East Broadway Bus Service and Crosswalk Improvements coming in 2023!

- Painted red bus lanes on Broadway from McGrath Highway to Rush Street to reduce delays and improve reliability for people on the 89 and 101 buses.
- Consolidate some bus stops between McGrath Highway and Pennsylvania Avenue to reduce the number of times the bus must stop.
- Improve safety and visibility at intersections for people walking, wheeling, and driving.

Where there are two travel lanes on Broadway today, the City will reserve one travel lane for buses and bikes. We will paint that lane red. We will add right turn arrows painted in white in the bus lane to allow cars to turn right. We will add “No Parking” signs and paint white boxes with diagonal lines to mark the area where parking is prohibited. These boxes will be located near crosswalks and intersections.



Bus stops changes include:

- Cross Street– The eastbound bus stop for the route 89 and 101 to Sullivan Square will be moved further east on Broadway between Autumn Street and Cross Street. The westbound bus stop for the route 89 towards Davis Square/Clarendon Hill and the route 101 towards Malden Center will remain.
- Illinois Avenue – The two westbound bus stops at Indiana Ave and Michigan Ave for the 89 towards Davis/Clarendon Hill and 101 towards Malden Center will be combined into a new stop at Illinois Ave.
- Glen Street – The two eastbound bus stops at Franklin St and Glen Street for the 89 and 101 towards Sullivan Square will be combined into a new stop between Glen Street and Cutter Ave.
- The bus stops at MacArthur Street and Kensington Avenue will both be removed.
