- 3. Update on Sound Bites:
  - Recap Sound Bites popular cafe in Ball Square. Few years ago one worker learned that he was underpaid and he took action. Owner of Sound Bites threatened his family. The Department of Labor learned about this and started to investigate. Owner then threatened other workers asking them not to cooperate with the Department of Labor. Owner of Sound Bites was found guilty and a ruling was put forward. Court found workers are owed \$300,000. About 25 workers were impacted and the owner cannot threaten workers. New protections to help workers get documented. Workers' conditions are not as bad. Things still are problems like not getting vacation time. In discussion with the Department of Labor, I would like to have two spaces for workers to come to see money they are entitled to. Also come to see demands. It is a way to have workers get involved.
