\*\* The 2014 WIAC champion will be determined by using a combination of the regular-season dual-meet results and the conference championship standings. The finish in the regular-season dual-meet standings accounts for one-third of the criteria, while the WIAC Championship results account for the remaining two-thirds. Enter the number of points earned in each flight next with the corresponding total (1st place - 7 pts., 2nd place - 6 pts., etc.). Add all nine flights together to get the total championship points. Then determine the championship team place and points multiplied by 2 (1st place - 14 pts., 2nd place - 12 pts., etc.). The top four teams (in the overall standings) will participate in a team tournament in the spring to determine the conference's automatic qualifier into the NCAA Division III Championship.
