## Student Board of Directors Member

The Minnesota Daily is governed by a Board of Directors, composed of current Daily leadership, outside professionals and University students. The Board meets once a month and has no editorial or day-to-day control of the paper. This role is unpaid.

### Responsibilities:

- Establish and evaluate organizational policies, priorities, and long-term goals
- Supervise and advise the Office of the Publisher
- Approve an annual operating budget
- Monitor and evaluate budget performance and the balances of all funds and reserves
- Review and make decisions and recommendations on the general operations of the organization
- Approve the strategic plan and ensure its achievement
- Ensure a proper response to all grievances brought to its attention
- Other duties as assigned

### Qualifications:

To be eligible for the position of student Board of Directors member, you must:

- Be a registered undergraduate student or graduate student at the University of Minnesota
- Not currently be employed by the Daily
- Be available from 6 to 8 pm the last Thursday of every month
- Commit to a one-year term

### Additionally, the successful candidate will:

- Be an avid Daily reader
- Demonstrate a firm belief in the freedom of the press
- Demonstrate an understanding of business management as well as journalism, media, or mass communication
- Reflect the diversity of the University community
