There is some risk, namely weather. End of steel is currently scheduled for August, weather tight is October 5. We have some GLX impacts getting things into the site.

The concrete contractor has hired a claims consultant to review their claim. This should help filter out some items from their claim. Electrical cost reconciliation meeting is next week; Plumbing, HVAC, façade tomorrow. MJR: Will we be able to review the claims analysis at the June meeting? SCCI: We will have some more information in June. We should have some of the subcontractors squared away. Hoping for site, concrete, electrical, possibly steel. We will provide an update of where we are at the June meeting. TP: Commended the work SCCI is doing to help reduce the schedule impact cost and thanked them for their efforts.

9/09:01	SBC		Design Update: Gym Floor – The committee reviewed a memo about the gym floor. The cost for the original floor is \$309,890, the cost for the new floor is estimated to be \$511,000. The track layout is unchanged. The original material selected for the track gave the track teacher concerns. The new layout has a wood parquet floor in the center of the gym with a poured rubber floor around. It is similar to the floor at Swampscott High School and the Reggie Lewis Center.  Nicole Viele: reviewed installations of the original floor design, neither school they looked at used that floor for competition. TP: Did not feel the original design was not a good choice for a running track. TB: asked why this is coming up now. We told everyone they had their last shot, now they are changing. Is MSBA paying for this? What is the maintenance? SMMA: The floor is a 50-75 year floor. Swampscott refinished their floor 10 years after the install. The poured floor has not been touched. TP: Asked if everyone is in agreement.  Nicole Viele: Yes, there is agreement that this is the best layout for all sports in the gym. Motion: Add up to \$250K to pay for the flooring system as described M:EB S:RR D: TP: asked if there are other funding sources identified. SL: We will look into it V: 9-0-0
	SCCI		Construction Update - SCCI: The month of April has 20 days of rain, our current schedule shows making an December opening is a long shot. We can make it, second shift and weekend work are required. We are focusing on getting the CTE programs back on site in December rather than pushing to get the upper floors complete. We will focus on the first and second floor, getting a temp CO for those spaces and not spending money to open unnecessary areas.  MJR: Is there a cost impact DG: This scenario would decrease some of the schedule pressure. It should not make the cost impact worse. LP: How

	realistic is the schedule? Will students be in the building during construction?
	I have a feeling the schedule is highly ambitious, and we should talk about
	pushing the entire project to a February to take more pressure off the
	scheduled. <b>SCCI:</b> Students in the building during construction is not an issue,
	we do it all the time, normally in hospitals. We would need ISD signoff on all
	life safety prior to occupancy. <b>TB</b> : is concerned. 8 months to open the
	building does not seem doable. SCCI was chosen because the cut a year off the
	schedule. TB toured the temp spaces, they are not an ideal learning
	environment. A lot of kids are at SHS because of the CTE program. How does
	this effect other programs? <b>LP</b> : Lower levels opening would be the biggest

