New Torah Class beginning this January: Do you love the focus questions about each aliyah during our Shabbat Torah reading, but wish you were able to dive in a little bit deeper? Join fellow seekers in an inquiry-based weekly parshah study structured by the famous question sheets of Nechama Liebowitz, an acclaimed 20th-century Torah scholar and teacher. Liebowitz's rich guiding questions have aided generations of readers of all backgrounds to unearth for themselves Torah wisdom both practical and moral, human and divine, by applying the strategies of literary analysis to the parashot. Along the way, the class will draw insight from contemporary teachers, such as R. Lord Jonathan Sacks and Dr. Avivah Gottlieb Zornberg, into conversation with our group as well! His passion for the Hebrew language began at age ten and he has never recovered, and he has given this lecture to American Jews of every stripe and to native-born Israelis at the Hebrew University in Jerusalem.
