Sending a quick note this morning so that we have all this information in one spot for the future in reference to local funds.

The scheduled Nov. 13 and Feb. 21 local funds replenishment transfers are complete. As we talk to folks around campus about this, I just wanted to jot down the highlights so we have them in one spot:

- A significant portion of the June sweep was of Athletics and Advancement funds, which at any given summer are drawn down normally at the end of the fiscal year.
- The remaining \$1.6 million had two parts a) roughly \$1 million of normal endowment yield, which we have to spend on an annual basis, and which is replenished each May from investment earnings, and b) roughly \$600,000 of departmental local funds made up of annual giving. That third part the \$600,000 of departmental local funds that came from annual giving is what was promised to be replenished in full (see attached spreadsheet).
- We replenished \$124,561 between July and November; \$208,120 on 11/13; and \$269,184 on 2/21.
- All of the replenishment was drawn from unrestricted philanthropic funds.

And, of course, fundraising activity for this year continues to be strong.

By the way, I also chatted with the president this morning and budget talks in Richmond seem to be progressing reasonably well. We certainly still have to manage finances carefully for the foreseeable future, which thanks to you two especially is happening every day, but we are in a much better position compared with a great many of our peers who are having significant budget issues. I think we can remain cautiously optimistic that we will enter FY26 on firm footing.

<u>Background:</u> As you may remember, at the September Board of Visitors meeting, President Reveley announced at the that the money that was deducted from Academic Affairs local accounts associated with departments and colleges, specifically those funded through annual and other kinds of recurring or one-time gifts, would be restored. Local accounts that are funded through programmatic endowment spend rates would not be restored. The Board of Visitors also approved a revision to <u>Policy 2028</u>, "Use and Investment of Local Funds," which clarified that local accounts funded by annual giving would not be swept at the University level.

Budgeting of Local Funds: As a reminder of what we have discussed before with regard to the budgeting of local funds:

- Local accounts funded through annual giving and other gifts (labeled AF in the attached spreadsheet) will carry over from year to year, but it is expected that going forward you will have a budget plan for how a certain amount of those funds will be spent each year.
- Local accounts funded through programmatic endowment spend rates (labeled PE in the attached spreadsheet) will also carry over from year to year, but it is expected that going forward the annual spend rate for a given fiscal year should be spent down in the same fiscal year.

If you have a PE account, I will be sending you a separate email soon asking for you to share how you plan to spend the rest of your budgeted spend rate amount this fiscal year.

I will also be sending a separate email about FY26 budget planning, which will include the budgeting of local funds.

Because of the deficits in some of the local accounts in CBE at the end of last fiscal year, there were several amounts that were transferred between accounts to clear the deficits. We also transferred money into the new local accounts created.

Mamun and I can walk through this all at our meeting this Wednesday. And we can schedule a follow-up budget meeting with all four of us (Mamun, Tracey, Kim, and me) as well.

<u>Background:</u> As you may remember, at the September Board of Visitors meeting, President Reveley announced at the that the money that was deducted from Academic Affairs local accounts associated with departments and colleges, specifically those funded through annual and other kinds of recurring or one-time gifts, would be restored. Local accounts that are funded through programmatic endowment spend rates would not be restored. The Board of Visitors also approved a revision to <u>Policy 2028</u>, "Use and Investment of Local Funds," which clarified that local accounts funded by annual giving would not be swept at the University level.

<u>Budgeting of Local Funds:</u> As a reminder of what we have discussed before with regard to the budgeting of local funds:

- Local accounts funded through annual giving and other gifts (labeled AF in the attached spreadsheet) will carry over from year to year, but it is expected that going forward you will have a budget plan for how a certain amount of those funds will be spent each year.
- Local accounts funded through programmatic endowment spend rates (labeled PE in the attached spreadsheet) will also carry over from year to year, but it is expected that going forward the annual spend rate for a given fiscal year should be spent down in the same fiscal year.

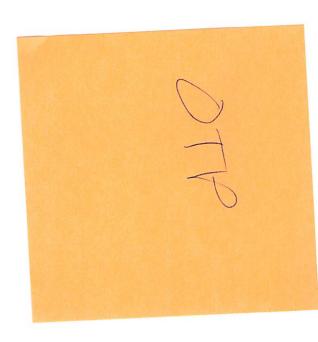

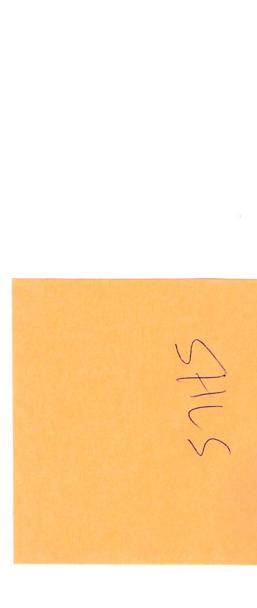

The restoration of local funds has been completed. I am attaching a spreadsheet that contains a list of your local account(s) that shows the transfer amount(s) and cash-on-hand balance as of February 21. I have also attached a PDF of screenshots of the Banner Ledger Activity that shows when the transfers were made.

We restored funds in two steps. If the fund had less than \$10,000 swept, then the fund was fully restored in November. If the fund had more than \$10,000 swept, then \$8,000 was restored in November, and the remaining balance was restored in February.
