LEADERSHIP ELECTIONS

The National Title I Association relies on the leadership provided by its members to undertake its many projects and programs. A number of board positions are available in this election cycle.

The following positions will be filled this year for terms of office beginning January 2015.

VICE PRESIDENT

The Vice President assists the President and President-Elect in the leadership of the Association. The Vice President will become President-Elect in 2015 and President in 2016. The Vice President oversees the management of training for new members, and as President-Elect, he/she will serve as conference chairman of the 2016 National Title I Conference in Houston. The Vice President cannot be from the same state as the President or President-Elect (for 2014 that includes Alaska and Mississippi). The term of office is for one year.

SECRETARY

The Secretary takes minutes of all Association membership and Board of Directors' meetings. The Secretary works with Association Management to ensure that all organizational documents are posted in the Association's electronic files and made accessible to members or board, as appropriate. The term of this office is for two years: 2015 and 2016.

REGIONAL REPRESENTATIVES

The Association is divided into five geographically-based regions. Regional Representatives and their alternates serve as liaisons for the state members within their region. The responsibilities include communication, coordination, training, and outreach. Regional Representatives are elected by the members of their respective regions. The individual receiving the highest number of votes within their region will be elected as the Regional Representative; the individual receiving the second highest number of votes within their region will be elected as the Regional Alternate. Alternates participate in all board activities and vote if the Regional Representative is not able to attend.

Open Regional Representative and Alternate positions elected this year are for Regions 1, 3 and 5.

The term of office is for two years: 2015 and 2016.

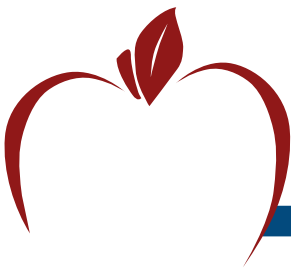
