John 1:14-And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

John 1:18-No one has seen God at any time. The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared *Him*

Heb 1:3-And He is the radiance of His glory and the exact representation of His nature

Col 1:15-He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation.

Matt 16:17-Jesus answered and said to him, “Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah, for flesh and blood has not revealed *this* to you, but My Father who is in heaven.

John 5:19-Then Jesus answered and said to them, “Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner.

John 10:30-31-I and *My* Father are one. Then the Jews took up stones again to stone Him.

John 8:28-Then Jesus said to them, “When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am *He*, and *that* I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father taught Me, I speak these things.

John 12:49-For I have not spoken on My own *authority*; but the Father who sent Me gave Me a command, what I should say and what I should speak.

John 10:38-but if I do, though you do not believe Me, believe the works, that you may know and believe that the Father *is* in Me, and I in Him.

John 3:5- Jesus answered, “Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.

John 16:7-Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you.

Luke 24:49-Behold, I send the Promise of My Father upon you; but tarry in the city of Jerusalem until you are endued with power from on high.

Acts 2:41-Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added *to them*.

Acts 1:8- But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.

James 5:16-18-The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much. ¹⁷ Elijah was a man with a nature like ours, and he prayed earnestly that it would not rain; and it did not rain on the land for three years and six months. ¹⁸ And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth produced its fruit.

John 12:28-Father, glorify Your name.” Then a voice came from heaven, *saying*, “I have both glorified *it* and will glorify *it* again.”

1 Cor 10:31-Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.

1 John 5:14-Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.

Jas 4:2-3-Yet you do not have because you do not ask. ³ You ask and do not receive, because you ask amiss, that you may spend *it* on your pleasures.

Acts 7:59-They went on stoning Stephen as he called on *the Lord* and said, “Lord Jesus, receive my spirit!”

Heb 13:20-21- Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, ²¹ equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
