- A 2018 Big Ten All-Freshman Team pick, Davison ranked among the top 5 B1G freshmen in scoring, assists, steals, 3FG%, and FT% last season.

Davison set the UW freshman record with 60 3FGs and his 398 points rank 4th all-time among Badger freshmen.

3-POINT SHOOTING

Among the biggest improvement for UW in 2018-19 has been its production from 3-point range.

- The Badgers rank 2nd in the Big Ten and 31st in the NCAA shooting 38.5% from deep. Last season, UW tied for 11th in the Big Ten shooting 33.5% from 3-point range.

Wisconsin is on pace to have its best outside shooting percentage since hitting 39.1% during the 2004-05 season.

- UW is averaging 7.8 triples per game this season after connecting on 6.5 per game a year ago.

- Six different Badgers have hit double-digit triples on the season, including **D'Mitrik Trice** (40), **Brad Davison** (23), **Brevin Pritzl** (15), **Nate Reuvers** (12), **Aleem Ford** (10) and **Kobe King** (10).

- Trice ranks 3rd in the Big Ten and 17th in the NCAA shooting 46.5% from deep and is averaging 2.7 triples per game (3rd in the Big Ten).

STINGY BADGERS

- Wisconsin ranks 19th in the NCAA allowing just 62.2 ppg. The Badgers have allowed just 3 opponents to crack 70 points this season.

- UW has made a habit of holding foes far below their scoring average. Consider the following:

- KenPom.com puts the UW defense 14th in the nation with a 91.6 adjusted defensive efficiency (points allowed per 100 possessions, adjusted).

- Opponents are shooting just 40.9% overall against UW and a mere 30.6% from 3-point range. Foes are making just 6.2 3FGs per game.

- The Badgers have had a better FG% than their opponents in 13 of 15 games and have allowed just 1 team to shoot over 48% in any game.

HOME ON THE ROAD

- Wisconsin is 1 of 5 major conference teams with 3 true road wins on the year.
The Badgers are also 1 of 13 major conference teams with at least 5 wins away from home this season.
The Badgers won a total of 4 games away from home last season (3 road, 1 neutral).
- Dating back to last season, Wisconsin has won its last 4 Big Ten road games: at Northwestern, at Illinois, at No. 14 Iowa and at Penn State.
- Since 2013-14, Wisconsin is 67-38 (.638) away from home (road and neutral). That is the NCAA's 12th-best win percentage away from home over those 6 seasons.
Only Michigan State (72-36, .667) is better among Big Ten teams.
- Since 2001-02, the Badgers have tallied 102 true road wins, the top mark of any Big Ten team. UW's .528 overall road winning percentage is also 2nd among Big Ten teams.

- Wisconsin is averaging just 9.1 turnovers per game, a figure that leads the Big Ten and ranks 2nd in the nation.
- The Badgers also rank 3rd in the Big Ten and 17th in the NCAA with a 1.51 assist-to-turnover ratio, handing out 207 assists to just 137 turnovers.

Already one of the most-accomplished players in school history, Ethan Happ returns for his senior season looking to cement his status as one of the Big Ten's all-time greats. A two-time first-team All-Big Ten selection, two-time Big Ten All-Defensive Team pick and 2017 All-American, Happ enters the 2018-19 season with a chance to finish his career ranked in UW's top three of nearly every category. A Big Ten All-Freshman Team selection, Davison started the final 29 games of the season and flourished after taking over the point guard reins when D'Mitrik Trice was lost to a season-ending injury. The physical, combo guard scored in double figures 20 times in his debut season, demonstrating the ability to attack the rim and get to the foul line while setting UW's freshman 3-point field goal record (60). A two-sport prep standout on the hardwood and gridiron in Maple Grove, Minnesota, Davison enters his sophomore season healthy after playing 2017-18 with a left shoulder injury that included 8 dislocations during the season.

King averaged 19.0 minutes and 5.2 points per game during the first 10 games of last season before suffering a season-ending knee injury. King was granted a medical hardship and will retain his freshman eligibility in 2018-19. Even in the short sample size, the former Wisconsin Mr. Basketball showed off a versatile skill set equally adept at attacking the rim and stretching the floor.

■ **Khalil Iverson - Senior - Forward**

One of the most explosive athletes in the Big Ten, Khalil Iverson broke into Wisconsin's starting lineup last year as a junior and enjoyed the best season of his career. Now entering his senior season in 2018-19, Iverson has expanded his game from above-the-rim athlete to all-around player. In addition to highlight-reel dunks, Iverson has shown a knack for scoring in the lane and getting to the free throw line and embraced the role of defensive stopper last season. The Delaware, Ohio, native has scored 572 career points in 116 games at UW, including 47 starts.

■ **Brevin Pritzl - Junior - Guard**

After emerging as a starter in 2017-18, junior Brevin Pritzl returns for his fourth year at Wisconsin. The hot-shooting guard began his career with a medical hardship when a broken left foot cost him nearly the entire 2015-16 season. He bounced back to appear in 24 games as a redshirt freshman in 2016-17 before averaging over 29 minutes per game last season. Lethal from long range, Pritzl hit multiple 3-pointers in 13 games last season, including a career-high six triples and 20 points vs. Minnesota. The all-time leading scorer in De Pere High School history, Pritzl has rounded out his game since arriving in Madison, ranking third on the team in rebounds and tops in assist-to-turnover in 2017-18.

■ **Nate Reuvers - Sophomore - Forward**

Nate Reuvers enters year number two after a season of growth both on and off the court as a freshman. At 6-foot-11, Reuvers brings size to the UW frontcourt and now he has added 25 pounds to that frame. An inside-outside threat, Reuvers started 15 of the final 18 games as a true freshman in 2017-18 and finished the season averaging 5.3 ppg and 2.0 rpg in 16.6 mpg.