We provided \$811k in cost avoidance, we need \$8MM. <b>TB</b> : is there concern over the amount of change orders. <b>PMA:</b> Yes, but we need to note that of the \$12.1MM in contingency usage, \$4MM +/- was for bid overruns, \$7.2MM is for schedule delay claim. <b>TB</b> : The Change order report is becoming voluminous. 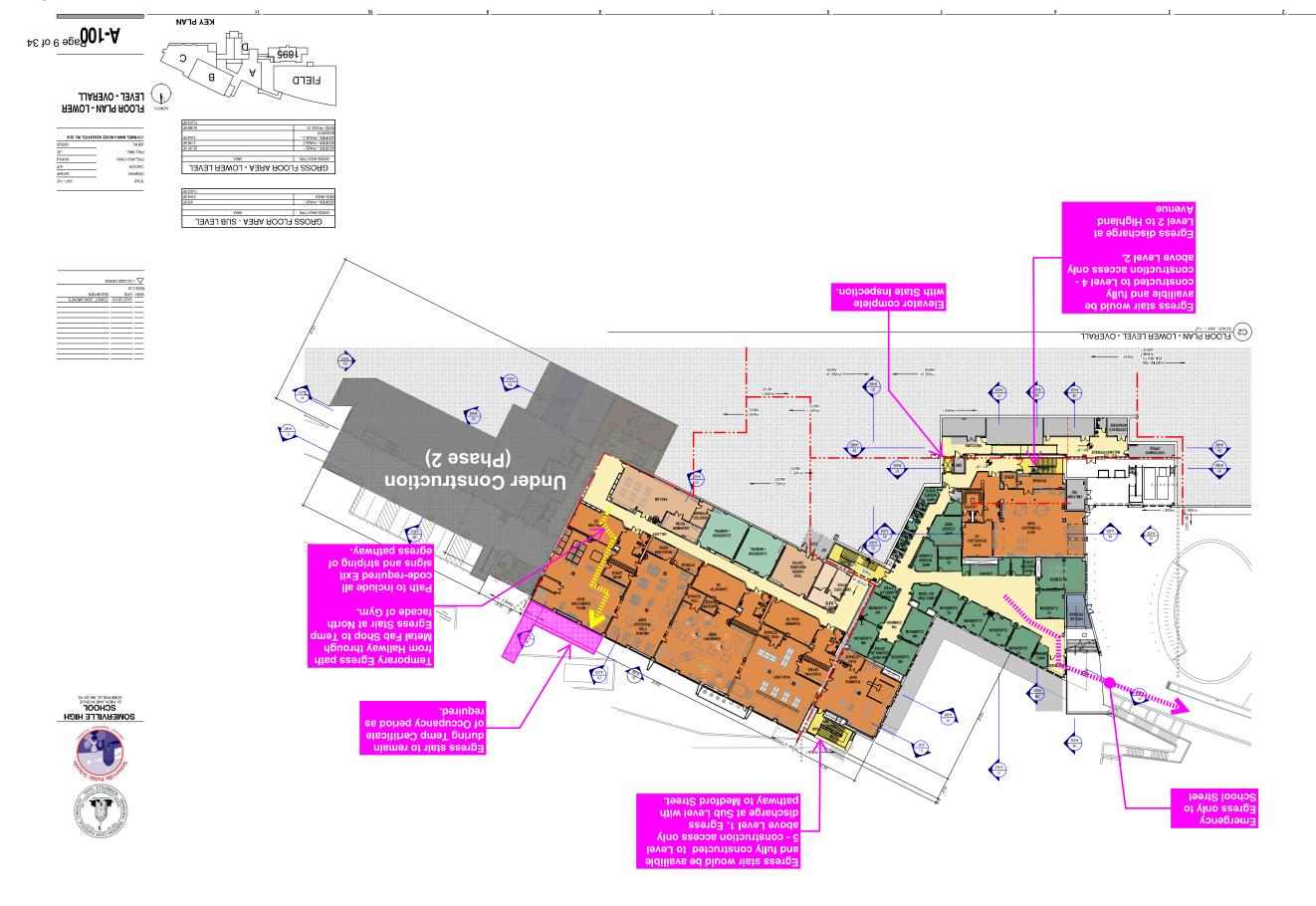
# **Temporary Certificate of Occupancy (Phased Occupancy) Planning**

- 1. The project always included some Phased Occupancy scenarios (base plan)
- 2. The current Phased Occupancy planning is ONLY for Phase 1 (all other phases remain unchanged from base plan) and allows for access to:
  - Lower Level CTE areas
  - Gymnasium
- 3. Phased Occupancy period: late December 2019 through February Break 2020
- 4. Phased Occupancy was reviewed with Inspectional Services Dept. (ISD) and the Somerville Fire Department (authorities having jurisdiction), as well as with SMMA, and PMA Consultants.
- 5. **Required** for Temporary Certificate of Occupancy:
  - Completion of all life safety systems (fire alarm, sprinklers)
  - Completion of all required egress paths / EXITS
  - Testing and inspection of the above
  - Sign off by SMMA (architects of record), and ISD / SFD

# **Temporary Certificate of Occupancy (Phased Occupancy) Planning**

#### **Risk Factors**

- Weather impacts to productivity (example: rain / steel erection)
  - \* This becomes a diminishing risk as the building becomes enclosed
- Site Access / Material Deliveries impacted by GLX Constructors
  - \* There is a weekly / daily coordination effort (including the City, PMA, SMMA) underway for the past month to mitigate this risk.

