On Tuesday, April 11, 2023 at approximately 10:15pm Investigators David and Temple entered the above license premises in order to observe the manner in which business was being conducted.

Investigators David and Temple observed a table with 4 youthful appearing individuals in the back left area of the premises that were in possession of alcoholic beverages. Their information is as follows:

DOB: 11/17/2003 (Age 19)

presented a fraudulent Maine driver's license with her name and picture, but with a date of birth of 11/17/2001 and stated that she was in possession of a cranberry vodka.

DOB: 2/20/2004 (Age 19) United Kingdom

presented a fraudulent Tennessee driver's license with her name and picture, but with a date of birth of 2/20/2001 and stated that she was in possession of a cranberry vodka.

DOB: 8/6/2003 (Age 19) France stated that he was not asked for identification upon entry to the premise and stated that he was in possession of a Fiddlehead beer.

DOB: 6/6/2004 (Age 18) United Kingdom

stated that he was not asked for identification upon entry to the premise and stated that he was in possession of a Fiddlehead beer.

Investigators David and Temple observed a second table with 5 youthful appearing individuals in the back left area of the premises that were in possession of alcoholic beverages. Their information is as follows:

DOB: 9/2/2003 (Age 19)

presented a fraudulent New Jersey driver's license with his name and picture, but with a date of birth of 9/2/2000 and stated that he was in possession of a Bud Light draft beer.

DOB: 9/12/2003 (Age 19)

presented a fraudulent Delaware driver's license with his name and picture, but with a date of birth of 9/12/2001 and stated that he was in possession of a Bud Light draft beer.

DOB: 3/29/2004 (Age 19)

presented a fraudulent Pennsylvania driver's license with his name and picture, but with a date of birth of 3/29/2001 and stated that he was in possession of a Bud Light draft beer.

DOB: 10/27/2003 (Age 19)

presented a fraudulent New Jersey driver's license with his name and picture, but with a date of birth of 3/21/2000 and stated that he was in possession of a Bud Light draft beer.

DOB: 11/20/2003 (Age 19)

presented a fraudulent New Jersey driver's license with his name and picture, but with a date of birth of 3/14/2001 and stated that he was in possession of a Bud Light draft beer.

Investigators David and Temple observed the majority of the bar, which was composed primarily of youthful appearing individuals, exiting the premise. Investigators observed two of the individuals exiting the premise to still be in possession of alcoholic beverages. Their information is as follows:

DOB: 2/7/04 (Age 19)

presented a fraudulent Connecticut driver's license with his name and picture, but with a date of birth of 2/7/2001 and stated that he was in possession of a Sam Adams beer.

DOB: 10/15/2003 (Age 19)

presented a fraudulent Georgia driver's license with his name and picture, but with a date of birth of 10/15/2001 and stated that he was in possession of a Sam Adams beer.

Investigators identified the individuals to the staff and bartender Thomas Mercier throughout the process and showed Mr. Mercier the fraudulent ID's which had been confiscated. The Investigators advised Mr. Mercier of the violation and advised him that a report would be filed with the Chief Investigator for further action.

Dear License Commission.

On February 22, 2023, I emailed the License Commission inquiring when businesses were permitted to apply for a permanent Outdoor Parklet.

On November 21, 2022, my landlord, Henry Patterson / Food Service Financials, had written a letter on behalf of both of my businesses: Annex and TW Productions, stating that we had given our permission to the use of space directly in front of Bronwyn restaurant and TB Pizza. His letter of permission conceded the entirety of the frontage at Bronwyn restaurant and half of the frontage of T&B Pizza. It is important to note below these points:

- We never received this document and we were never informed by our landlord that he wrote a
 letter on our behalf which conceded our frontage rights to Picante for both our companies, Annex
 TW and TW Productions.
- Had we been made aware of the letter, whether by landlord or by licensing at that time, we would
 not have emailed inquiring when the application process started(since I would have already given
 our consent to our frontage).
- Had we known about the process in November, we would have started our own licensing
 application process at that time. We, most certainly, would not have given our consent or conceded
 our frontage rights without securing our own outdoor parklet first.
- We were not informed that frontage consent was a requirement for the license process for AnnexTW or TW Productions from the beginning in February. The license commission had accepted our consent via our landlord. Additionally, once I had learned about other businesses giving consent, I inquired with Licensing as to why all the other businesses required consent, but for some reason, not us. The November letter by our landlord giving our consent was never referenced, or shared. It was shared with us for the first time when read aloud at the hearing in July.

We are hoping that the License Commission recognizes our perspective: the letter stating our consent to frontage was not justly procured by our Landlord and does not represent our viewpoints. It came as a surprise during the July License hearing. Since this document was presented on behalf of both my businesses in the closing of this process versus in the beginning of this process, it was the determining factor that has belated our outdoor seating.
