- 1. Approve minutes (5 min)
  - Welcoming new up and coming members, Ben, Christine, and Sarah
- 2. Community News (20 min)
  - SAC updated website is finally up, still work in progress, hopefully having a more functionally integrated community calendar, and better forms and systems
  - The pit in Teele Square might get developed
  - Our Yorgos is famous and won a big prize from the ICA!
  - Milk Row Studio is working on bigger presence in Open Studios and other large events.
  - Some performances are coming up at the Hive, SomArt Spaces.
  - Potential poetry salon coming up.
  - People are excited for PorchFest, and underground music festival (Aug 7-9<sup>th</sup>)

- 4. Advocacy: Central Street Studios, Cultural Capacity Plan, Somernova Development (15 min)
  - Armory will be seeking advisory board.

- Great win: Mayor plans to support Central Street Studios, to purchase it and keep it affordable. Art Stays Here is helping to organize the tenant association. Great precedent for a way to support studios that may experience similar situations.
- Cultural Capacity Plan, finally out, trying to keep an ongoing ambassador program as it
  has been a recurring theme/need, but hard to hire new people to organize this.
  - o Upcoming music meetings to support local musicians to share knowledge
  - City will continue to explore what a cultural trust, and figure out financial mechanism.
- Somernova: Land use committee hearing later in March 20<sup>th</sup> 6:30pm at City Hall and online, will propose revision of ACE definition, additional overlays protect arts community.
