1505.1 MOBILIZATION LUMP SUM

PART 1 - GENERAL

1.1 SUMMARY

- A. This section includes mobilization consisting of moving all plant and equipment onto the site required for the Contractor's operations; furnishing and erecting plants, temporary buildings, and project and other construction facilities; erecting project signs and traffic management signs; implementing security features and requirements; all as required for the proper performance and completion of the Work. Mobilization shall further include the following principal items:
 - 1. Arranging for and erection of Contractor's work and storage/staging yard(s).
 - 2. Having all OSHA required notices and establishment of safety programs.
 - 3. Having the Contractor's project manager/superintendent at the job site full time.

METHOD OF MEASUREMENT:

Operational is defined as the substantial commencement of work on site as described in the following paragraph. The Lump Sum price bid for mobilization shall not exceed 2 percent of the Total Amount of Bid.

BASIS OF PAYMENT:

Under the Lump Sum price bid for Mobilization, the Contractor shall move his equipment to

Mobilization shall also include site control, preparation and staging needed for vacuum excavation of test pits. Mobilization shall include all costs of initiating the Contract, exclusive of the cost of materials. Mobilization includes securing and constructing a staging area(s) for materials (0.5%); submission and approval of initial permits and Traffic Management Plans (0.5%); distributing contact numbers for Contractor's staff to Owner and Engineer; submission and approval of shop drawings (0.5%); submission and approval of initial work plans, schedule, and sequencing plans (0.3%); distribution of initial notices (0.1%); transporting all necessary trucks and construction equipment to the site necessary to begin construction (0.1%); and all other work necessary to start Construction.
