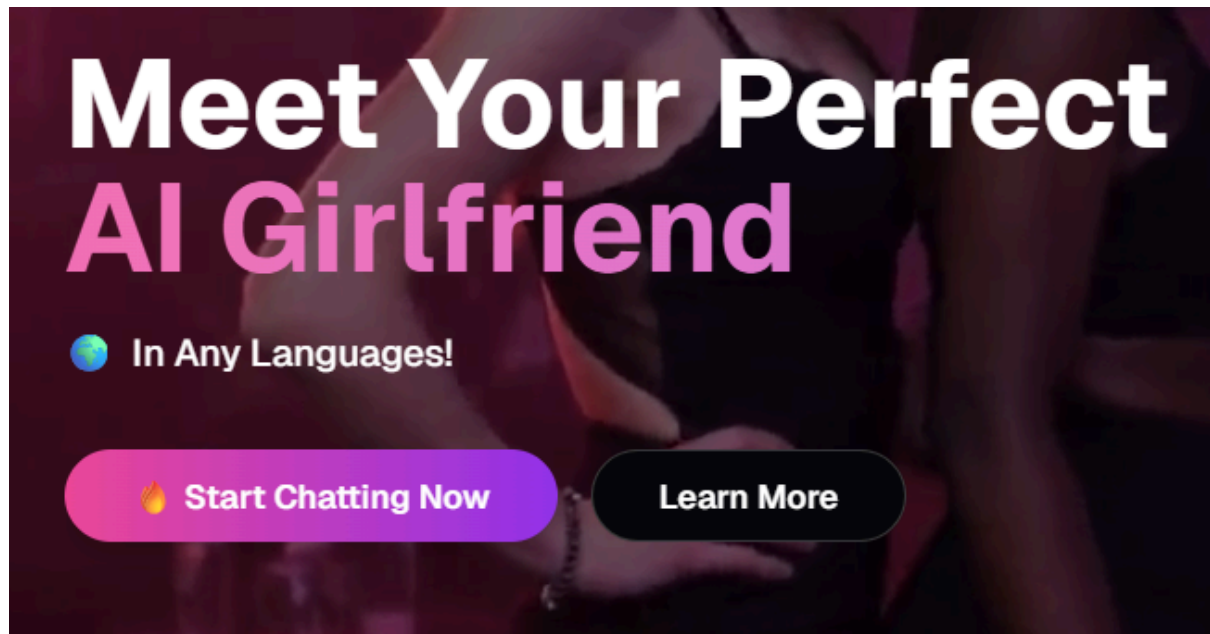


AI Girlfriend: Why People Are Talking About It?
