

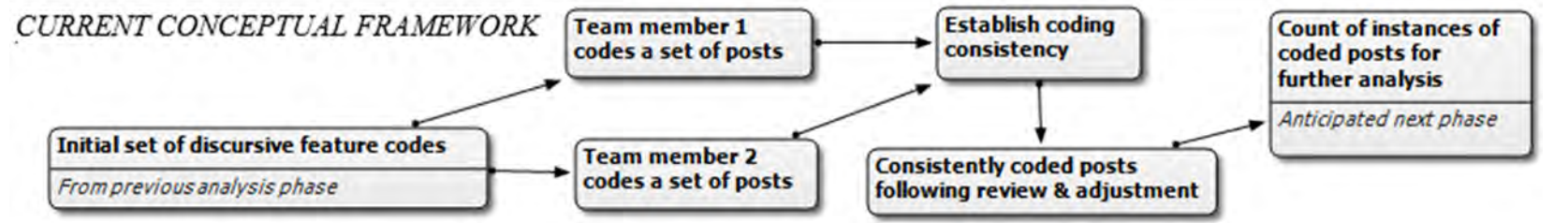

OBJECTIVES
 How is “grief” constructed in online support groups based on newcomers’ initial posts and responses to those initial posts?

GUIDING METHODOLOGY
 Discourse analysis from a discursive psychology perspective

**Level 2:
OVERALL
ANALYTIC PLAN**



PRIOR COMPLETED: Separate coding by each team member of the same posts

CURRENT: Compare team members’ coding for consistency

NEXT ANTICIPATED: Count instances of posts coded to the same discursive features

Level 4: SELECTED TOOL (single paragraph)
Level 5: CONSTRUCTED TOOL (numbered)

Establish coding consistency

UNITS Coded quotations
PURPOSE Compare coding to assess consistency
POSSIBLE COMPONENTS Free quotations, codes, coded-quotations
CHOSEN COMPONENTS Quotations and codes
EXPLANATION We will pre-define free quotations to code rather than deal with uncertainties of overlapping coded-quotations

1. Create FREE QUOTATIONS for each meaning unit that can comprehend a discursive feature
2. Each team member codes the FREE QUOTATIONS from their copy of the ATLAS.TI PROJECT
3. Merge ATLAS.TI PROJECTS
4. Compare coding

REFLECTIONS Not certain if Query Tool is identifying overlapping quotations coded to same and/or different codes. No time to experiment right now. This constructed tool removes the uncertainty for this analytic task and the next anticipated one.
