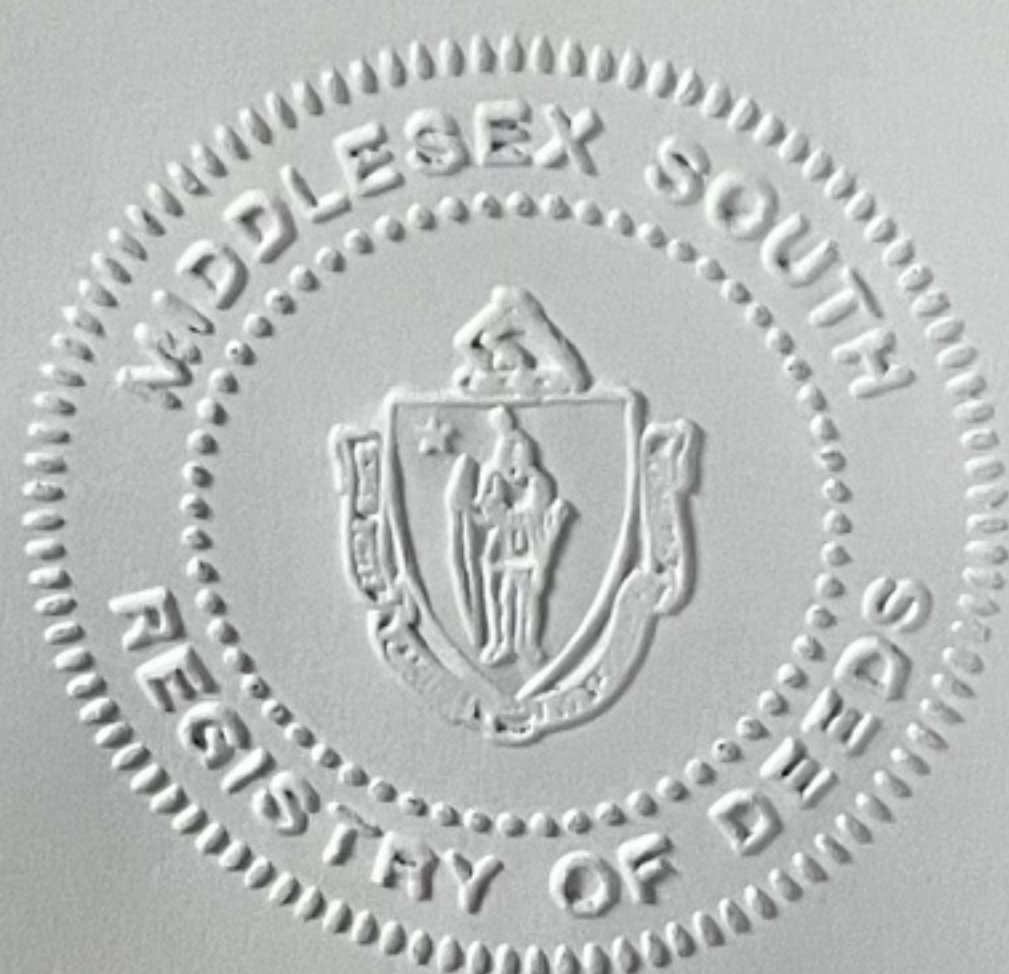
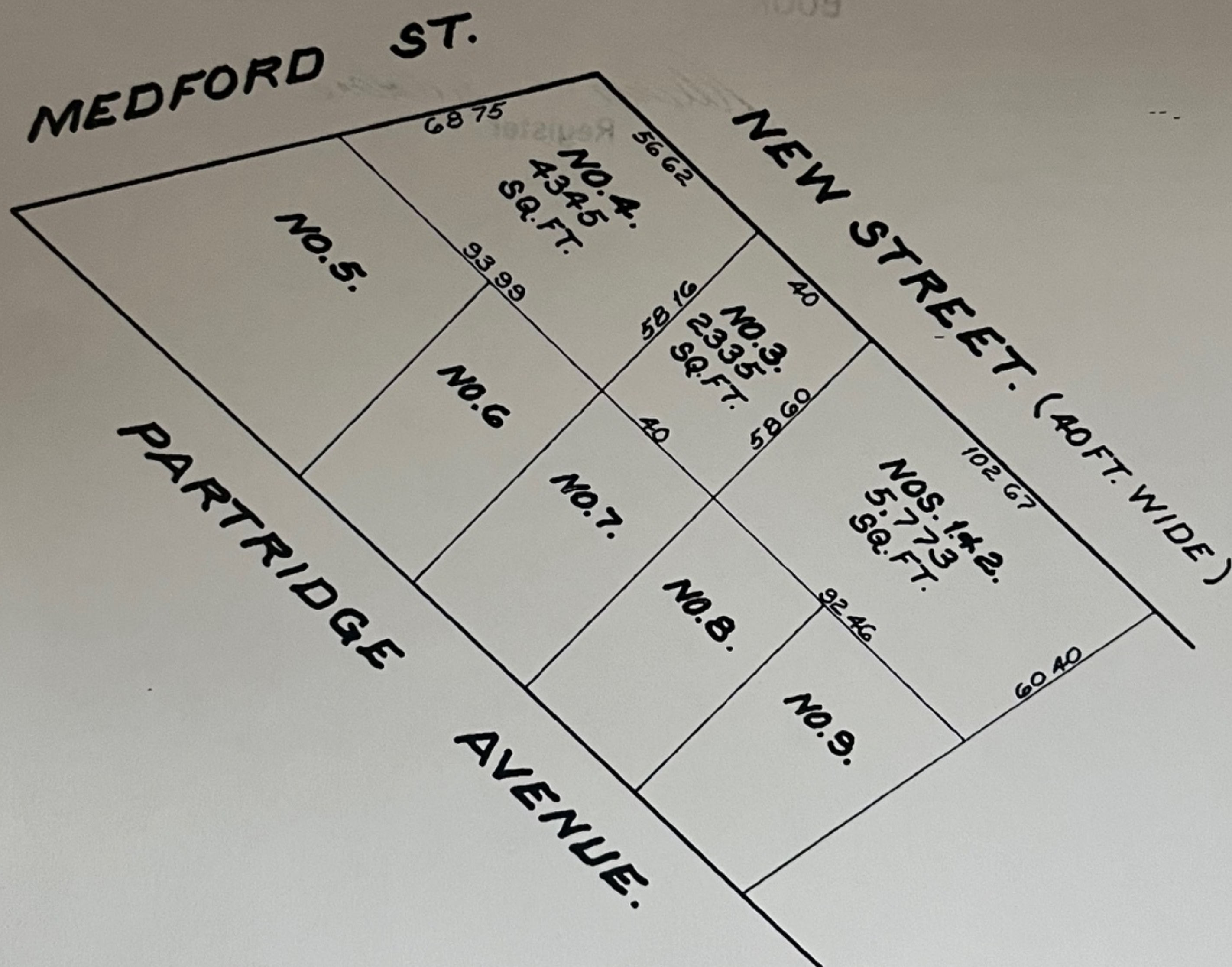


