## Earthquake news report philippines

MANILA, Philippines - A powerful earthquake struck the central Philippines on Tuesday, killing at least one person, injuring dozens, damaged houses, two buildings used for coronavirus quarantine, bridges and a port. In the coastal town of Cataingan, a three-storey house collapsed when the ground sh called. A retired police officer has died, pinned to the wreckage, and rescuers have been searching for other members of his family who are missing. More than 40 people were injured as a result of the earthquake in Masbate province, according to disaster response officials. More than 100 people who have been quarantined in two damaged Catalan government buildings have been moved to school buildings to ensure their safety, the Civil Defense Office said. The quake also damaged roads, bridges and harbours. People should avoid immediately returning to damaged structures, said Rino Revalo, the provincial administrator of Masbate, for the ABS-CBN network. The quake with a magnitude of 6.6 struck at a depth of about 21 kilometers (13 miles) about 5 kilometers from Cataingan, said the Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology. Catainga resident Isagani Libatan said he was on his way to his aunt's for breakfast when his bike suddenly swelled when the ground got stuck. I thought it was my tire, but people suddenly snuck into panic from the fluctuating houses and then we lost electricity, Libatan said on the phone, and he turned it off because he felt a pretty strong jump. The quake caused the movement of The Philippines to defect, said Renato Solidum, who heads the government's Institute of Volcanology. It was felt in several provinces across the central region of Visayas. The Philippines lies along the Pacific Ring of Fire, the arc of faults around the Pacific Ocean, where most of the world's earthquakes occur. It is also hit by about 20 typhoons and tropical storms each year, making it one of the countries that have succumbed to catastrophes in the world. An earthquake of magnitude 7.7 killed nearly 2,000 people in the northern Philippines in 1990. In the northern Philippines, a moderate 5.4 magnitude earthquake struck in the Metro Manila area, seismologists and residents have been scathing, seismologists and residents say. There's no danger of a tsunami. The quake struck at 2:16 a.m. local time .m was .m the center of Balayan Bay, about 33 kilometres west of Batangas, or 100 kilometres southwest of the Manila subway. The Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology said the quake measured 5.4 and struck at a depth of 122 kilometers, which is relatively deep. The U.S. Geological Survey put the magnitude at 5.6. According to PHIVOLCS, it is tightened according to PHIVOLCS. Earthquakes have been shaking across the region, including in Manila and Quezon City, where some said the tremors were strong enough to wake them up. There were no immediate reports of injuries or casualties. The Philippines is on the so-called Pacific Rim The fire, the arc of fault lines that orbit the Pacific Basin, is submitting frequent and large earthquakes. Volcanic eruptions also occur frequently in the region. At least one person was killed and 43 injured when a magnitude 6.6 earthquake rocked central Philippines, damaging buildings and roads and sending residents in front of their homes. The shallow quake happened at 8.03am (00:03 GMT) on Tuesday, the US Geological Survey said. Many damaged houses, said Staff Sgt. Antonio Clemente in Cataingan, a town of about 50,000 people on the island a few miles west of the epicenter in the Samaria sea. It was really strong. According to the Philippine Institutes of Volcanology and Seismology, the quake struck about five kilometers (13 miles) from Cataingan. Local radio station spokesman Christopher Decamon said he saw emergency workers dragging the body of a retired police officer from the rubble of a three-storey house on the outskirts of Cataingana. The husband's wife escaped unharmed. Police have confirmed the man's death. Sixteen people were also injured in the city. The earthquake was really strong, ours were broadcast at the time, but they just ran out of the building, Decamon, a spokesman for the AFP, told AFP. At least 27 people were injured in nearby Palanah after being struck by fallen objects or when their motorcycles crashed, Chris Adique, a municipal police officer, told DZBB radio. Search and rescue efforts were still in place in the region. The lockdown, which has affected a quarter of the population, including the capital Manila, will be facilitated on Wednesday. We have spoken to several officials on the ground who say that rescue operations in Cataingan are going well, said Jamila Alindogan from the capital Manila from Al Jazei. Officials have raised the warning to four volcanoes in many parts of the southern and central part of Luzon, where it is necessary to see whether the impact of these volcanoes is directly related to the quake, she added. So far, the Philippine Seismological Bureau has recorded at least 24 earthquakes, the strongest of which was a magnitude 3.8. light damage to the food market in Cataingan. Scattered buckets and small fish scattered on the floor and pieces of cement fell from the pillar. People were out on the street. Red Cross president of the Philippines Richard Gordon has been uploading photos taken by his colleagues depicting buildings in Cataingan with corrugated iron roofs. Other photos, taken in the nearby town of Uson, show a closed road with a large crack across it. The Philippines is located on the Pacific Ring of Fire, an arc of intense seismic activity that stretches from Japan through Southeast Asia and across the Pacific Basin. It is also hit by about 20 typhoons and storms each year, making it one of the countries that are the most succumbing to disasters in the world. The magnitude 6.8 quake struck the southern island of Mindanao in December, killing at least three people, with dozens and damage buildings.
