

All members of St. Albert Youth Basketball League and any visitors in our facilities are held to the standards of behaviour listed below. Violating any part of the code of conduct could result in disciplinary action up to and including removal from the league. See the SAYBL Policies document on www.SAYBL.ca for details.

General Code of Conduct

- 1) I will respect the rights, dignity, and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background, religion, sexual orientation, gender identity or other part of their personal identity. I recognize that everyone is welcome in this league.
- 2) I will treat all members in the league the way I wish to be treated, including players, referees, coaches, parents, volunteers, visitors in our gym and members of the board of directors. I will not interfere with, bully, intimidate, or take unfair advantage of others in any form, whether in person, via email, on social media or any other platform with or without their knowledge.
- 3) I (and my guests) will refrain from any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, parent or volunteer such as booing and taunting, refusing to shake hands, or using profane language or gestures.
- 4) I will respect the officials and their authority during the games.
- 5) I will respect the board of directors and their authority during and between seasons.
- 6) I will learn and follow the rules of the game and the policies of the league to the best of my ability at all times.
- 7) I will respect the use of equipment and facilities provided. This includes following all rules regarding food and drink in the facilities, respecting off-limit areas and cleaning up after myself.
- 8) I will handle any disputes or disagreements with dignity and will report concerning behaviour to the board of directors to be handled in an impartial way.
