## CAMPAIGN TOPIC: A better cooperation between Princeton University and Princeton Municipal Council

In 1978, Princeton University student **Diane Hartley** investigated the structural integrity of the Citicorp Center, a recently completed skyscraper in NYC.

Concerned about winds directed diagonally, she found a possible major flaw. She alerted the building's structural engineer, William LeMessurier. After investigations from a number of other parties, the building was found to be in danger of possible collapse (with a catastrophic domino effect on nearby skyscrapers).

Workers made repairs over the next months, and a major disaster was avoided.

Princeton will benefit from an **improved cooperation** between the municipal council and the university. This could provide a good **propositive not-binding consulting**, possibly at a lower cost (or no cost) to the citizens. *In simple terms:* let's hear the opinions of the many brilliant minds from PU and do not rely, in the early stage, just on one (or few) co-opted professionals (with the looming risk of a conflict of interest).

We signed to the organization formed to promote and conduct a commemorative event honoring the memory of those who died in the Tiananmen massacre that occurred in Beijing on June 4, 1989. Princeton's significance in the history of American independence and the enduring ideals of liberty and self-government associated with that history make it a fitting place for such an event. With the United States approaching the 250th anniversary of its founding, **Princeton offers a meaningful setting in which to honor the courage and sacrifice of those who stood for freedom, human dignity, and democracy** in Tiananmen Square.

This commemoration will also reflect on how the original hope that China's economic opening would lead to greater freedom of ideas and a broader respect for human rights was often overtaken by a US-China relationship increasingly defined by profit-driven interests.
