#	Question	Answer
1.	Do busses, and if yes how many, use the drop off/pick up loop in Elm St?	Six (6) small busses use the loop each school day. They generally start lining up between 7:30 and 7:45. There are also at least two cars that use the loop for their child to access the building. Again, there are no large yellow busses that use this loop.
2.	Does the Elm St drop off/pick up loop queue onto Elm St at either the start or end of the school day?	Not normally, please see answer to above question about busses for more information.
