This decision summarizes the findings made by the Historic Preservation Commission (HPC) at their October 19, 2021, meeting regarding the preferable preservation of 1252 Broadway

SUMMARY OF PROPOSAL

The Applicant proposes retroactive approval to demolish the principal structure located at 1252 Broadway.

DETERMINATION

The HPC voted 4-0 that the structure at 1252 Broadway is Preferably Preserved such:

That the demolition of the building(s) at 1252 Broadway would be detrimental to the architectural, cultural, political, economic, or social heritage of the City.

In their deliberations, the HPC found that prior to demolition the structure retained its original gothic detailing and its original form and the massing.

Therefore, in accordance with Demolition Review Ordinance (DRO), 1252 Broadway has been determined to be "preferably preserved" and an 18-month demolition delay is imposed.
