










SAFETY NOTICE

GUIDELINE FOR PROHIBITED ITEMS

This guideline outlines the prohibited items that Sims Metal Management does not accept:

|  | Gas Bottles / Pressure Vessels / Accumulators: LPG, oxygen, acetylene, fire extinguishers or any other compressed gas cylinders. |
|  | Flammable Liquids: Fuels, oils, paints, thinners, spirits, etc. |
|  | Unclean Drums / Tanks: Drums and/or tanks that do not meet our requirements for acceptance of drums and tanks. |
|  | Corrosive Material: Acids and alkalines. |
|  | Explosives / Ordnance: Projectiles, military ordnance, explosive devices, detonators, fireworks or similar devices. |
|  | Poisons: Pesticide, mercury, herbicide. |
|  | Radioactive Material: Isotopes, industrial radiation gauges, radiation sources, primary x-ray or cancer treatment equipment. |
|  | Asbestos: Or any material containing asbestos. |
|  | CFCs: Devices that may contain ozone-depleting substances such as refrigerator compressors and air conditioning units. |
|  | Non – Metallic Refuse: Loose non-metallic items such as masonry, rubber, compostable items, soil, plastic, fabrics and glass. |

The above is necessary to fulfill our obligations in not only protecting the environment but also in providing a safe place of work for our employees and visitors. Prohibited items sent to any Sims Metal Management site, or loaded into Sims Metal Management bins, **may result in the associated costs for their removal/disposal being passed onto you.** A weight deduction for prohibited items will also be applied.
