Because the UC does not report 12-month enrollment by residency, California resident headcount at UC in 2024-25 is estimated using the 12-month enrollment reported in IPEDS for 2023-24, adjusted using the enrollment growth from fall 2023 and fall 2024 reported by UC, and then allocated across residencies (i.e., California resident or not) using the percentage of California residents in fall 2024 as reported by UC. The CSU enrollment is the annual 12-month enrollment for each CSU campus as reported by the California State University Chancellor's Office.
