

# Montecito Fire Department brings to you the **NEIGHBORHOOD FIRE PREVENTION PROJECT**



We must prepare now for the next fire. We have chosen your neighborhood to participate in the annual chipping program. You do the cutting and trimming and we'll help you take it away.

## How to participate in the annual program:

- **START CUTTING AND TRIMMING YOUR VEGETATION** at least three weeks before your scheduled neighborhood clean-up.
- **TAGGING AND TRIMMING** of roadside hedges and selected trees will be identified by Fire District personnel and trimmed by a professional tree trimmer service. Chain saws and chipping will be used to improve roadside clearance for emergency vehicles. If property owners choose not to have tagged vegetation trimmed, please contact the project coordinator prior to the project date.
- **CHIPPING SERVICES FOR SHRUB AND TREE LIMB MATERIALS WILL BE PROVIDED BY OUR CONTRACTOR.** This material should be stacked at the edge of a passable access road (trunk ends pointed to the center of the road) and the chipping crew will chip them on site. Leaves, succulents, agave, pine needles, and palm fronds cannot be chipped. It is up to the property owner to properly dispose of these items or they can be placed in MarBorg containers.
- **MARBORG WILL DONATE LARGE "ROLL OFF" CONTAINERS** which will be placed in strategic locations in your neighborhood. Containers will be in place approximately 5 days prior to the project start date and will remain on site for 7 days. Roll off container locations will vary for each neighborhood, please visit our website for exact locations.
- **ONLY VINES, GRASS, PALM, SUCCULENTS, CASTOR BEAN AND OTHER SMALL TRIMMINGS** should be put in the roll off containers. Please do not dispose of trash.
- **CHIPPING SCHEDULE:** Crews will start on the Monday of your neighborhood's scheduled week. Please put out all vegetation by Monday, and place it in a location visible from the street. Most chipping project areas take two to three days to complete.

## Chipping Schedule 2017 for the weeks beginning:

- **2/27/17** - El Bosque, Bolero, Hodges, Periwinkle, Juan Crespi, El Dorado, Live Oaks and Randall
- **3/13/17** - Lower Romero, Oak Grove, Alisos, Olive, Piedras, Veloz, Lilac, Feather Hill, Camino Del Rosario, Knollwood, Tabor and Orchard
- **3/27/17** - Pepper Hill, Alston, Woodley and Glenview
- **4/10/17** - Chelham, Dawlish, Stoddard, Cloydon Circle and Paso Robles
- **4/24/17** - Upper Romero, Park Hill, Bella Vista, Park Lane, Park Lane West, Tollis, Winding Creek and Buena Vista
- **5/08/17** - Arcady, Knapp, Cowles, Cottage, El Rancho and Sky View
- **5/22/17** - East Mountain, Irvine, Brooktree, Oak Creek Canyon, Ashley and Ayala
- **6/05/17** - West Mountain, Coyote and Banana
- **6/19/17** - Sierra Vista, Nicholas, Ridge View, Canyon View, Sycamore Vista, Calle Elegante, Calle Hermosa, Crest View and Ranchito Vista
- **7/03/17** - Hot Springs, Para Grande and Tejas

- **Lower Romero: 3/9-3/16** at 2110 Alisos Dr. and 2195 Veloz Dr.
- **Alston (Pepper Hill):** No Roll-Off scheduled for this area.
- **Chelham: 4/5-4/12** at 681 Chelham Way
- **Upper Romero:** No Roll-Off scheduled for this area.
- **Arcady/Knapp: 5/3-5/10** at 651 Cowles Road
- **East Mountain Drive: 5/17-5/24** at 354 East Mountain Drive and 1090 East Mountain Drive (in the eucalyptus grove)
- **West Mountain Drive: 5/31-6/7** at a Pull out near 225 West Mountain Drive
- **Sierra Vista: 6/14-6/21** at 445 Nicholas Lane
- **Hot Springs: 6/28-7/6** at 567 Para Grande Lane

\*Reminder: Roll-Offs are only for vegetation that cannot be chipped (leaves, vines, grass cuttings, palms, succulents, and other small trimmings).
