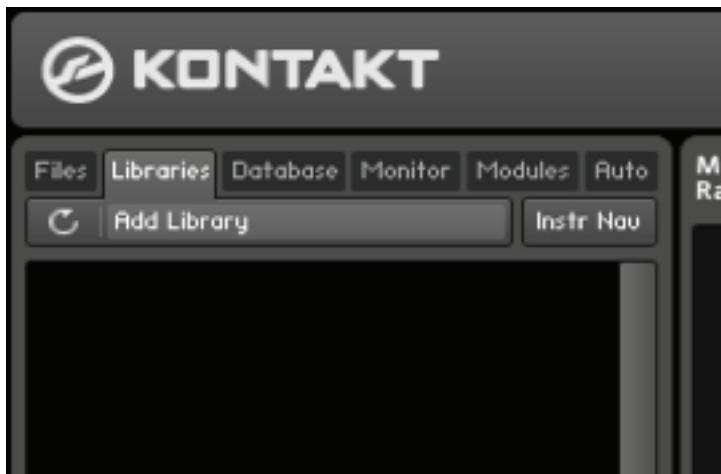

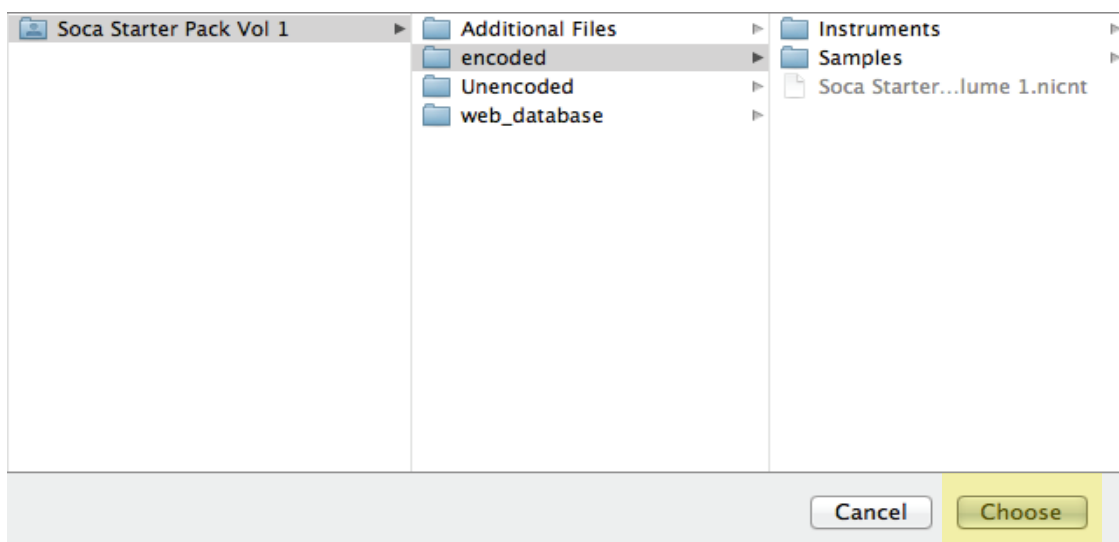
## 1-Getting Started - Adding Library

- 1.1 Please ensure to have Kontakt version 5.5.2.xxx and above.
- 1.2 After downloading the link provided, please unzip the Soca Starter Pack Volume 1 onto a desired destination.
- 1.3 Please open KONTAKT 5 PLAYER and click add library.

- 1.4 Search for the unzipped Indigisounds folder.
- 1.5 Select and click choose/open/select on the encoded folder.



## 1-Getting Started - Adding Library


- 1.6 Click **Activate** and input user account information in the required Service Center fields.

