Catlin, City Manager, dated May 24, 1934, lodged in the Clerk's Office of the Circuit Court of Prince Edward County, Virginia, on which the real estate hereby conveyed is designated as Lot No. 221101), and is the present property occupied by Prince Edward Lodge No. 269 of the Improved Benevolent
