MEETING AT SOMERVILLE HIGH SCHOOL 93 HIGHLAND AVENUE 3RD FLOOR CONFERENCE ROOM

Rachel Borgatti called the meeting to order at 7:04 pm followed by introductions.

New Business:

- 1. Assembly Square replacing tree box filters with pocket rain gardens
 - o Gene Crouch (VHB) Engineers for the developers of Assembly square
 - o Filterra units Stormwater biofiltration units with an opening in sidewalk special soil; filtration and vegetation
 - o Replace filterra untis with specially designed rain gardens that have a similar operation.
 - o Same foot-print of the filterra untis
 - In the edge of the sidewalk, breaks in gutter line allows water to flow into system
 - o Vegetated system, grass, flowers, etc
 - o Plans→ Mulch → Bioretention Reservoir → Underdrain → Water carried out
 - o How long does it take for water to run through the system? 72 Hours.
 - o Provides storm water treatment
 - Landscapes / Streetscapes feature
 - o Larger capacity than the filterra units
 - o Concern for inlets in regards to erosion and sediment controls and protection
 - o Block 5 under construction
 - Block 7 \rightarrow Timeline 1+ Year away; Starting design



- o When will work start Spring 2020.
- Dead trees in filterra units
- City maintenance Agreement
 - Maintenance falls to the City
 - Federal Realty to maintain the landscaping
 - Property lines are disclosed in presentation
 - Sidewalks vs. the Street which are City owned
- O Who Maintains?
 - Street retail
 - Landscape
 - Trash / general upkeep
 - City
 - Bioretention Materials
 - System
- o Timeflex Gate is described as a 72 inch pipe for events of high tide
- Allows for storage of rain pressure
- Not a back flow preventer, it drops into a manhole
- o How do you communicate to the City that they have to maintain a new storm water system?
 - Pass- off Meeting
 - Notify in the event of passing off
- o Planting List Public Space Planner's concerns are discussed
- O Why submit an RDA instead of an NOI?
 - Project is in a totally developed area
 - Project is not in a buffer Zone
 - Streets are only affected
- o Any more questions?
 - Constituency has high support for pollinator plants
 - Federal realty is open to get the right species and early season plantings that are needed
- Negative 2 determinations with special conditions.
- Motion: Issue a Negative 2 Determination of Applicability with special conditions [Motion Joroff, Second – Turin, vote: 5:0:0]
- 2. Community Gardens forms and manuals
 - o Conservation Commission oversees the Community gardens
 - Updates made to forms and manuals
 - O Updates made to Application forms and renewal form
 - Discussion ensues about Chuckie Harris Community garden
 - No one gardens there
 - Garden is not fenced in, it's wide open
 - Described as in a place of stasis
 - Not having it in the document may be a good idea
 - No one has Gardened there in two years
 - Garden being located in East Somerville may be one of the only garden plots in the area
 - Garden has 7 Plots
 - Fence vs. No fence
 - Garden Plots are too small and irregular shaped
 - Not an ideal location
 - Is there a process to remove or decommission a community garden?



- What of the waiting list?
 - Who is on the wait list?
 - Are these garden plots desirable?
 - There are great demand for garden plots
- Remove Chuckie Harris from Online forms?
- Action: Agent Drayton to ask Public Space Director Luisa Oliveira for background and thoughts on Chuckie Harris community garden
- Site visit should be conducted before January meeting
- Stop recommending Chuckie Harris
- No contact information for Chuckie Harris has been provided
- Should we re-commission the garden
- No sense of community
- Remove from active list → defacto decommission?
- Should we schedule Chuckie Harris decision for January
- Could it be a pollinator garden?
- Reach out to wait-list?
- Tara is manager of the master waitlist
- o Interested heard about Avon and Bikeway Community garden expansions
- Coordinators are self-sufficient
- ConCom to write letter to remind garden coordinators to send in wait-list garden information
- o Gardens are exclusionary with little to no turnover How to communicate to community gardeners?
- o Reach out to other cities and towns (Erica San Martin Hernandez has this data)
- Community gardens open house
 - Gate policy would problematic with an open house
- Desire to get everyone on board
- New community garden Plots coming online
- o Term limits
- Fences privatization of public land
- Options Shared plots after limits
- o Would turnover affect garden coordinator turnover?
- o Communal Plot?
- o Re-visit term limits in January?
- o 100% Turnover vs. Continuity
- o Is now the administrative time of gardening?
 - You must maintain a master list
 - Tara and Chair Borgatti to draft memo
 - o New requirements must be in the manual
 - Must fill out financial tracking sheet
- Transition to electronic makes it easier.
- o Forms and manual s must be added to website along with maps for the community garden.
