To further our goal of financial sustainability, the Indiana Daily Student will continue to seek grants and other forms of external funding. Because these avenues of financial support are often focused on specific areas of coverage, this policy will affirm our commitment to editorial independence in our reporting and to transparency in our funding.

The IDS's acceptance of gifts or grants does not mean endorsement of the funding sources' ideas or products. Our contribution policy follows [SPA-11-014](#), IU's policy on gifts, grants and external funding. While the IDS may accept funding that is directed at covering certain topics or areas, the reporting process remains completely independent of such funds in order to produce the highest quality journalism that best serves our audience.

If grants are used to report on a story or to pay for a staff position, it will be disclosed at the bottom of a published article or at the end of a video. Some examples include:
