Reasons for my Request:

- Wisteria is a genus of flowering plants in the legume family, Fabaceae (Leguminosae), that
 includes ten species of woody twining vines that are native to China, Japan, Korea, Vietnam,
 Southern Canada, the Eastern United States, and north of Iran. They were later introduced to
 France, Germany and various other countries in Europe. Some species are popular ornamental
 plants.
- 2. The flowers have drooping racemes that vary in length from species to species. W. floribunda (Japanese wisteria) has the longest racemes up to 90 centimetres (35 in).