*Note: New Users would have to create a service centre account. Users can also register using NKS.*



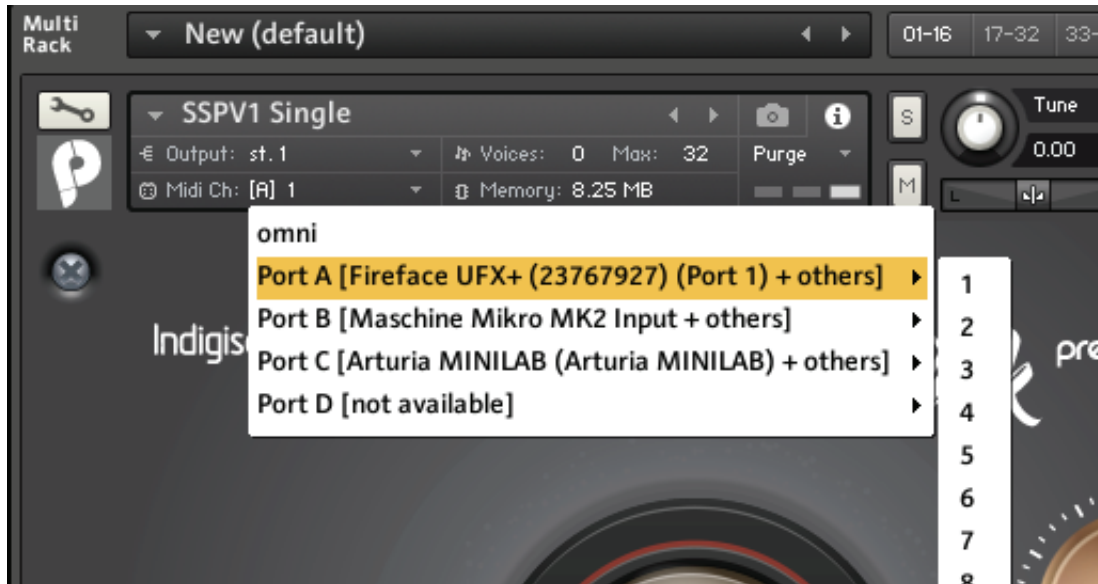

- 2.2 Ensure Midi Ch. matches the desired interface and instrument.

## 3-Getting Started - Navigating Main Page

- 3.1 Main Page contains the following

- 3.1.1 Quantize and Speed (Note - Single does not contain these options)



Quantize and Speed option

- 3.1.1.1 Quantize - User is able to input all incoming Note-On messages to a set grid/rate.

- 3.1.1.2 Speed - User is able to control the rate of of all loops.

*Note: cmd + right click (OSX) or control + right click resets the incoming Note-On messages to default settings*



## 3-Getting Started - Navigating Main Page

### 3.2.1 Duration of Sample



*Duration option*

**3.2.1.1** Envelope - User is able to control the Attack and Release of the samples during Note-On messages.

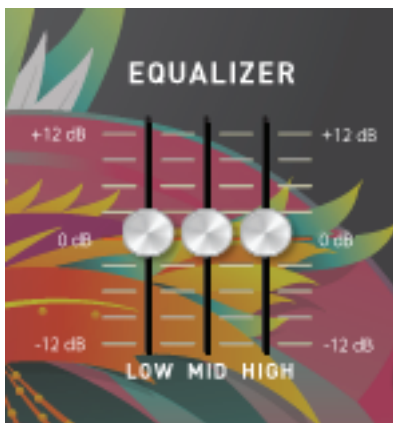
### 3.3.1 Tuning of Sample



*Tune option*

**3.3.1.1** Tune - User is able to tune samples in semitones (st)

### 3.4.1 EQ of Sample



*EQ option*

**3.3.4.1** EQ - User is able to control LF at 70Hz, HMF at 2.5 kHz and HF at 10kHz.

## 4-Getting Started - Navigating FX Page

### 4.1 FX Page Contains the following

#### 4.1.1 Main FX



Main FX option OFF



Main FX option ON

The main FX shall allow the user to access:

- Telephone
- Chorus
- Phaser
- Reverb
- Delay
- Filter

Pressing the OFF button, shall independantly enable the user to turn on the various effects with its respective paramters.

Pressing the ON button, shall independently disable the effect.

## 4-Getting Started - Navigating FX Page

### 4.2.1 Master FX



*Reverse FX and Precision Loudness options*

The Master FX shall allow the user to independently access:

- Reverse - enabling this button shall reverse all samples within the library.
- Precision Loudness - enabling shall provide you total access to Precision production trademark processing.