■ **Tai Strickland - Freshman - Guard**

A true freshman from Tampa, Florida, Tai Strickland brings quickness and athleticism to the UW backcourt. The son of Rod Strickland, a 17-year NBA veteran and former All-American at DePaul (1985-88), Tai Strickland is equally adept at distributing and penetrating on offense as he is locking up as an on-ball defender.

■ **Charles Thomas - Senior - Forward**

Charles Thomas IV begins his senior season in 2018-19 looking to provide valuable depth to the Badgers' frontcourt. In his first three seasons at UW, Thomas has appeared in 81 games, including 38 Big Ten contests and three NCAA tournament games. A sturdy, low-post presence, Thomas has shown the ability to score both inside and outside, scoring 160 career points and grabbing 134 rebounds while playing 7.3 minutes per game in his first 3 seasons.

■ **D'Mitrik Trice - Sophomore - Guard**

D'Mitrik Trice returns as a third-year sophomore in 2018-19 after missing the final 23 games and receiving a medical hardship last season with a foot injury. Trice, who debuted with a strong freshman campaign in a sixth-man role in 2016-17, took over the starting point guard reins a year ago for Wisconsin. Starting the first 10 games of the season, Trice averaged a team-high 31.5 minutes per game and responded by ranking third on the team with 9.4 points per game and second with 2.3 assists per game before the injury. A sturdy ball handler and sharp-shooter, Trice shot a team-high 41.8 percent from 3-point range in 37 games as a freshman in 2016-17. The Huber Heights, Ohio, native has earned a reputation as a natural leader after a successful prep career in basketball and quarterbacking his high school football team to a state championship.

► UW has reached the Sweet 16 or better in 4 of the last 5 seasons. No team in the nation has gone more frequently over that span. Kentucky is the only other team with 4 appearances in the last 5 seasons.

HEAD COACH GREG GARD

2016 JIM PHELAN NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR

A coaching veteran of more than 20 years, Greg Gard has expertly made the jump from assistant coach to head coach at Wisconsin. After assuming the head coaching reins on Dec. 15, 2015, Gard promptly led the team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons at the helm and will begin his fourth season as the head coach of the Badgers in 2018-19.

Initially an interim head coach, Gard proved quickly he was worthy of the head coaching position and was officially named as such on March 7, 2016. In three seasons, he owns the third-highest winning percentage in UW history, piloting the Badgers to a record of 57-36 (.613).

In his first two seasons with the head coaching title, Gard maintained a level of success that has become synonymous with Wisconsin Basketball. In his inaugural season as head coach, Gard led the Badgers to the 2016 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16, becoming just the second-ever first-year coach to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award. He followed that up by leading UW to the fifth-highest single-season win total in school history (27-10) and making a second-consecutive visit to the Sweet 16.

Gard is just the third coach in the last 20 years to pilot his team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons, joining UCLA's Steve Lavin (1996-97) and Gonzaga's Mark Few (2000-01).

Wisconsin maintained its place among the top of the Big Ten during the transition to Gard as well. In his first season, the Badgers finished the regular season in a tie for third place in the Big Ten standings — extending its streak of top-four finishes to a league-record 16th-consecutive season — with a 12-6 conference record. Gard led the Badgers to the most Big Ten wins by a first-year coach since 2004 (Bruce Weber, Illinois).

Gard's Badgers would post another 12-6 conference campaign in 2017, finishing second in both the regular season and the Big Ten tournament. Wisconsin would cap off its 27-win season with a signature win in the NCAA tournament, knocking off the nation's No. 1 team Villanova, 65-62, to advance to the Sweet 16.

Gard's first two seasons as head coach at Wisconsin continued a trend of lofty academic success, placing 15 players on the Academic All-Big Ten list. Over his 17 years in Madison, UW has boasted a total of 63 Academic All-Big Ten honors, trailing only Purdue and Northwestern over that span.

Long considered one of the top assistant coaches in the game, Gard served as an assistant at Wisconsin for 14-plus seasons, including the final seven as the associate head coach. In 2015, Gard was ranked as the fourth-best "X&O" assistant coach in college basketball by coachstat.net. In 2012, Gard was named No. 3 on the list of top assistant coaches in college basketball according to Bleacher Report. FOX Sports also listed Gard No. 10 on its list of the nation's top 25 assistant coaches.

Prior to coming to Wisconsin in 2001, Gard spent the previous two seasons as an assistant at UW-Milwaukee and served as an assistant coach at UW-Platteville from 1993-99.

Prior to joining Ryan's staff in Platteville, Gard spent three seasons at Southwestern High School and one at Platteville High School, where he served in junior high and assistant varsity coaching capacities.

In 2016, Gard and his wife, Michelle, partnered with the University of the Wisconsin and Wisconsin Foundation and Alumni Association, to launch Garding Against Cancer. This fundraising initiative raises funds and awareness for cancer research and care within the state of Wisconsin. In its first two years of hosting fundraising events across the state, GAC raised more than \$2 million dollars in the fight against cancer.

Gard is a 1995 graduate of UW-Platteville with a degree in physical and health education. He received a master's degree in counselor education from Platteville in 2007. Gard and his wife, Michelle, have two daughters, Mackenzie and Peyton, and a son, Isaac.

▶ Since the 2001-02 season when Greg Gard first joined the staff, the Badgers have compiled a 255-38 (.870) record at the Kohl Center.

▶ Over the last 15 seasons, UW is 125-25 (.833) in Big Ten home games, the best mark in the conference.

▶ Over the last 15 seasons, 191 of the Badgers' 255 home wins have come by at least 10 points (74.9 percent).
