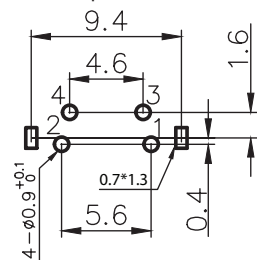

Top View

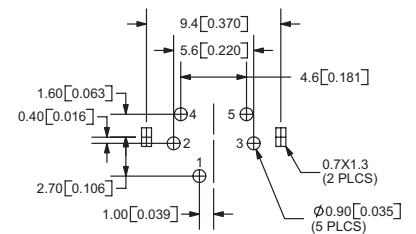
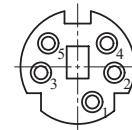


Recommended PCB Layout
