## Our SimsMMway Principles

**All injuries, illnesses, operational exposures and adverse environmental impact associated with the workplace are preventable and can be safeguarded against. Accordingly, it is a condition of employment that:**

- Each employee must refuse to perform any task that cannot be performed safely or in a manner that prevents pollution.
- Each employee must understand and comply with the letter and spirit of each of our SHECS policies/protocols/plans/programs.
- Each employee is accountable for promptly reporting any observed unsafe act or condition, safety or environmental incident or breach of our SHECS policies to his/her supervisor.
- All operational activities must be evaluated for safety, health and environmental risks and not commence until adequate safeguards are in place.
- Each employee is a representative of Sims Metal Management and as such is accountable for his/her conduct at all times with regard to fellow employees, contractors and members of the community.
- The site/facility manager\* is accountable for maintaining safe, healthy and environmentally responsible working conditions and proactive communications with the community at all times.
- All supervisors and line managers must implement risk assessments as required and when equipment is purchased or when jobs or processes significantly change.

\* The site/facility manager is the person responsible for management of the facility.

**We are committed to:**


- Integrating safety, health, environmental, community and sustainability considerations into every aspect of how we conduct our business.
