Addendum No. 1 to IFB 25-28

Dear Bid holders,

This addendum (#1) was issued to add to the scope, provide answers to your questions, and revise the price form.

Addition to the Scope:

Please note, as discussed during the pre-bid site visit, the following has been added to the scope:

- 1. Both Boiler Room 1 staircases to include housekeeping pads or other method of elevating the metal feet above the damp floor. Neither staircase in this room can have the bottom of a stringer located in the drainage sump that runs around the perimeter of the room. A housekeeping pad, if recommended, cannot block the drainage sump.
- 2. Boiler Room 2 staircase to include a third stringer in the center of the staircase for stability/support.
- 3. Furnish, deliver and install steel tube railing for the exterior concrete staircase from ground level down to the door to Boiler Room 2 (Water Dept. Building). The steel tube railing will be attached to the east-facing wall of the Water Department building.

Questions and Answers:

Below are all the questions received during the site visit and by email and answers provided.

Following are the questions that were raised during the pre-bid site visit and answers to those questions:

- Q1. Can the Contractor reuse the existing handrails?
- A1. Reuse of existing handrails is acceptable if the following conditions are met:
 - Existing non-galvanized steel handrails are compatible with the galvanized steel fabrication
 - Existing handrails are code compliant
 - Reusing the existing handrails is more cost effective than fabricating new galvanized steel handrails
 - Reused handrails are included in the Contractor's warranty
- Q2. Is there a specific color that the staircases should be painted?
- A2. Galvanized materials do not need to be painted. If the existing steel tube handrails are reused, they should be primed and then painted yellow.
- Q3. Is a fire detail required for welding in the boiler rooms?
- A3. The Contractor will be responsible for obtaining a hot-work permit.
- Q4. Where can the Contractor Park for delivery/installation?
- A4. DPW will coordinate parking space for the Contractor in the DPW Yard, as near as possible to the exterior boiler room doors.

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- Q5. The scope states that the platforms and stair treads must be galvanized. Are the stair stringers also required to be galvanized?
- A5. Yes. All staircase components, including but not limited to stringers, treads, rails, and landings will be fabricated from galvanized steel. The only exception is if the Contractor decides to reuse the existing handrails and meets all conditions for reuse (see Q1 and A1).
- Q6. What is the timeline for the project?
- A6. Estimated Contract Start Date: February 1, 2025.
 Date of Substantial Completion: May 31, 2025.
 Date of Final Completion: June 30, 2025.
- Q7. How will the bid price be broken down?
- A7. The Contractor will submit one lump sum bid for the cost of all materials and labor specified in the Scope of Work. Addendum 1 includes an updated price form.
- Q8. Will the staircase in Boiler Room 2 also have housekeeping pads to elevate the feet off the floor?
- A8. No. The floor is graded away from the stairs. The floor of Boiler Room 2 is dry under normal circumstances.

Following is a question received by email and the answers to that question:

Q1. Could you let us know how long we'll have to complete the job? We offer 3 options for the stairs: aluminum, carbon steel, or galvanized.

Estimated Contract Start Date: February 1, 2025.

Date of Substantial Completion: May 31, 2025.

Date of Final Completion: June 30, 2025 (see Q6).

All staircase components, including but not limited to stringers, treads, rails, and landings will be fabricated from galvanized steel (see Q5).

Revised Price Form:

Please note that the Price Form has been revised. The Original Itemized Price Form has been replaced with a Lump-Sum Form which includes Alternative Options to Replace Some or All Staircase Rails in the event they Do Not Meet Code.