**SKETCH OF PLAN

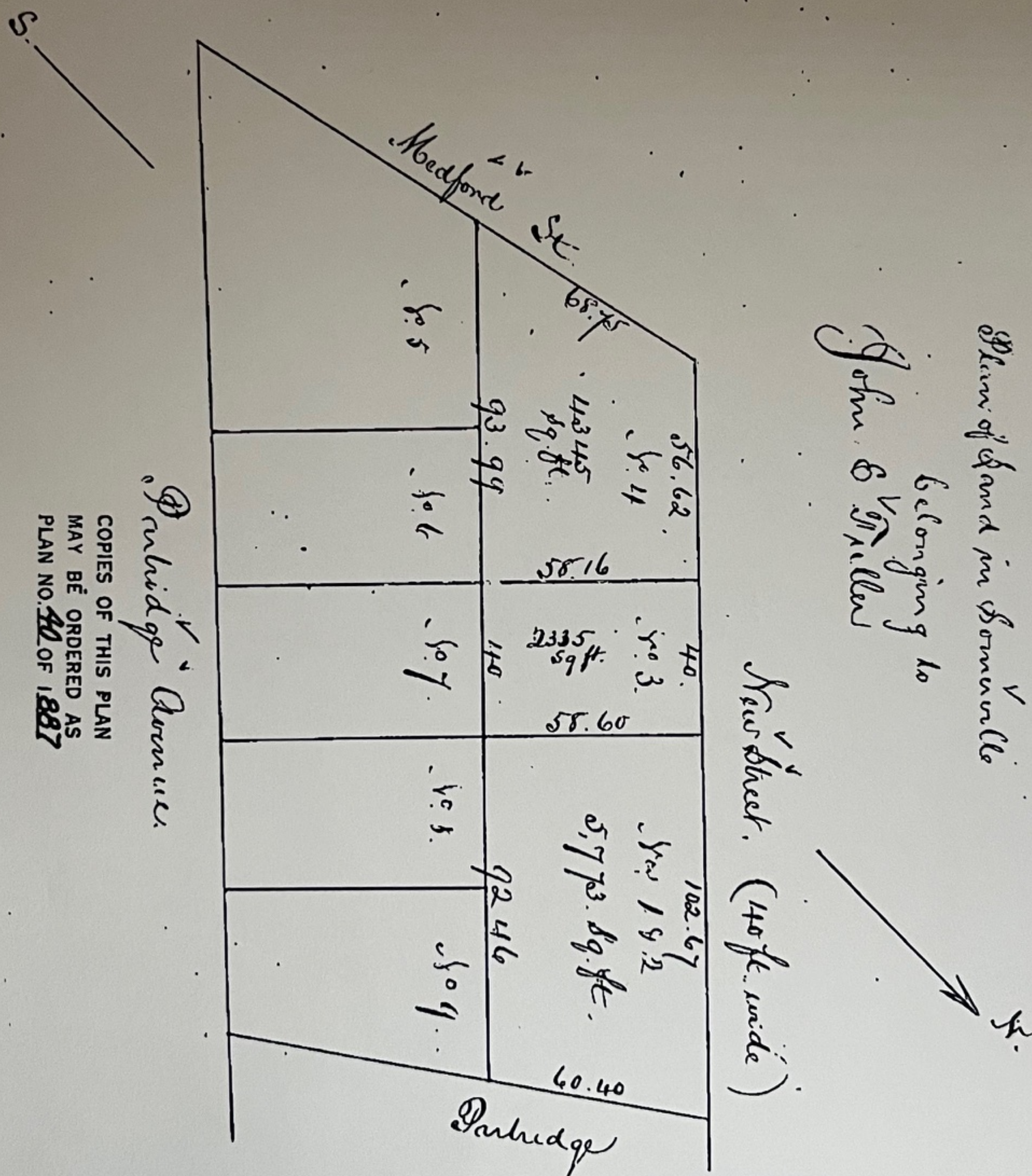
