This decision summarizes the findings made by the Historic Preservation Commission (HPC) at their May 02, 2023, meeting regarding the historic significance of **the principal structure** located at **236 Pearl Street.**

SUMMARY OF PROPOSAL

The Applicant proposes to demolish the structure located at 236 Pearl St.

DETERMINATION

In their deliberations, the HPC, stated that the structure lacked historic integrity, was not related to any historic individuals, and did not contribute to the streetscape.

A motion was called to declare **236 Pearl St** *historically significant*. The HPC voted unanimously (0-4) **against** declaring the structure at 236 Pearl historically significant. Because the vote failed, the motion failed. Due to the failed vote, the building at 236 Pearl St, therefore, is NOT *historically significant*.

236 Pearl St may be released for demolition at the discretion of the Inspectional Services Department (ISD).
