List of Immediate Demands

- 1. Ensure that all elevator and escalator inspections are done yearly as required by the ADA.
- 2. Provide all physically disabled students with accessible classrooms and buildings for their Fall 2023 schedule. This includes:
 - a. Accessible desks in all rooms utilized by disabled students.
 - b. Power buttons on the classroom doors so that each student may enter independently.
 - c. Power buttons and ramps on the external doors.
 - d. Power buttons and fully ADA compliant bathrooms in each building utilized by disabled students.
- 3. Require that classes are moved to an accessible location if a wheelchair user cannot make it to their class for over a week due to accessibility concerns like a broken elevator.
- 4. Provide ADA lab bench tops that raise and lower as well as accessible lab equipment required by classes in all lab buildings.
- 5. Establish a standardized, yet tailored evacuation plan for emergencies and unexpected inaccessible situations that respect the humanity and autonomy of disabled students.
- 6. Ensure that all academic accommodations are met regularly and intentionally, and create a process of accountability for accommodations that are not met.
- 7. No P2P bus can discriminate on the basis of disability. P2P drivers must be trained on how to use accessible equipment to prioritize the safety of students.
