Again, do you have any communications about the posters and Partiful.com event page, an order to have the posters printed, a receipt for the printing job, or anything documenting the creation of the Partiful.com event page? If there is anything else you'd like to share about this poster or Partiful.com event page, please include it.
- 3) Did you communicate with Animal Advocacy members between March 15 - April 18, 2026, about Ridglan Farms? If so, when and what was discussed? If anything was communicated in writing, please share that with me.
