Advanced Cruising Course

- 10 days/9 nights (normally 8 days/7 nights)
- Passage planning and vessel preparation for extended offshore passage
- Minimum 48-hour passage, including sailing safely at night
- Strengthen leadership and skippering skills to an advanced level
- Advanced navigation including modern GPS systems and AIS
- Boat systems and management
- Heavy weather sail planning and implementation
- Advanced safe boating practices
- Competently handle a 10 – 15 metre boat in varying sailing conditions
