**DETERMINATION: Historically Significant** 

**DECISION DATE:** February 15, 2022

This decision summarizes the findings made by the Historic Preservation Commission (HPC) at their February 15, 2022, meeting regarding the historic significance of the principal structure located at 51 Broadway.

### SUMMARY OF PROPOSAL

The Applicant proposes to demolish the structure located at 51 Broadway.

### **DETERMINATION**

It has been determined that the principal structure at 51 Broadway is "at least 75 years old," and the HPC voted 4-0 that it is Historically Significant according to criteria b of the Demolition Review Ordinance (DRO) which reads as follows:

The findings for historical and/or architectural significance of a historic property address the period, style, method of building construction and association with a reputed architect or builder of the subject property, either by itself of in the context of a group of buildings or structures, and therefore it is in the public interest to be preserved or rehabilitated rather than to be demolished.

In their deliberations, the HPC discussed that the building retains its architectural form and massing, and that it is part of a consistent streetscape of structures built at the same time in the same design.

Therefore, In accordance with the Demolition Review Ordinance (DRO), the HPC shall next conduct a public hearing during which the Commission will discuss whether or not the principal structure at 51 Broadway should be "preferably reserved".

**DETERMINATION:** Preferably Preserved

**DECISION DATE:** March 15, 2022

This decision summarizes the findings made by the Historic Preservation Commission (HPC) at their March 15, 2022, meeting regarding the preferable preservation of 51 Broadway.

### SUMMARY OF PROPOSAL

The Applicant proposes to demolish the principal structure located at **51 Broadway**.

#### **DETERMINATION**

The HPC voted 4-0 that the structure at 51 Broadway is Preferably Preserved such:

That the demolition of the building(s) at 51 Broadway would be detrimental to the architectural, cultural, political, economic, or social heritage of the City.

In their deliberations, the HPC found that the structure retains its original form and massing. The Commission noted that the building's elevated basement and four-story height are rare and worthy of preservation.

Therefore, in accordance with Demolition Review Ordinance (DRO), 51 Broadway has been determined to be "preferably preserved" and an 18-month demolition delay is imposed.