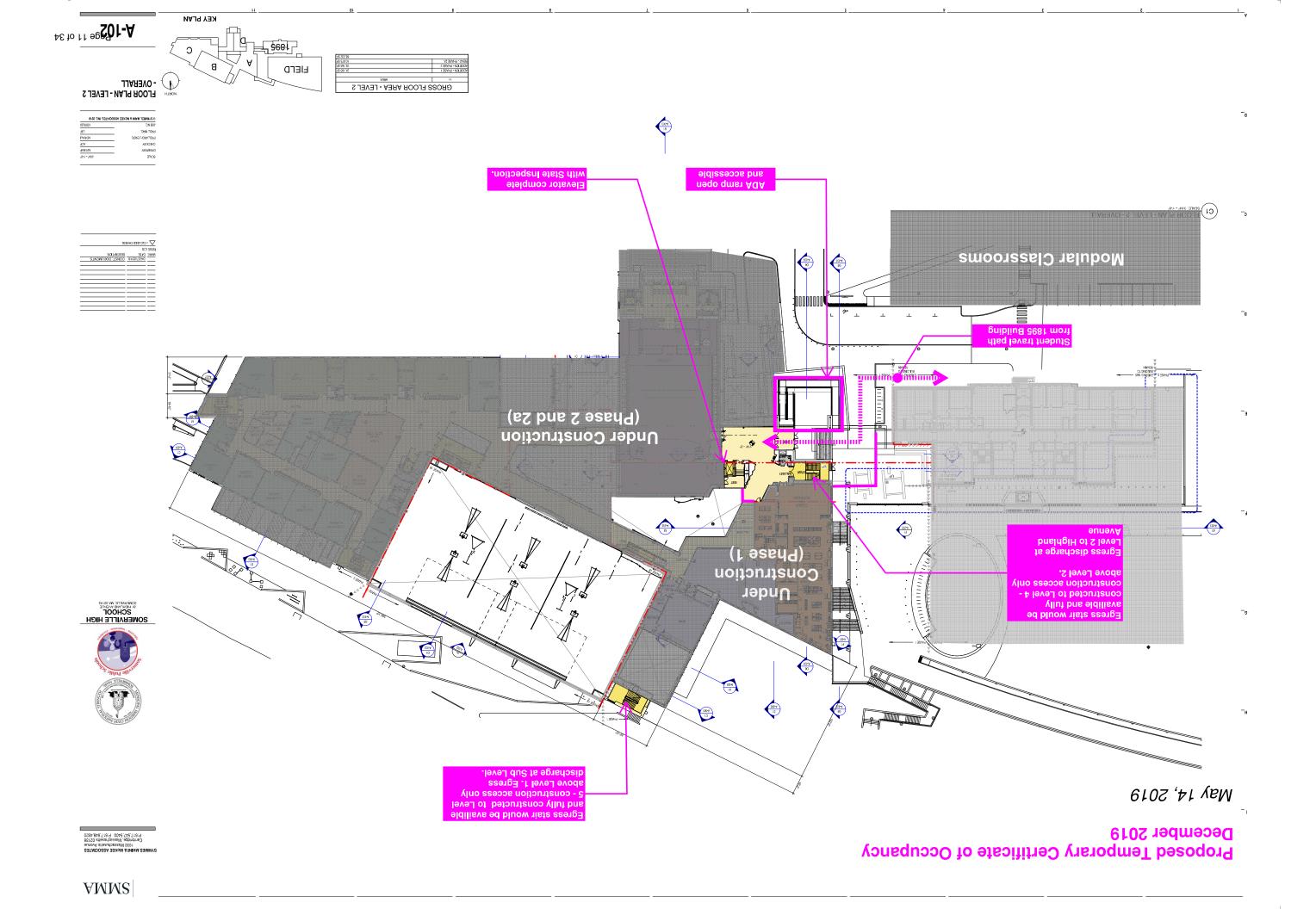

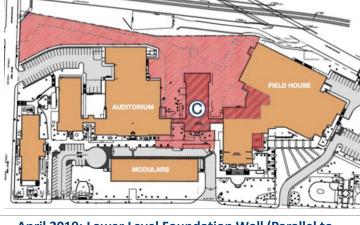

#### PROACTIVE MEASURES RELEVANT TO COMMUNITY INTERACTION DURING CONSTRUCTION



#### **Conduct of Contractor Personnel**

All Construction Personnel must be CORI checked. The Contractor must establish and enforce rules as are appropriate to ensure the safety of the school programs and appropriate demeanor in the presences of the students, staff, parents and other visitors. Personnel must wear identification badges when on site. Workers are forbidden from intermingling with students or entering a school occupied area except with prior approval of the Owner.



#### **Working Hours**

The Contractor is allowed to work on site between 7:00AM to 7:00PM Monday-Friday and between 9:00AM and 7:00PM on Saturdays. Work on Sunday and Legal Holidays is prohibited.

Any deviation from this plan requires a request made by the contractor 72 hours in advance of the work being performed and the approval of the DPW Commissioner.



#### Use of Site

Site Work and Work outside the building may be performed while school is in session if it does not interfere with or impede school activities, including but not limited to arrivals and departures of students and staff, and outdoor athletic and play activities. Before performing work in any area that is immediately outside an occupied area of the building, the contractor must notify the Owner and obtain written authorization.

Any operations that would result in high levels of noise, vibration, odors or other disruption to the school must be coordinated to with school prior to the activity commencing. Any operation causing interruptions to the school activities will be stopped as required by the school.

Prior to execution of the work, the contractor is required to submit a site utilization plan, weather protection and heating plan, dust containment plan, and traffic and hauling plan.



#### **Existing Utility Interruptions**

Utilities serving the property are not allowed to be interrupted. When utilities connections need to be modified, temporary services must be provided and put in place to insure uninterrupted utility service to the school, unless otherwise approved by the Owner.



#### **Indoor Air Quality**

The contractor will develop and enforce procedures for preventing construction activities from creating unacceptable Indoor Air Quality within occupied areas. This includes use of dust protection, filters, containment, ventilation and negative air pressurization. The contractor is required to monitor work practices and have systems in place for early detection of potential Indoor Air Quality issues. The contractor is required to provide monthly monitoring of the building indoor air quality with additional monitoring required when construction operations generate higher levels of potential contaminants.



#### **Noise Control**

The contractor is required to develop and maintain a noise abatement program and enforce strict discipline over personnel to minimize noise. The must employ construction methods and equipment which reduce excess noise
